Jeff Mackey Awarded \$1000

Jeff Mackey, a Senior at Woodville has been selected as the 1983 Wal-Mart Foundation Scholarship Recipient, according to local store manager Terry McGeath in Woodville, Texas. The \$1,000 academic scholarship is based on grade point average, college entrance exams, curriculum, financial need, extra curricular and work activities. An interview of the finalist was also used in determining the recipient.

Last year, the Wal-Mart Foundation started the scholarship program in three hundred and thirty-five communities and awarded a total of \$335,000 in scholarships. In 1983, over 500 scholarships will be awarded to deserving high school seniors throughout a fourteen state area.

Mackey plans to attend Texas A&M in College Station, Texas this fall with an eventual degree in Accounting.

'1950's' Day Is Friday At Wal-Mart

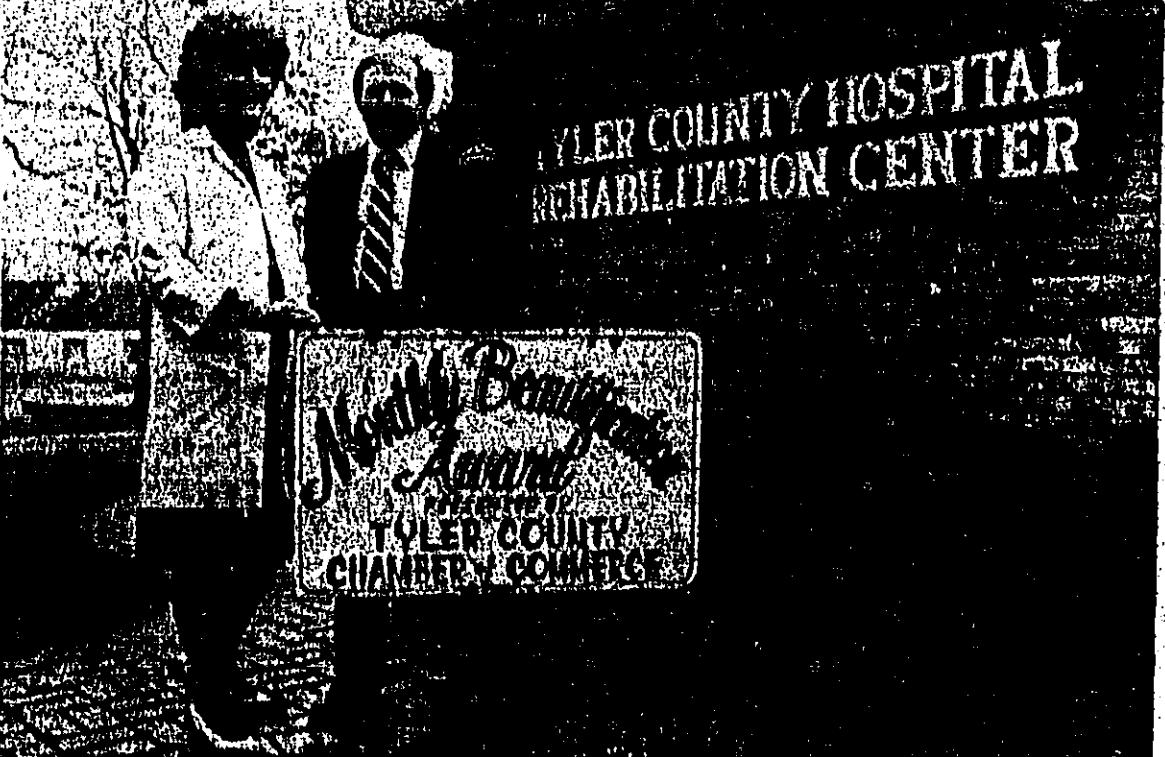

Special Teaching, Special Students, Special Needs

Editor's Note: This is the first of a four part series giving our readers a detailed look at Tyler County's special programs for students with special needs.

"Anyone who knows of a handicapped child needing help should contact me at 817-2328."

"The younger we can identify a child with a handicap, whether it be sight or hearing or mental retardation, the sooner we can begin teaching the child," says Mrs. Jane Boykin, Director of the Tyler County Special Education Cooperative.

"The public can help by helping us locate handicapped students who we are not serving."

The Tyler County Special Education Cooperative continues to provide today, as it has for the past 10 years, a wide variety of special educational programming for handicapped and learning disabled students aged 3 through 21 years.

