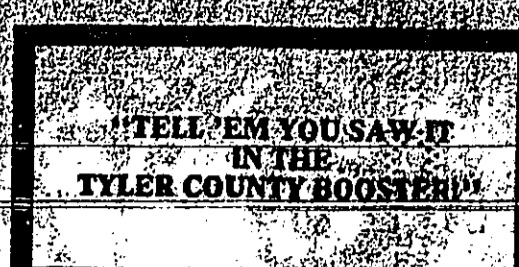

Warren School Board

Budget Study Underway

The Warren Independent School District Board of Trustees held their annual Budget Study Tuesday, July 11, 1985. The new budget being considered is approximately \$3,500,000. The proposed budget will be discussed again at the Board Meeting.

The Board voted to ask the Texas Education Agency for a delay of one year in implementing a Pre-Kindergarten Program for the District. A delay will also be asked for in adding a class at Fred Elementary that has twenty-seven students.

According to Monitor Lee Myers, "If you don't have the room, you can delay it one year."

The Board discussed the possibility of bringing all sixth grade students from Fred to the Junior High Campus beginning with the 1985-86 school year. In the past, these students have had the option of coming to the Junior High or staying at Fred Elementary.

Warren students promote to Junior High their sixth grade year. It was the consensus of the Board that it would benefit the students if they all started Junior High School at the same time. The issue will be discussed again at the Regular Board Meeting July 23, and all Fred parents will be encouraged to attend this meeting.

The Board accepted

the resignation of Athletic Director Rick Brazzell effective the end of July. Requesting to be heard in Open Session, Coach Brazzell outlined his "feelings of betrayal by the District." He stated that "when he came to Warren, he made a three-year commitment, which even included buying a house in the community." Brazzell said that

"because his wife's contract had not been renewed, he could not financially afford to stay." He stated that Independent School District "he wished only the best for the athletes in Warren." Brazzell has accepted a coaching position with Hull-Ida.

Rehab Center Offers Varied Services

Texas Hospitals, published monthly by the Texas Hospital Association, recently featured Tyler County Hospital with an accompanying article on its Rehabilitation Center.

The issue focused on rural health care. Bob

Boykin photographed the hospital for Rehabilitation Coordinator, Dedo Cordes, who writes the hospital article. Through the support of the hospital Board of Directors, the hospital based rehab center offers both inpatient and outpatient therapeutic services seldom obtained in rural communities.

Numerous referrals have originated from

The rehabilitation staff treats patients affected by amputation, aphasia, arthritis, athletic injuries, burns, cerebral palsy, cardiovascular accidents, cranial accidents, cleft-palate conditions, delayed language, dysfluency, dyslexia, emotional disturbances, hearing difficulties, learning disabilities, mental retardation, muscular dystrophy, orthopedic involvements and parkinsonism.

This vital rehabilitation program is even more significant since implementation of the prospective payment system. Providing comprehensive patient care on an outpatient basis, the nexus of the rehabilitation center had minimized hospital stays and maximized cost effectiveness without compro-

missing quality health care.

In addition to therapeutic services for the hospitalized patients and outpatients, assistance is available to area nursing homes, day care centers, and Polk County school children and clients of Deep East Texas MHRM, and Department of Human Resource and Tri-County Head Start.

The therapists' work profiles vary. The licensed occupational therapist treats toddlers with balancing and crawling limitations, and stroke patients displaying hand dysfunction. The occupational therapist assists patients in acquiring and/or regaining autonomous activities of daily living, such as feeding, dressing, grooming and homemaking. Occupational therapy emphasizes sequentially building strength and functional abilities in the upper extremities through programs of activity and exercises.

Speech pathologists treat cleft-palate youngsters with voice and articulation disorders, delayed language toddlers with limited communication skills, laryngectomies, stroke patients with receptive-expressive language deficits and hard of hearing adults. Auditory training, mirror exercises, breathing techniques and articulation skills are incorporated into therapy sessions, addressing the different language modalities—listening, speaking, reading and writing. Closely interrelating with the referral source and family members, the speech pathologist coordinates

the patient's total language process, developing and/or restoring the highest level of functional communication possible.

