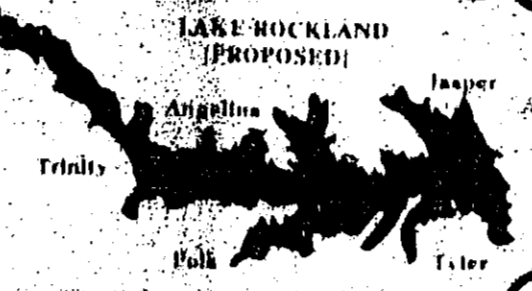

## Houston Water Planners Eye Rockland Dam

Lake Rockland is seen as one of several alternatives for meeting the municipal and industrial water needs in the Houston area in the opening decades of the 21st century, according to the Texas Department of Water Resources (TDWR) draft study "Water for Texas" published recently.

Lake Rockland is a recently reactivated project of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, which built according to the early timetable of the Corps of Engineers would result in a 22-mile-long, 1-mile wide reservoir on the northern border of Tyler, Polk and Trinity counties. Lake Rockland, in addition to supplying water to municipal, industrial and agricultural users in the Neches River Basin, Golden Triangle and

Houston areas, would produce hydropower for peak demand use by area electric utilities, reduce flooding along the Neches River from Rockland to Beaumont and provide irrigation amenities for area visitors and residents.

The "Water for Texas" water supply projections, assuming continued Houston area growth, show inadequate water supply for the Lower Brazos San Jacinto River Basins beginning early in the next century.

Lake Rockland is one, but not the only alternative supply, for water being looked at by Houston area water planners according to Dr. Herb Grubb, director of Planning and Development TDWR. The Low Creek Lake Project which would be located west of Conroe in Montgomery County and the Lake Cleveland Project which would be located in central San Jacinto County are both under consideration according to Grubb. Low Creek Lake is projected by the TDWR study to begin construction around the year 2000 at a cost of \$467 million. Lake Cleveland is seen as starting around the year 1990 and costing \$206 million. Both reservoirs have the expensive disadvantages of being located in areas which are already developed plus assuming the TDWR projections are correct, the effect would only be to further delay for a few more years the need for additional water supply from Lake Rockland in the Neches River Basin and still later the need for Bon Weir Reservoir in the Sabine River Basin.

