## DPS Warns 'Drive Safely'

AUSTIN - The Texas Department of Public Safety estimates that as many as 17 people will die in traffic accidents in the state during the 30-hour July 4 holiday period. "Though this year's estimate is lower than last year's death toll, the final figure could be even lower if Texans refrained from drinking and driving, stayed within the speed limit and buckled their safety belts," said Colonel Jim Adams, director of the DPS. Last year, 20 persons died in crashes on Texas streets and highways during the July 4 holiday period. Three additional fatalities resulting from serious injuries during the period pushed the final toll to 23. "This year's estimate of 17 deaths compared to the higher number of fatalities last year is in keeping with a downward trend in Texas traffic fatalities," said Adams. In 1984, 48 per cent of the fatalities reported during the July 4 period resulted from accidents in which speed or DWI was listed as a contributing factor. "In an effort to limit the number of deaths, additional DPS troopers will again be patrolling rural roads and highways during the holiday period," Adams said. Citizens State Bank will be closed Thursday, July 4 in observance of Independence Day.

The Blood Center of Southeast Texas is holding its annual blood drive Tuesday, July 16 at the United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall in Woodville at 10 a.m. through 1 p.m. and from 2:30 p.m. through 5:30 p.m. The community coordinator is Gwen Steiling, R.M. from the Tyler County Hospital. A mini-physical will be taken of each donor which includes blood pressure, temperature, pulse and testing of your blood to make sure you have enough red cells to share. The whole procedure takes about thirty minutes. Only volunteer donors are accepted.

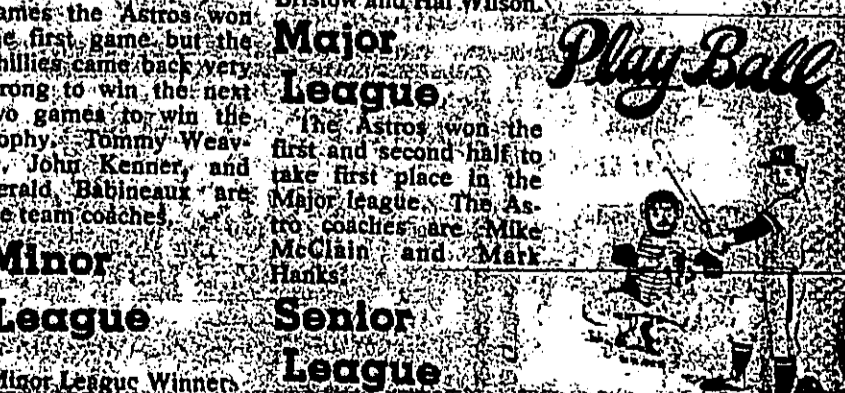


All Star Schedule
