Editorial

Dress Rehearsal

Last weekend's arrest of two young men who were allegedly selling drugs to some 30 Tyler County area youth, is just one measure of the problems our communities and schools are facing in proper direction and supervision of youth on a community basis.

Parents are responsible for supervising their children and, that makes it more incumbent on parents to act as a community to provide, for example, a youth community center where their offspring and other teenagers can congregate under Tyler County "family" supervision.

It is becoming apparent, from the events of this past weekend, that private concerns which cater to the youth of our community cannot or will not, provide that level of supervision which is necessary to prevent what seems to have occurred Saturday.

A municipal, church or school youth community center, at least, in Woodville, Warren or Colmesneil will not stop drugs nor will it offer any type of haven from the "real world" which teenagers live in today. Teenagers will bring that with them. But it does offer in combination with other youth improvements such as the Tyler County Youth Development Center, Inc., a strong indication that the parents of our environs have no intention of abandoning their supervisory responsibilities and allowing an atmosphere conducive to drug abuse and other youth manifested problems.

If the charges do not stand in terms of the arrests and the surveillance this past weekend or if the "postage size pieces of paper" with substance on them turns out to be only sugar, and not drugs, then it seems like the weekend's scenario would serve as a good dress rehearsal for an act coming soon which would be painfully hard to follow.

Sheriff Leon Fowler was right when he said last year, "The number one problem in Tyler County is that Tyler County needs a safe place for our youth to assemble."

Drug Arrests

"The drug I really didn't expect was that there would be this many Woodville area young people who would be this willing to buy these alleged drugs," said Tyler County Sheriff Leon Fowler, Monday, discussing Sunday morning's arrest

stop south of Woodville after a controlled drug buy was reportedly arranged earlier in "The Phoenix" game room in Woodville, located 50 yards from the sheriff's office. The "drug buy" was reportedly made with surveillance cooperation between sheriff's deputies.

Court OK's Radios

Commissioner's Court in a regularly scheduled meeting Monday, August 8, agreed to go out for bids for two radar units and two mobile walkie-talkies for locally based Department of Public Safety Officers.

Sam Purce Collins, Executive vice president and general manager of the Sabine River Authority (SRA), recommended to Texas water planners July 26 in Baytown, Texas, that they seriously consider protecting the limited number of water supply reservoir sites remaining in Texas.

Among the water reservoir sites remaining is the recently reactivated U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Lower Neches Valley Authority Lake Rockland Project, which if built according to the early timetable of the Corps of Engineers in 1996, would result in a 22 mile long, 3 mile wide reservoir on the northern border of Tyler, Polk and Trinity Counties by the year 2008. Lake Rockland, in

addition to supplying water to municipal, industrial and agricultural users in the Neches River Basin, Golden Triangle and Houston area, would produce hydro power for peak demand use by area electric utilities, reduce flooding along the Neches River from Rockland to Beaumont and provide recreation amenities for area visitors and residents.

Collins spoke at a public hearing designed to receive public comment on the draft version of the Texas Department of Human Resources (TDHR) "Water for Texas" amendment to the Texas Water Plan. The TDWR was represented by Dr. Herb Grubb, director of planning and development for TDWR and former Mayor of Houston, Louis Welch, member of the Texas

Water Development Board and head of the Houston Chamber of Commerce. "We must all realize the most efficient condition in supplying the water needs of Texas are yet to come," said Collins. "Due to the limited number of these reservoir sites, we feel that all concerned should immediately begin consideration of procedures to accomplish preservation of these sites at the earliest possible time. A key factor in this endeavor which is urgently needed is a statewide program to provide for 'up-front' financing arrangements to build projects in advance of actual need, especially which other types of development in the near future might preclude use of these sites for future reservoir construction."

ATLANTA, August 3 - Josiah Wheat, a partner of the Woodville law firm of Wheat and Stafford and general counsel to the Lower Neches Valley Authority in Texas, today was elected a member of the American Bar Association Board of Governors. Wheat will serve a three-year term representing District 11, which includes Texas.
