The church of the New Testamen has no proper name, but is referred to as the church. Acts 2:47(). It needed no name to distinguish. Meanwhile you are condially invited to attend the services of the chiral of Conse

distinguish it from others for no other churches existed in the days of the apost ties. All of the terms which are found in the Bible are descriptive of what the church is and to whom it belongs. The members were the name "Christian" (Acts 11:26; I Peter 4:16). They are also described as "saints": (one set apart); "disciples": (followers); and "brethren" (members of the same family). There is no New Testament references to "kinds of Christians." We look at the organization of the church

in Bible times. It had only one universal head - Christ (Matthew 28:18; Ephesians 1:22). Elders were the overseers of a local congregation (Acts 14:23). They tended to the work of the local church only (I Peter 5:1-3 and Acts 20:28). They must be scripturally qualified (I Timothy 3:1-7). Deacons, as their name indicates, are special servants (I Timothy 3:8-13). These individuals, the elders, guided the local followers in the footsteps of Christ - not in their think
