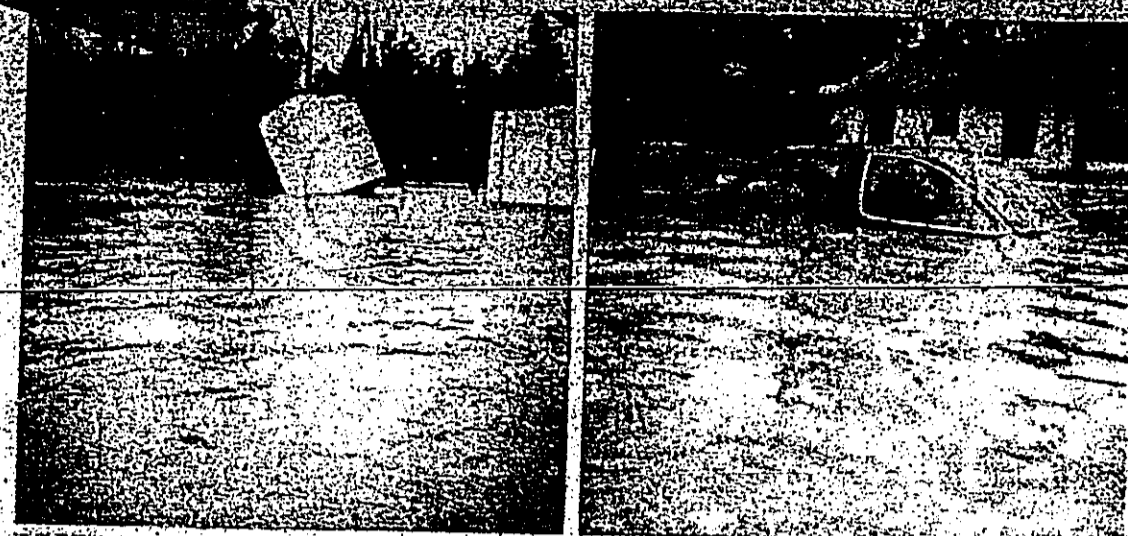

The Honorable Charles Wilson, Congressman, House of Representatives will be the principal speaker at the Annual Meeting of the Deep East Texas Development Association. This meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m., Friday, Feb. 24 at the University Center, Stephen F. Austin University, Nacogdoches, Texas. Congressman Charles Wilson has served the people of East-Texas for 23 years. His election to the Texas Legislature in 1960 was the beginning of a 12 year career in politics at the state level; six years in the Texas House of Representatives; and six in the Texas Senate. Congressman Wilson was born in Trinity, Texas and has lived in Lufkin since 1960. A graduate of the United States Naval Academy with the rank of Lieut-

enant, Wilson served three years active sea duty as gunnery officer on a destroyer and one year in Washington with the Technical Intelligence Branch of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. In Washington, the Congressman represents us on the powerful House Appropriations committee. There his interests center on the National Security of the United States. He is an outspoken and vigorous member of both the defense and foreign affairs subcommittees.


The Spurger girls won their last three games of the season and second place in their district and advance in the play-offs.