Directed by Boykin, the Tyler County Special Education Cooperative provides educational evaluations, counseling and supervision services for all handicapped students and also provides early childhood services to handicapped 3 to 5-year old children and vocational and as of this year pre-vocational education for high school aged special education students.

Educational programming is currently provided to meet the special educational needs of students who are physically handicapped, emotionally disturbed, mentally retarded, learning disabled, speech handicapped, suffer from pregnancy and homebound services are available for students with health problems. The Special Education Cooperative provides a Day School for the hearing impaired deaf and programming for students with sight difficulties from birth to age 22.

The Special Education Cooperative was formed in 1972 with one supervisor and seven teachers, and has now grown into a full fledged agency with director, three staff members and 23 teachers. It serves approximately 480 students a year.

In 1978 federal money to implement Federal Law 94-142 became available, and the services were much expanded. The law requires that every school district provide a free and appropriate education for every handicapped child, ages 3-21.

The co-op now conducts diagnostic testing on each child suspected of having a handicap, then writes an individual educational plan for that student in conjunction with the parents. It continues to assess and supervise the child's progress yearly.

Certified special education teachers in local schools then provide the special services required.

The Special Services Co-op also coordinates residential placement for any students whose handicapping condition cannot be handled by the local program.

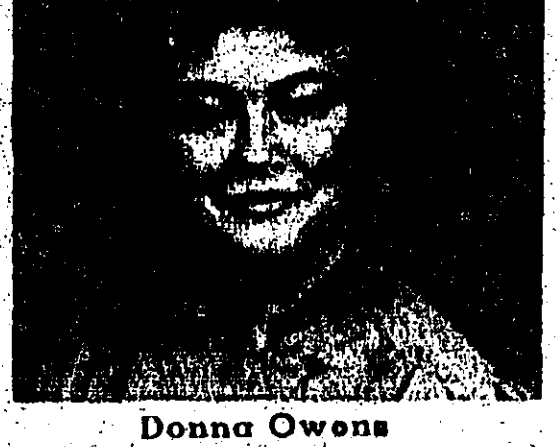

ASCS Offers Acreage Pre-measurement Service

To take the guess work out of crop certification and help farm program participants obtain and report accurate crop acreage, the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service provides pre-measurement and other producer services.

"One gamble that a farmer should never take is the loss of program benefits because of failure to comply with acreage requirements," said Kathy O. Lowe, ASCS County Executive Director.

Before crop planting time, ASCS will provide pre-measurement services to help farmers determine the type of acreage, the amount of acreage, and the crop to be planted. The farmer requests the service, and ASCS sends a team to report their requirements are met.

"We will begin accepting pre-measurement requests on April 1, 1983. The service costs \$10 per farm plus \$5 per plot, plus mileage, and includes measuring, referencing and marking fields with stakes prior to planting. Only those acres pre-measured by our office will be eligible for program benefits," Mrs. Lowe said.

Other producer services include measuring total cropland, field or subfield to be planted and land area for other purposes. Fees vary, depending on the type of service requested.

May 1 Deadline For Crop Report

The Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service is currently accepting acreage reports for the 1983 farm program. Farmers have until May 1, 1983, to report the acreage and intended crop of their wheat, oats and other fall seeded small grains.

"Some farmers are offered these crops when they signed up for the 1983 acreage reporting program, and some reported spring seeded crops," said Kathy O. Lowe, County Executive Director.

Farmers who fail to report their fall seeded crops by the deadline will be ineligible for pre-support loans, target prices, land area payments and commodity under the pay

ment in kind program. Acreage reports are used to determine compliance with farm program. They also serve as a basis for the 1984 program base acres for farmers. Program participants are required to report their actual planted acreage on a field-by-field basis to be eligible for program benefits.

It is also important for non-program participants to report their acres because the 1984 base acreage reports are accurate ASCS randomly checks farms and also provides aerial photography for farmers to identify their fields.

Partners who have not certified their fall seeded crops are urged to do so as soon as possible. The county ASCS office is open weekdays from 8 a. m. to 5 p. m.

Foreign Owned Ag-Land Eyed

The Agricultural Foreign Investment Disclosure Act of 1979 requires all foreign owners of U.S. agricultural land to report their holdings to the National Agricultural Statistics Service. The act also requires that the foreign owner report the acreage, value, and use of the land.

Foreigners who own or control agricultural land in the United States must report the land to the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The act also requires that the foreign owner report the acreage, value, and use of the land.

