

District To Protest Tax Board Budget

"I know what several of these people were doing a couple of years ago and it sure wasn't \$18,000 worth," said Woodville School Board President Alva Cook after a protest of the 1985 Budget of the Tyler County Tax Appraisal Board was approved by the Woodville

School Board meeting last Tuesday night September 18. Woodville School trustees objected to the payment by the Appraisal Board of health insurance coverage for the families of Appraisal Board employees rather than paying only for the employees and also ques-

tioned the salary levels of Appraisal Board employees. Woodville School Board representative on the Tax Appraisal Board Beth Allison, who previously voted for the 1985 Budget on the Appraisal Board was not present at Tuesday's meeting. In order for the protest to

succeed a majority of the Appraisal Board members must object to the Budget by the end of September. Woodville Trustees voted to appoint district Tax Assessor-Collector Erma Hickman to prepare a protest of State Tax Appraisal Board Values. Hickman said

she had recently received two downward revisions in the state appraisal values. State Tax Board Appraisal Values are used in computing the wealth of the school district and determines how much state aid the district receives. "They are a lot closer to the Tyler County Tax Board values than they were," said Hickman.

Hickman presented Woodville School Board members with estimates of tax income produced by several different tax rates. Examples sup-
