**SOCIAL SECURITY CHECKS TO BE EARLY**

Social Security checks, which are normally delivered on the third of the month, will be delivered Friday, October 1 since the third is a Sunday, Travis C. Briggs, social security manager in Lufkin announced. The Friday check delivery is a new policy. SS checks will be delivered on a Friday whenever the third falls on a Saturday or Sunday. The same schedule will apply to beneficiaries who have their SS checks deposited directly in a bank.

**SPURGER SCHOOLS MUST REPAY FUNDS**

Superintendent A B Crank recently returned from Austin where the Texas Education Agency informed him the Spurger Schools will have to refund \$832.00 to the state.

The Texas Education Agency advanced the Spurger Schools \$1,940.00 during the 1969-70 school year for Vocational Travel and NDEA reading programs. In 1972 an audit was conducted and no records could be found to substantiate these expenditures. After an exhaustive search of school records the unsigned travel vouchers and corresponding school board minutes for that year were compiled and taken to Austin, where \$1,108.00 was successfully accounted for. The remainder will have to be repaid to the state. The Spurger board of Trustees expressed to the Agency their concern over the taxpayers having to repay this due to mismanagement of the school administration back in 1969-70.

Superintendent Crank states that he is glad to finally get the whole matter settled. "This audit was conducted the first month after I moved to Spurger and for four years we have known some settlement would eventually have to be made. I'm just relieved the travel funds did not have to be repaid also." The same audit in 1972 also resulted in the Spurger Schools having to repay \$1,400.00 in teacher salaries for the 1969-70 and 190-71 school years. This was because some teachers were paid incorrectly. The amount was paid shortly after the audit of '72.

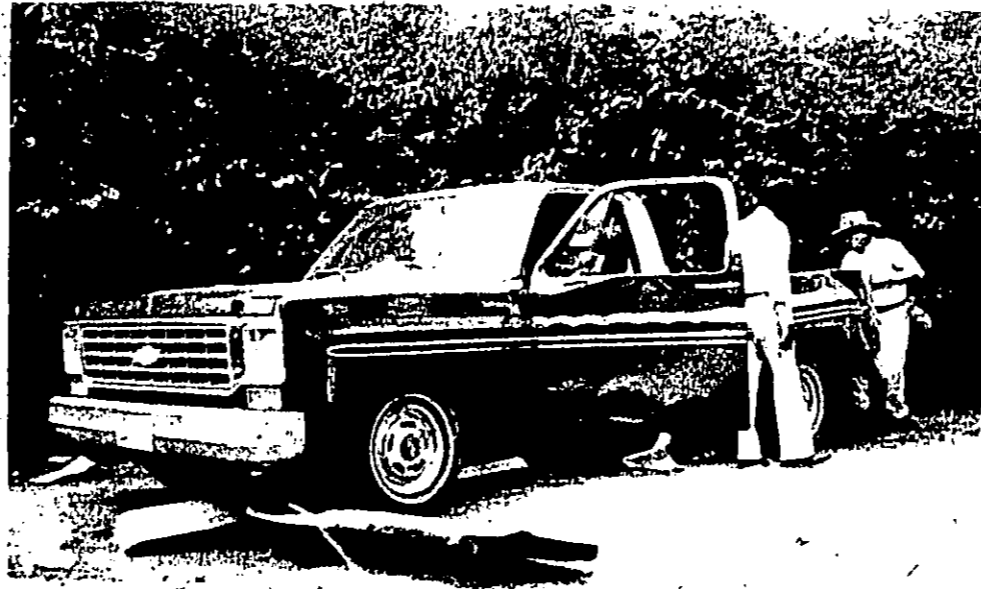

A shopping trip to the store Wednesday ended up in a freakish accident for Cecil Davis of Colmesneil. Upon returning to his pickup truck, the accelerator apparently stuck and caused the vehicle to spurt backward when placed in reverse gear.

The truck sped backward at a high rate of speed and crashed thru a railing around the Brookshire parking lot and five students were hit and injured while leaning on that rail. **MHMR RECEIVES  
\$225,000 GRANT**

The Deep East Texas Regional Mental Health Mental Retardation Services has received final approval of a construction grant totaling \$225,000 from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, according to U.S. Rep. Charles Wilson's office.

The grant will be combined with a \$45,000 grant from the T.L.L. Temple Foundation and \$30,000 from local agency funds for a total of \$300,000, according to MHMR Services Executive Director Dr. Wayne Lawrence.

AUSTIN — A statewide committee to sell Texas voters on adoption of Constitutional Amendment 2 — a \$100,000,000 addition to the state's clean water bond program — was announced here Monday.

needed sewage treatment facilities.

Local governments borrow money, on a pay-back basis, from the fund to improve or rebuild their facilities when money is not available from other sources.

The additional \$100,000,000 "must be provided if these Texas communities are to improve their sewage treatment facilities and the rivers and streams in the state are to be properly protected," Wheat said at a Capitol press conference.

Many towns, he said, cannot raise money locally to finance replacing or upgrading facilities and federal

money often is not available within a needed time frame.

Wheat said he knows of no organized opposition to Amendment 2, but that the committee was organized to explain the purposes of the fund to voters.

"Very often, when people don't know what is involved, they vote 'no' just to be on the safe side," he said.

The Texas For Clean Water Committee includes representatives of statewide professional and business associations, the League of Women Voters, Municipal League, water conservation and pollution control, the Texas Jaycees, publishers and broadcasters.
