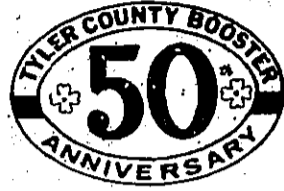

E & L Chipper Mill Plant Could Add 150 Jobs

Issuance of \$4 million in revenue bonds for construction of a proposed chipper plant by E and L Lumber Company south of Woodville was the subject of a public hearing and vote of approval by the Tyler County Industrial Finance Corporation Board of Directors including Tom Knapp, Robert Allison, and John Coker.

regular commissioners Court meeting for the month of December. The construction bonds will be issued through the Houston law firm of Vinson and Elkins and purchased by Lufkin's Republic Bank for a period of eleven years bearing interest of 80 percent of prime. Neither Tyler County or The Tyler County Industrial Finance Corporation are financially responsible for the bonds according to

Finance Corporation lawyer Robert Cain of Lufkin. Tyler County Commissioner's will actually approve the issuance of the bonds at a December 31 meeting. "This should create jobs, mainly timber cutting, for about 50 workers and if everything goes as planned could increase to about 150 workers," according to E and L co-owner Buddy Lowery. "The timber cutting should be started in about two

months and the plant should be open in about eight to ten months," said Lowery. Commissioner's in other action, on a motion by Jerry Mahan voted to hold county financial support to the Warren Volunteer Fire Department following allegations of selective covering of fires in the Warren area in the past by chief of the newly created Warren Community Volunteer Fire Department George McCuen and Tyler County Firefighters Association Chairman Paul Massart. The Warren Volunteer Fire Department now consisting of one man, Billy Burks according to McCuen.

The Department headed by Burks is the only county department not in the County Firefighters Association according to Massart. Commissioner's on a motion by Bo Jordan voted to request Burks to bring his books to Commissioner's Court to account for expenditure of \$125 per month of County funds provided the department. Commissioner's voted to extend with the area on the Job Training Program providing half the salary for clerk Jeanette Duet's position in Justice of the Peace Wanda Brasher's office. Brasher reports recent monthly case loads for her office have increased from 300 to 674 requiring secretaries to work to 6 or 7 p.m. two or three evenings a week to keep up with the paper work. Council Meets

Several Woodville residents, including Phoebe Armstrong, questioned City Council Monday night about last months increases in sewer charges which in some instances were higher than their corresponding water bills. City Secretary Walt Davis said that the city of Woodville was required by the State of Texas to use a "users fee" based on water use to pay for the \$650,000 city's part of bonds used for repairs to one city sewer plant and construction of another sewer plant. Davis said after several months experience with the \$1.15 per thousand gallon sewer fee that city would probably establish a 10,000 gallon "or maybe lower" maximum on the sewer fee. Woodville City Fathers also passed on a 5

cent per 1,000 cubic foot increase in gas rate from Tennessee Gas raising the city rate from \$5.90 per 1,000 cubic foot to \$5.95 per cubic foot. A request was granted to David Feagan for permission to extend city gas and water lines some 500 ft. along Hwy 190 east at his expense. City Fathers also approved the Weaver and Smith annual audit for the 1984 fiscal year and appointed Woodville contractor-developer Lloyd Fortenberry as city representative on the Tyler County Tax Appraisal Review Board. Council discussed repairing existing garbage truck and buying a new truck and approved an option of leasing new dumpsters for \$20 per month or purchasing the dumpsters by city business.

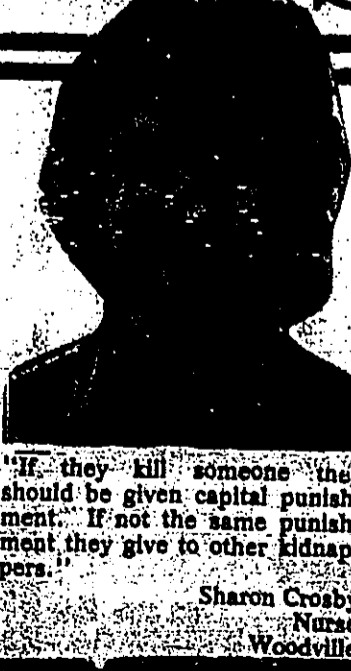

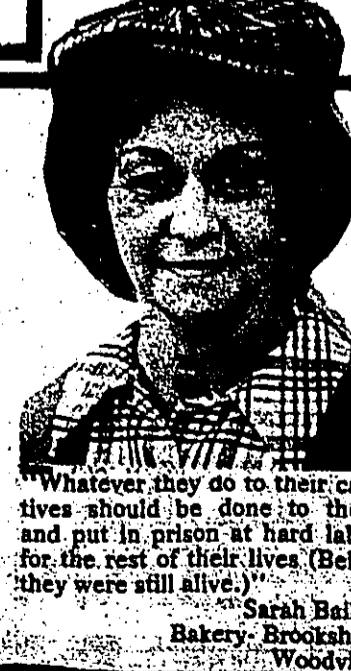

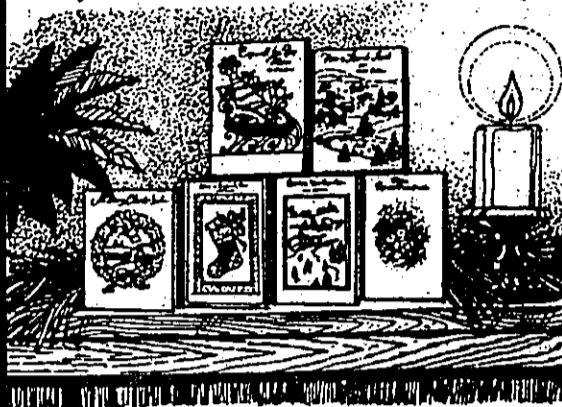
Woodville 4-Hers Win Blue Ribbons
