Enrollment Up

Woodville School Board trustees meeting in special session Tuesday at noon accepted an amended budget, involving the deletion of \$106,000 in special education salaries from the budget. The funding of those salaries will be funded through the Tyler County Special Education Cooperative whose funding agent is Caldwell School District. Preliminary figures for fall enrollment for the 1983 school year indicate a total enrollment of 1,774 students or an increase of 44 students over the comparable period last school year. 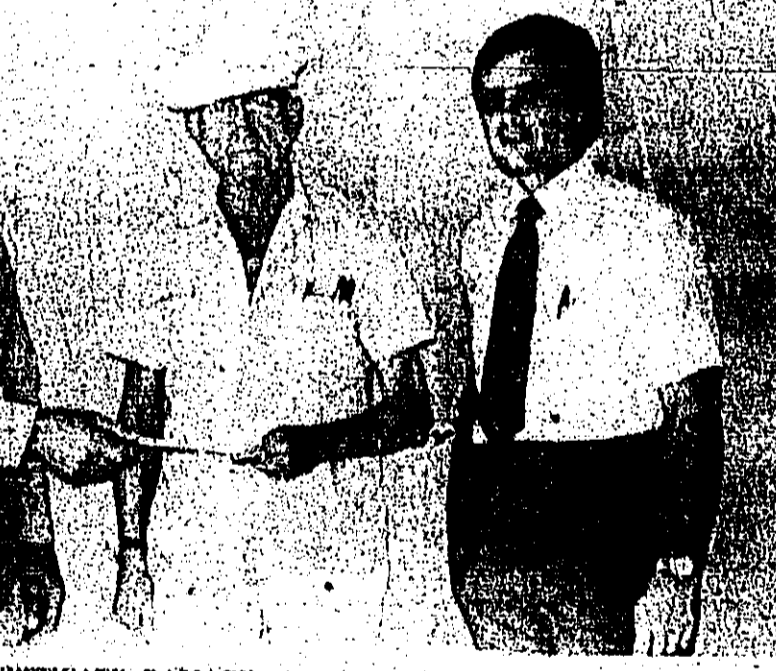
Sen. Blake Oversees Capitol Restoration

Lieutenant Governor Hill Hobby announced the appointment of Senator Roy Blake to the State Preservation Board. The Board will exercise oversight responsibility for the restoration of the Capitol and the old General Land Office with the help of the Permanent Advisory Committee. The Preservation Board is responsible for preserving, maintaining, and restoring the State Capitol and the old Land Office. The Board has the authority to hire an architect and a curator for the Capitol to assist them in their charge. In making the appointment, Hobby commented, "Senator Blake carried the enabling legislation which created the Preservation Board. His interest in the area of preservation of State landmarks is well known. He will make a valuable contribution by adding his perspective to the Board." The Board has six members, the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house, a member appointed by the governor, a member of the senate appointed by the lieutenant governor, and a member of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker.

