Seniors Get Pay Day Break

Quit State Utilities is instituting a new program that will make it a little easier for many senior citizens to pay their monthly QSU bills.

Depending on ability, qualified retirees throughout the QSU system will be able to pay their monthly bills on a designated date that coincides with the date their retirement checks arrive.

"We realize some of our older customers receive their Social Security or pension checks after the due date of their electric bill," said Dr. Paul W. Murrill, QSU board chairman and chief executive officer. "Because they've always been good customers, they worry about paying their bills on time."

Any QSU customer who is 65 or older, retired, receiving Social Security or a pension and has a good credit rating with the company can qualify for the new program, known as the Convenient Payment Plan. Retirees should call their nearest QSU office to see if they are eligible and when going to the office to sign up, should bring some proof of age, such as driver's license or birth certificate.

"We know that customers who live on Social Security worry about being late with their bill payments," Murrill said. "This is one small way QSU can help. We will continue to look for other ways to assist all customers in coping with rising electricity costs."

Small Business Dollar Help Available

Washington - Small business in a 12 county area of East Texas will be eligible to receive financial help through the newly created Deep East Texas Regional Certified Development Corporation, U.S. Senator John Tower (R-Texas) announced today.

The corporation has been certified by the Small Business Administration and will be authorized to lend up to \$500,000 per qualifying business for fixed assets. To qualify, the borrower must provide 10 percent of the investment package and obtain financing for another 30 percent from a commercial lending institution. The remaining 40 percent would come from the Regional Development Corporation portion of the loan can be for up to 25 years, although the commercial loan must be for at least half the period of that loan.

"The availability of long-term financing from the Regional Development Corporation should make it easier for businesses to get the required loan from a commercial institution," Tower said.

"This Small Business Administration program establishes a partnership between private and public resources, and is particularly valuable because it will spur economic development in the Deep East area, and is an excellent example of federal funds being used in the most effective manner possible," Tower said.

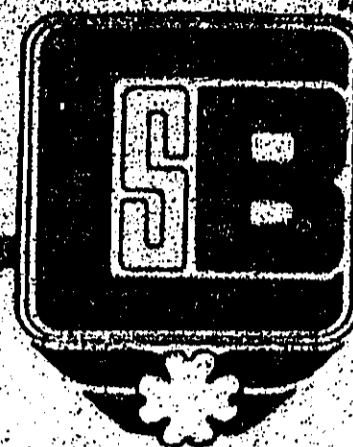

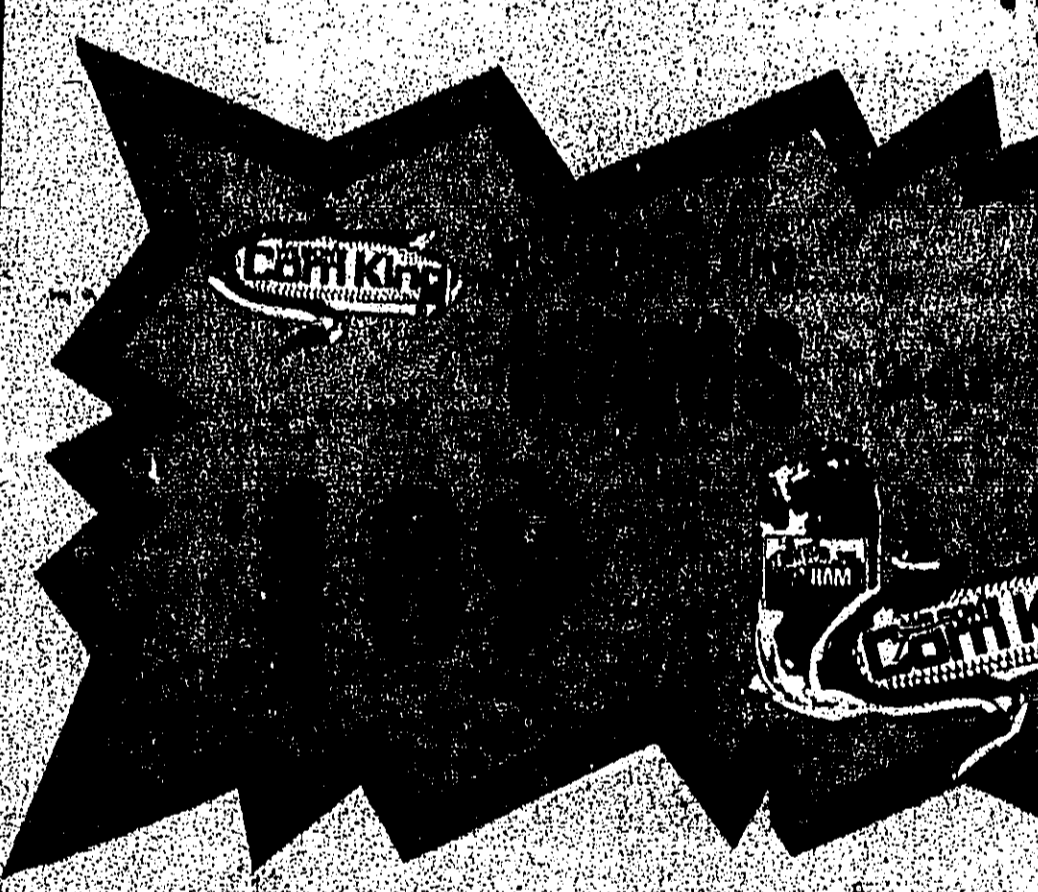
