## Reflections Of Europe. Italy And France

Touring Italy from the south to the north was, in my opinion, seeing the best of it. We sailed from Greece to Brindisi, drove to Naples, and caught another boat to the island of Capri. Mount Vesuvius towered above the Naples area, and it was easy to imagine in the distance that it could erupt. The Isle of Capri, which broke off years ago from Sorrento, was a beautiful place. We went to the top of a town called Anacapri, and the view was magnificent.

Florence, the city of Michelangelo, was my favorite place in Italy. Here is housed the famous statue of David, along with many other works of the master. Michelangelo's tomb, along with Galileo's, are in a beautiful church here. And, for the shoppers, Florence can't be beat. The open air markets are full of bargains-you can spend hours in the streets of colorful booths.

Rome was our next stop. The Sistine Chapel was beautiful-it is hard to imagine that one person is responsible for something so large. St. Peter's Cathedral is beautiful, but I found the commercialization of many religious items in and around Vatican City very distasteful. In St. Peter's Square, you could not enjoy the beauty of the place without someone coming up trying to sell you something. The most disgusting sight I have seen on our trip was on a street just outside Vatican City. A small child (approximately 1 1/2 years old) had been left on a street corner to beg.

The little child sat next to a plate of coins and never moved. There were many beggars on the sidewalks of Rome. We visited the Colosseum where the Gladiators fought. Just down the street is a huge arena where the chariot races were held. It was here, not in the Colosseum that the Christians were persecuted. They were thrown to the lions here and also burned on stakes all around the arena to provide light as it grew dark. I had to wonder how courageous I would be if we Christians today faced that kind of persecution.

Venice is best seen at night because you don't see the filth as much then. The canals are quite dirty and it does not look like a city of romance by daylight.

France has been the biggest disappointment of the trip so far. The beaches on the French Riviera did not even compare to the beautiful beaches in the United States. And though the French people seem to think nothing of it, I could not get used to women of all ages going topless on the beach and men changing into their swimsuits in front of you all over the city.

The Louvre is huge-you could spend weeks there. Notre Dame was another beautiful church made more special by the choir singing inside while we were there. Paris is full of museums and historical places, but if you get tired of the city, head for Versailles. The palace is magnificent, but moved to the grounds (250 acres) are not crowded-you can wander for hours marveling at their beauty.

France and Italy...two countries I'm glad I visited, but I wish I had no desire to return.

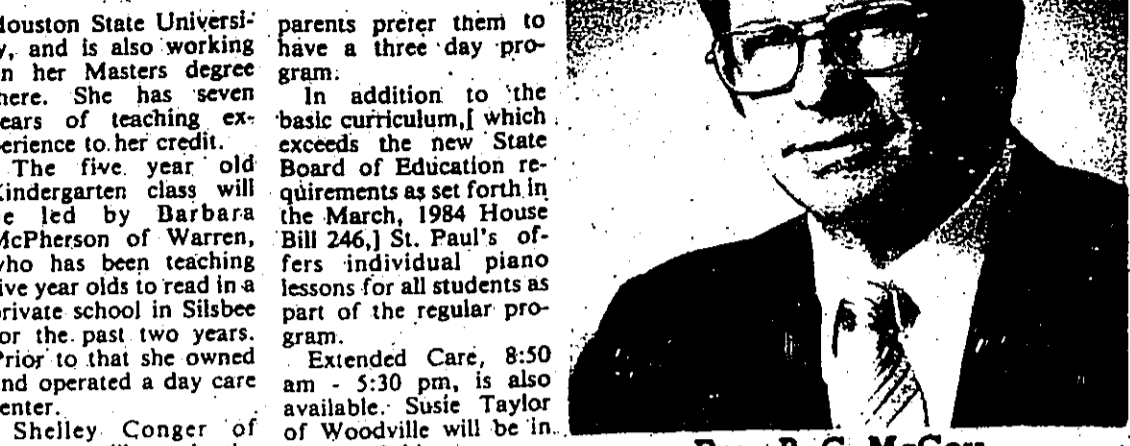

## Editorial 'Integrity?'

The firing of Tyler County Youth Development Center Director Richard Bowen brings to a conclusion a sad and wholly unnecessary chapter in the history of this County's efforts to meet the needs of troubled area youth, through private efforts of Tyler County Citizens.

