Herrington, never the less, told the BOOSTER Monday that an estimated \$5 million project was now underway for Woodville called the "Cracker Barrel Mall", to be completed by September 1, 1984. According to "Alexandria-Town-Talk" Publisher, Tom Hardin, "Herrington has apparently moved to greener pastures in Woodville because he only dumped two loads of dirt on the project here." The Alexandria-Town-Talk staff watched the Mall project fizzle saying they were obviously "embarrassed" when nothing came of it. Herrington has "sold" his project here also to The Tyler County Commissioners Court and to the Woodville City Council by using them as a forum to "announce" his new idea for our area. Both governmental entities have "wished him well in his venture."

Metal Production Firm Eyes Woodville

The Texas Metals Company of Beaumont, a metal pipe flange producer, still, despite adverse strike conditions in Beaumont, plans to move part of its operation to Woodville soon and will occupy a 20 acre tract offered by a Tyler County industrial group if plans remain on schedule, according to George Morgan, Jr., a representative of the company. The Texas Metals Company will reportedly become a neighbor to the former Lexington Products Company. Early prospects for the firm include hiring a startup crew of 14 and expanding, officials say, to a possible 200. The firm billings would be "in the millions," the same official said.

In the past 20 years under his direction, the department has grown to be the largest state or regional chamber tourist association in America. Frank Hildebrand, Executive Director of the Texas Tourist Development Agency noted that along the way, Rosser's department has posted a number of firsts in Texas Tourism. 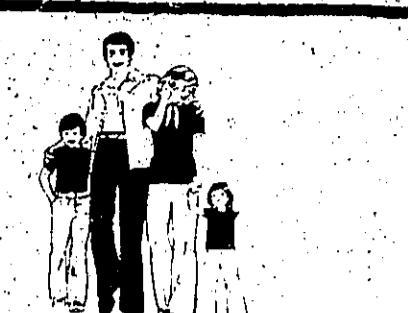

There is a method to eating smorgasbord that is much different from our pile-it-on-and-dig-in-to-the-elbows technique which the Danes consider quite rude. You first pick up a plate and fill it up with as much fish as you want. Go to your table, eat the fish, then-leaving them...

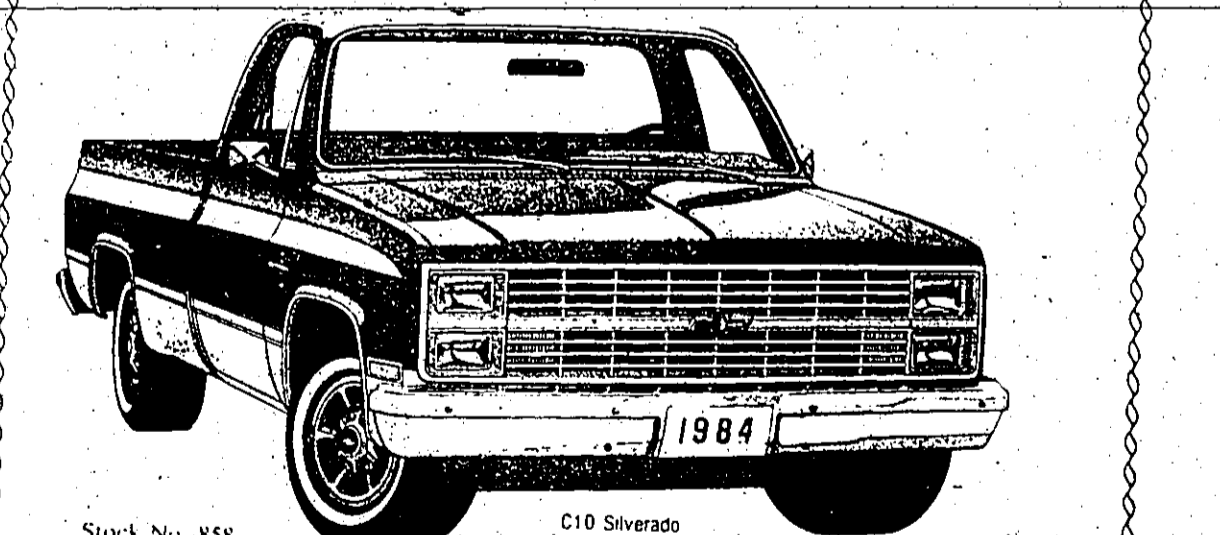

With the theme "Present and Future Progress," more than 200 youth and adult representatives including Niki Minter, Danny Jordan and Carol Whitehead of Spurger, recently attended the American Cancer Society's seventh annual "Youth Against Cancer" Conference in San Antonio.

The statewide meeting designed to involve high school students in local cancer control activities was held June 27-28 at Trinity University. The conference was the first of its kind since the 1920's when the word "cancer" was rarely mentioned.