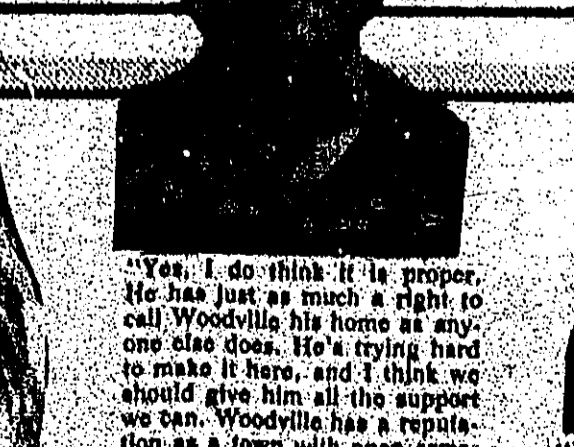

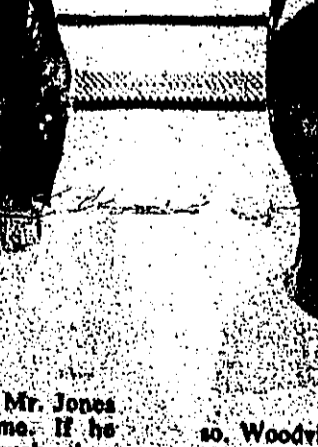

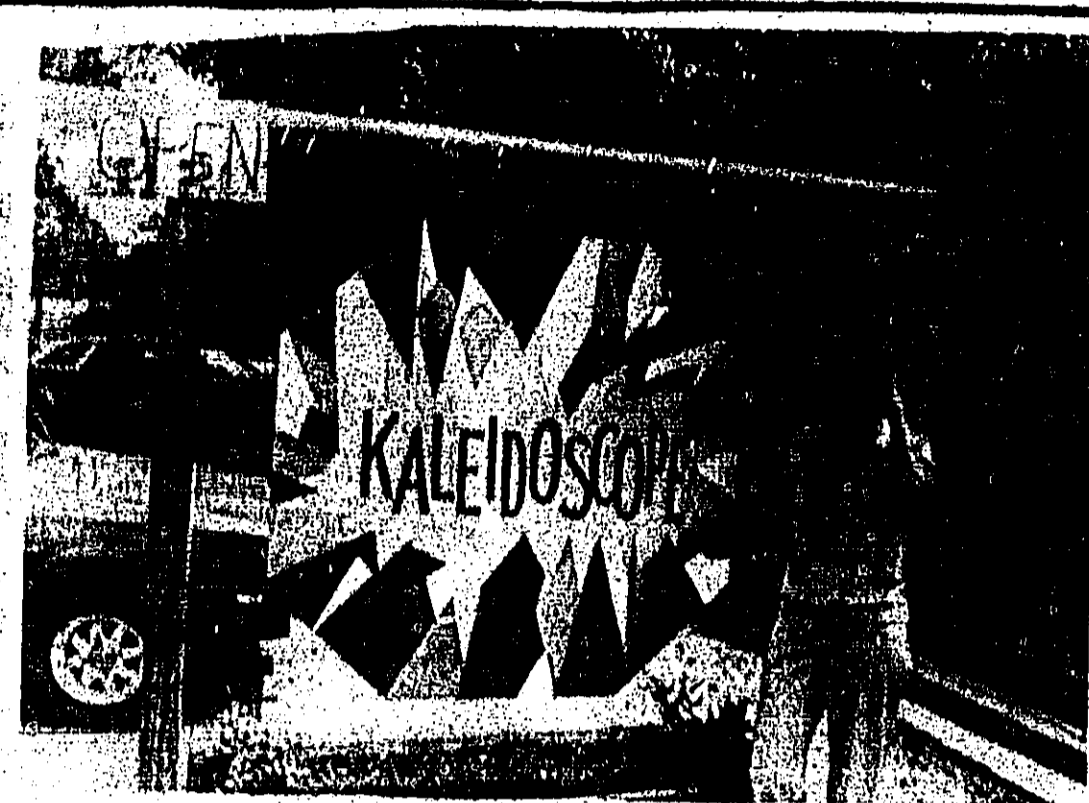


1943 Kirby Reunion A Success

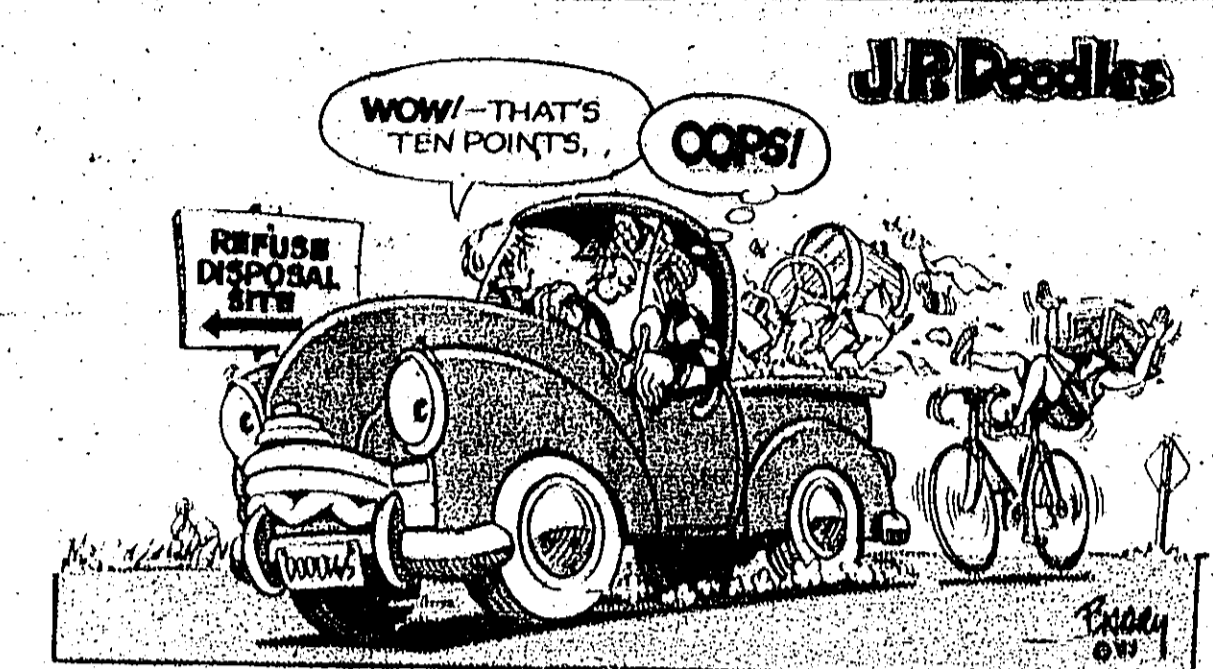
...Well, you don't say those things face to face without inviting some pretty strong verbal abuse.