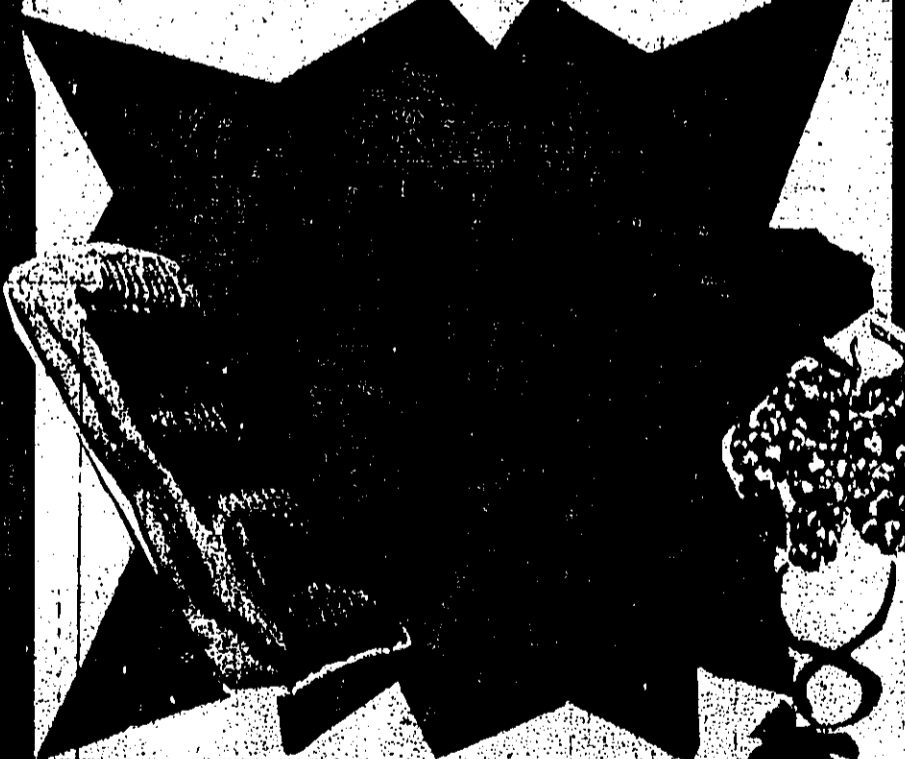

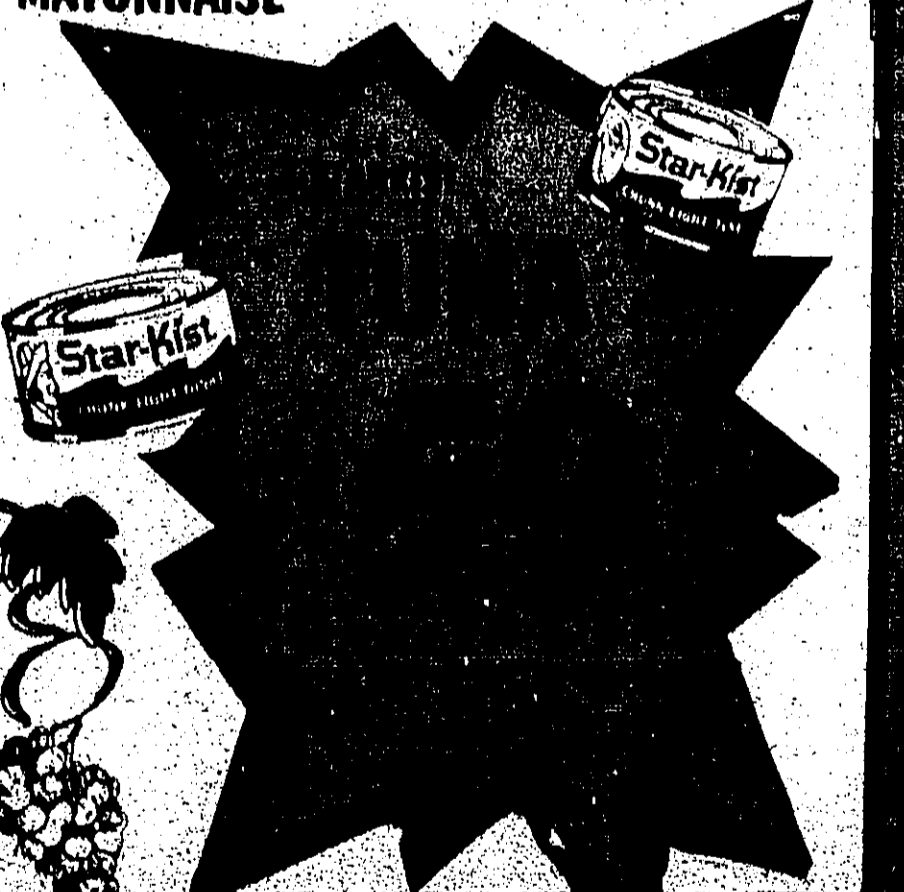

# Distribution Of Surplus Cheese Reduced

Distribution of surplus cheese and butter to low-income Texans is being reduced 70% by direction of the U.S. Department of Human Resources which has been administering the program, said his department had been releasing 3,720,000 pounds of cheese each month. This will be reduced to about 1.1 million pounds a month. Butter was being given away at a rate of about 1.2 million pounds a month which will be reduced to about 768,000 pounds a month.