Bowen was supposedly fired "for lack of technical knowledge and failure to develop administrative abilities necessary." Yet the facts remain that Bowen's performance in this regard was satisfactory enough to warrant state licensing just a few days before.

"Lack of technical knowledge" really implies that Bowen did not speak "governmentese" with the same accent as does the primarily career government employee leadership of the TYCDC Board of Directors.

At a June 25th meeting of the Board of Directors, Board Member and County Probation Worker, Kenny Simpson, suggested that Bowen might have problems making a presentation to the Jasper United Fund "because of the general way he answers our Board's questions."

THE BOOSTER does not dispute the need for experts such as Simpson to sit on the Board but we do not in any way see the board of a community-originated and supported project, such as TYCDC must be controlled by the courthouse and state-house civil servants to work effectively with youth.

The Solution is in the question: Where are the dedicated cadre of ministers, farmers, doctors and small businessmen who are and have been the heart and soul of so many public spirited enterprises in our Community.

Several positions on the Board of Directors as well as selection of a new Shelter Director will be filled in the next few months. THE BOOSTER urges the TYCDC Board of Directors to use this opportunity to nominate candidates for these positions which will broaden the representation of the TYCDC Board further beyond the "courthouse square."

Likewise, will the appointment of a new Shelter Director represent a genuine attempt to create a "home-like environment for Sheltering run-away or other troubled youth?" Or, will the Board appointment represent merely an advancement in the professional career of one drawn from "courthouse-state agency circles of friends and associates?"

When the \$165,000 of taxpayer provided start-up funds run out and beyond any funds which might be provided from other private foundations; the main ingredient which will determine whether this Shelter will continue successfully to keep its doors open will be the continued strong support of the citizens of this County. It is Our Project!

THE BOOSTER believes that an organization shouldn't ask a man to "quarterback" the team then ask him to be the "water-boy". Encouragement from the TYCDC membership and the community as a whole for Bowen to use his options of appeal, in re-seeking the directorship will make the next director of the Youth Development Center, at least, know what he needs from his operating board before he takes the job. Bowen, we feel, didn't get that chance.

This plastic box is a network interface. That's where you join the local telephone network, which can also connect you to a long distance network.

It's this box where we terminate a pair of wires from our switching center to your residence. That's technically where our service ends, but not our concern for our customers. We want you to understand the importance of this interface device and the other changes which have taken place with the breakup of the Bell System so that you can relax and continue to enjoy good telephone service.

The network interface is being installed on the outside of most new homes, usually adjacent to the power meter. For others it may be found on the wall of a walk-in closet, a utility room or garage. Southwestern Bell Telephone began installing network interfaces in 1982, therefore wiring installed prior to 1982 may not have a network interface. Unfortunately, not all of the older network interfaces are exact look-alikes, but they are similar.

From the network interface, you have at least three options on how to handle installation and repair of inside wiring and jacks to your telephones:

- (1) hire Southwestern Bell Telephone to do it.
- (2) hire another contractor.
- (3) save the money by doing the work yourself.

(Materials are readily available from numerous retail stores.)  
If you choose Southwestern Bell Telephone to do the inside work, you should know about recently approved "Premises Work Charges," which include both time and materials. Premises Work

Charges are billed according to the time required to do the job. Here is Southwestern Bell Telephone's schedule of charges:

These charges are similar to those made by other service personnel for work performed on customers' premises. Remember, too, that while inside wiring and the workmanship required to install or repair it may be obtained from many sources today, wire is not in the business, if that's your choice.

When we complete the work, you get a 30-day warranty against defects and malfunctions from the date of installation or repair. For your convenience, keep your Southwestern Bell Telephone warranty handy.

We sincerely hope this information will be helpful to you in the future. We know most of our customers still have a lot of questions about the changes which have taken place since divestiture.

While we are no longer responsible for every facet of your telephone service like we used to be, serving you is still our only business. After all, it's AT&T we separated from, not you.