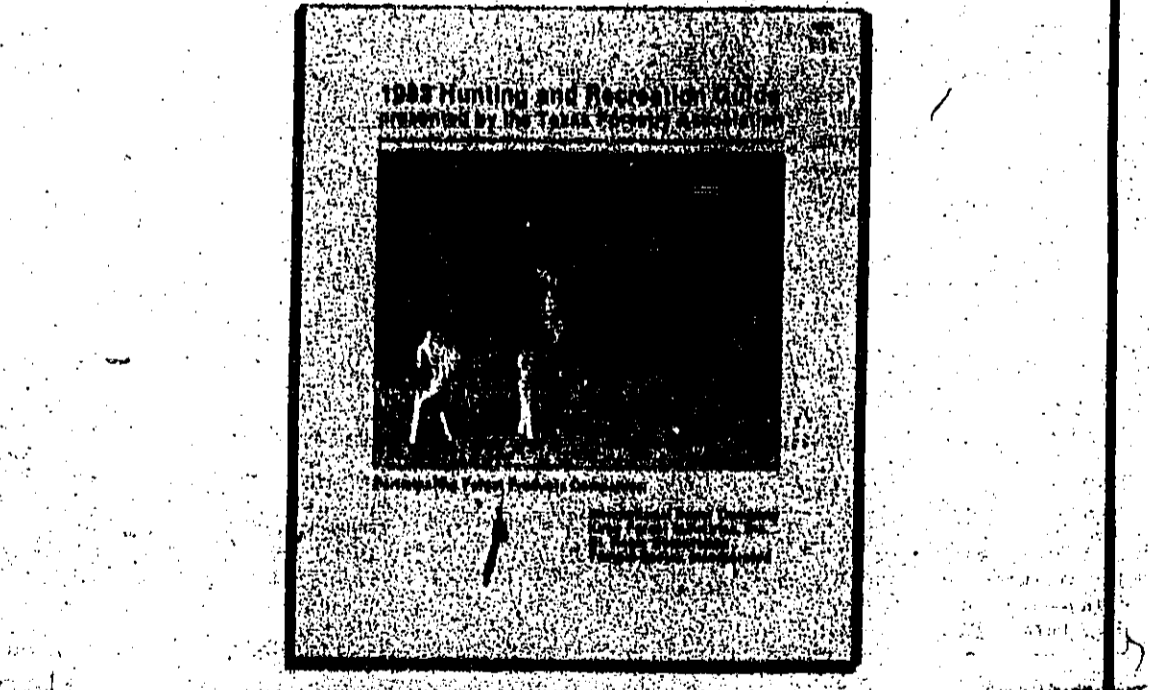

Early morning bird walks are scheduled on Sept. 3 at 7 a.m. and Sept. 24 at 7:30 a.m. A late evening night hike is planned for Sept. 2 at 7:30 p.m.

Why dress yourself in a "Saturn" sunup out of bed before sunrise on a "Saturn" morning tour guide, Marie King knows that the Big Thicket comes alive after dark. Nocturnal animals such as crows, owls, and night hawks are active during the dark hours of the night. The September walks are a good time to observe the hawk migration as well. The Sept. 3 bird walk will be in the Turkey Creek Unit and will begin at the information Station on FM 420, 2 1/2 miles east of U.S. 69 and 7 miles north of Kountze. The Sept. 23 hike will be in the Beech, magnolia, and loblolly pine forest of the Beech Creek Unit. It will begin at the trailhead on FM 2992, 1 1/2 miles north of the FM 420 intersection, west of Spurger. Both walks require a reservation.

East Texas Folk Festival

Producers of wheat, barley, and oats who can qualify for a new Individual Yield Cover age (IYC) plan are of fered higher yield guar antees at no additional cost.

For information about eligibility under the IYC plan, producers should contact an authorized crop insurance agent well in advance of the August 31 deadline. To select an agent, producers may check the list of authorized crop insurance agents available at the county office. Call 283-2241 or write to the ASIS office at 411 North Ross, Woodville.