The commissioner said that USDA closed their stocks are exhausted. Under new directives issued in Public Law 98-8, the Jobs Bill which went into effect May 1 of this year, the reduced distribution of cheese and butter will be targeted to areas of severe unemployment and high unemployment. Non-profit, tax-exempt organizations which participate in the program will receive the donated commodities for distribution to needy individuals for home consumption. The participating organizations will have to determine the eligibility of individuals in their area of high unemployment. Examples of organizations which are eligible for the program include: churches, synagogues, mosques, and other religious organizations; schools, hospitals, and day care centers; and other non-profit organizations.

Dr. Mary Ann Shriver, director of the program, said: "Many of these accidents could have been prevented." # Lock Returns As Fisheries Specialist

Dr. Joe T. Lock, Agricultural Research and Extension Center at Overton, returned to the position he held with the Texas Agricultural Experiment Station, Texas A&M University System, in July 1983. 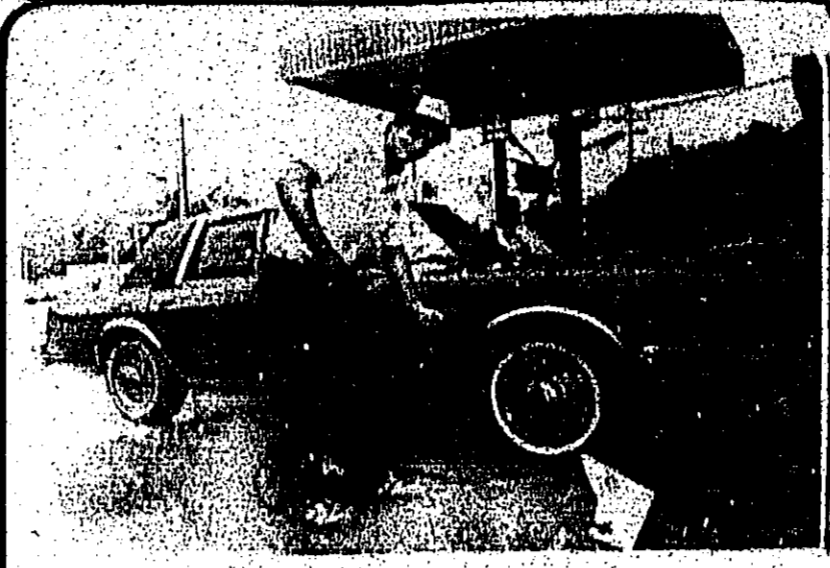

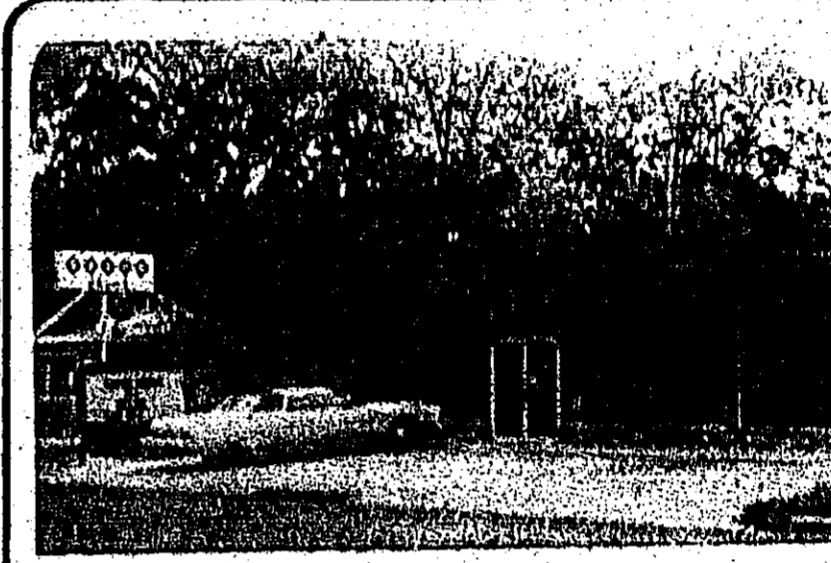
