

# First National Bank Plans Larger Structure

WOODVILLE—The newly chartered First National Bank of Woodville broke ground last week on its first bank building at its site on South Magnolia in Woodville.

The 3000 square foot building will preserve the favor of traditional Texas architecture, according to the bank's president, Rexx Behring. The building will have a long porch on the front. "The style is reminiscent of the earlier construction of earlier times," Behring said, adding that the low-pitched roof and porch would add protection for customers

from the intense summer sun and those sudden rains. The siding will be cedar. "We are able to combine the most efficient energy-saving features with a comfortable environment and a secure, modern banking facility with this design," Behring said.

Behring said that parking will be provided for 21 customer vehicles, and that the facility will have two drive through lanes. "One of our drive through windows will be devoted entirely to commercial business," Behring said. In addition, the building will have wheelchair access by means of a ramp leading from the

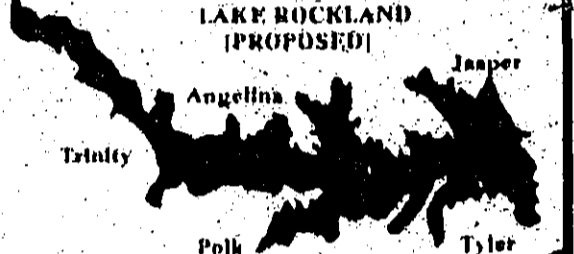

### 'Delete Dam', Says Thicket Group's Brink

Betty Brink of Kountze, Texas, representing the Big Thicket Conservation Association, urged state water planners to "delete" the Rockland Dam and Lake Project from the list of planned future water reservoirs, describing the proposed Corps of Engineers Project as an "environmental disaster".

Brink spoke at a public hearing in Baytown held last Tuesday, to receive comments regarding the draft version of the Texas Department of Water Resources (TDWR) "Water for Texas" proposed amendment to the Texas Water Plan. The TDWR was represented by Dr. Herb Grubb, Director of Planning and Development for TDWR, Charles Nemir, Executive Director of

TDWR, and Mr. Louis Welch, member of the Texas Water Development Board and head of the Houston Chamber of Commerce. Lake Rockland is a recently reactivated project of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers which if built according to the early timetable of the Corps of Engineers, would result in a 22 mile long, 1 mile wide reservoir on the northern border of Tyler, Polk and Trinity Counties, Lake Rockland, in addition to supplying water to municipal, industrial and agricultural users in the Neches River Basin, Golden Triangle and Houston area, would produce hydropower for peak demand use by area electric utilities, reduce flooding along the Neches River from Rockland to Beaumont and provide recreation

Clark further said that it means for the first time the County will have a complete Law Department and it will require a person with extensive experience in all areas of the law as well as organizing and administering an efficient law office.

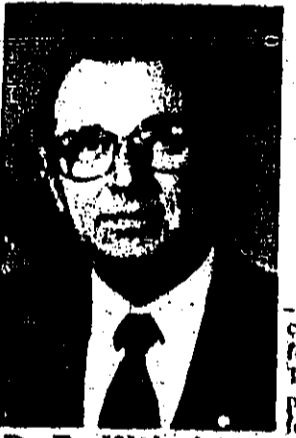

## Lawn Care Requires Patience

Lawn care has many problems and two of the biggest in East Texas are fire ants and bahia grass. With patience and a little work, both of these can be dealt with. If the lawn is bermudagrass, Dr. Jim A. Reeves, Jr., agronomist for the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, says that DSMA or MSMA can be used to effectively control bahia grass. Follow label directions. If the lawn is bahia with Roundup in a which applicator, bahia grows from seed, therefore, several years may be required for complete control. Some pre-emerge herbicides that prevent plants from growing from seed are approved for use in lawns. County Extension agents throughout the area have additional information on approved herbicides.

Fire ants in yards can be controlled by several methods, according to Dr. James Robinson, Extension entomologist. Amdro, an approved fire ant bait, can be used for small mounds. Check labels for specific instructions. Amdro is slow acting and may take several weeks for complete control. Do not use Amdro when the soil is wet or just before watering the lawn. Wait until the dew is off the grass to apply Amdro and follow label directions. Wait at least two or three days before watering the lawn. The quickest way to destroy established fire ant mounds is to treat them with one of the approved pesticides. Robinson says, These may be used in several forms, baits, powders, drenches or dusts. Diazinon, dursban and orthene may be used as drenches. GFC 90 comes in a liquid form and is also a drench. Orthene 75 percent soluble powder can be used as a powder. Diazinon or sevin are approved for use as dusts. Regardless of the pesticide used, label directions should be strictly followed. Reinfestation of fire ants is likely to occur, therefore the lawn should be checked frequently and new infestations treated immediately. Additional pesticides may be available for fire ant control. Check labels for specific approvals. Robinson and may take several weeks for complete control.

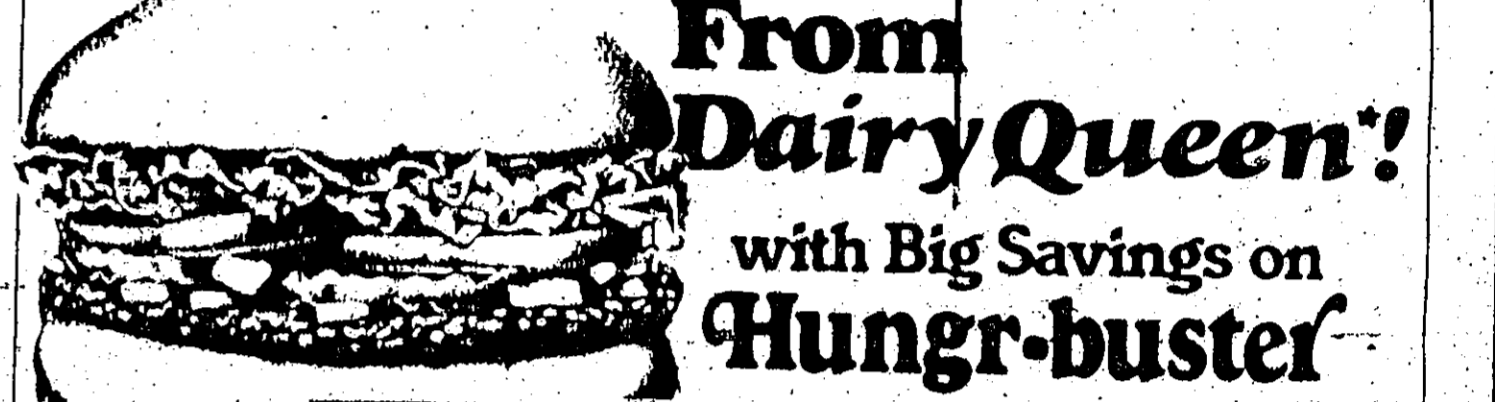