The reporting requirement is still in effect, Kathy O. Lowe, ASCS County Executive Director, said.

For reporting purposes, agricultural land is defined as any tract of

more than one acre used in agriculture, forestry, or other production. This includes land used for agricultural use when purchased as well as land later converted to agricultural use. The act also requires that the foreign owner report the acreage, value, and use of the land.

Foreigners who own or control agricultural land in the United States must report the land to the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The act also requires that the foreign owner report the acreage, value, and use of the land.

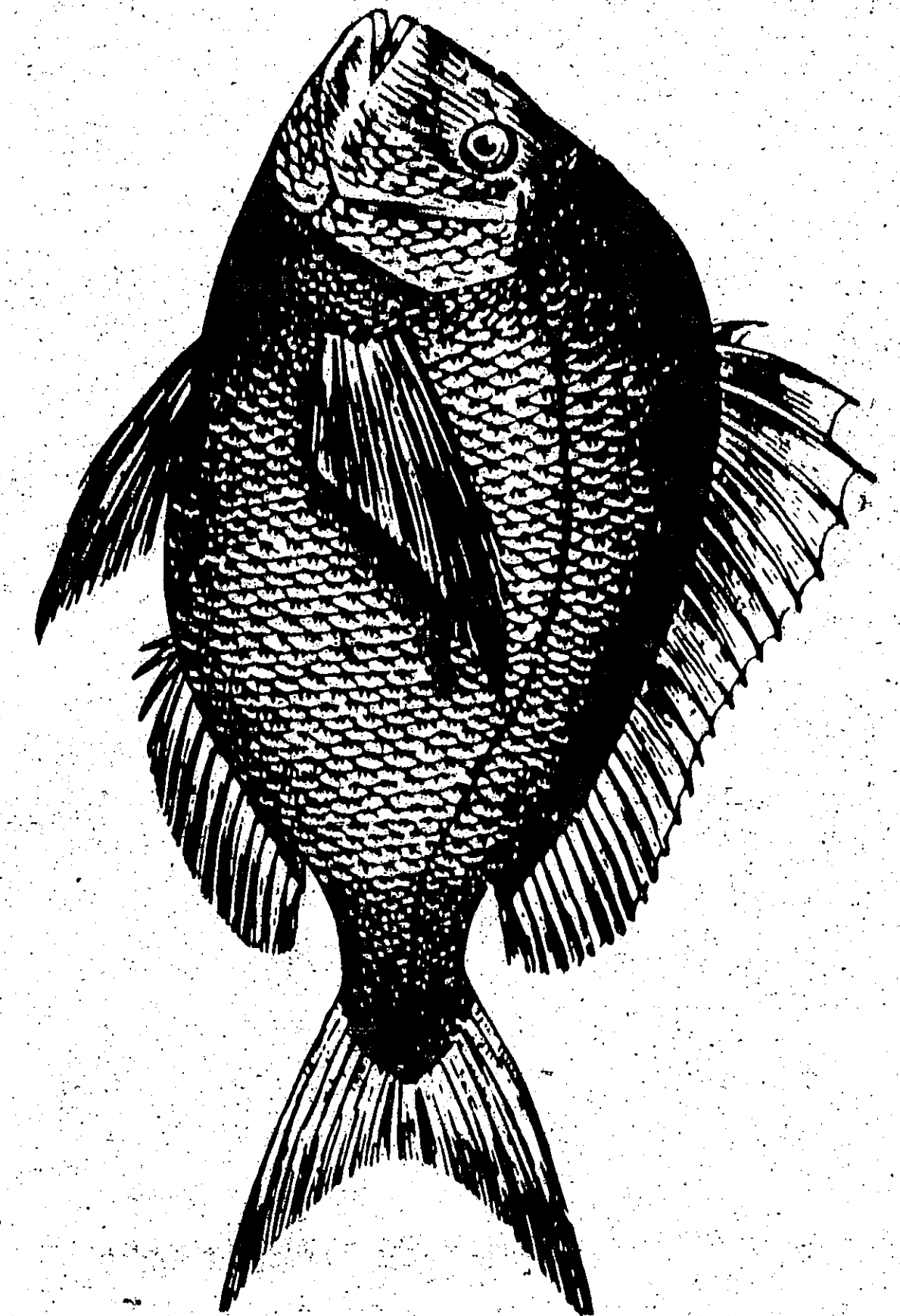