The licensed physical therapist treats amputees, stroke patients with paralysis, individuals with chronic back pain and patients with mobility limitations. Stationary bicycle exercises, traction, tilt-table, deep-heat and/or ultrasound treatments of diathermy, hot-packs, and the whirlpool frequently are employed by the physical therapist. He teaches patients the essential skills of mobility through muscle re-training.

Chipper Mill To Open

On February 18, 1985, construction of the new chipper mill began at E & L Lumber Co., located south of Woodville, on Hwy 69. The mill is owned by Buddy and Lester Lowery.

On that day, according to Mike Herring, mill superintendent, the dirt foundation was landscaped in preparation for the first stage of construction, the Marathon LeTourneau JC-40 Jib Crane purchased from Lumberville, Texas.

Three hundred yards of cement was poured by Ready Mix Concrete of Woodville, for the foundation. Immediately following was construction of the crane.

The 300,000 pound crane was delivered to E & L in a 100-ton trailer. Delivery required a truckload.

Construction superintendent is Derryle Davison. Foremen are Tom and Tim Tillman. Flair Construction, has employed approximately twenty employees for the chipper mill job.

The 100 foot, or twelve story high crane structure was completed in 2 days, and is at this time waiting electrical hook-up.

The crane consists primarily of a free-standing column, 120 foot main boom with grapple, counterweight bobbin, consisting of 95,000 pounds in cement blocks, and the five foot by five foot operation cab.

The free-standing column allows use of all space under the boom. The column and travelling trolley (grapple) has a variable working radius of eight feet to 24 feet, maximum.

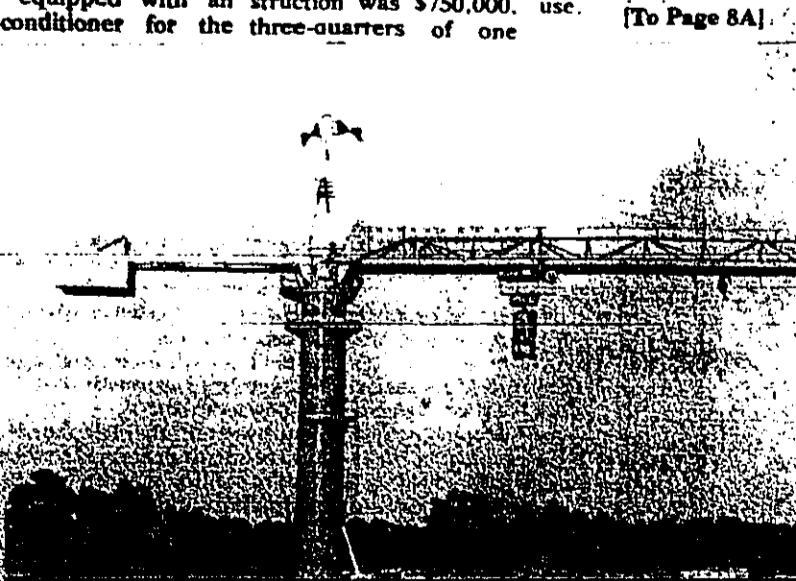
The five foot by five foot cab consists of windows on all four sides. It's equipped with an air-conditioner for the operators convenience.

The column provides drive-through traffic patterns for truck unloading and straight line truck staging. Maneuvering is eliminated. The result is a capability of unloading 100 trucks per shift. According to Herring, the shifts will either be 2-8 hour shifts or 4-12 hour shifts.

Six foot grapple offers optimum design for unloading trucks, retrieval and deck's infeed services without swinging the crane boom.

The crane has a capacity of lifting 40,000 pounds or 20 tons.

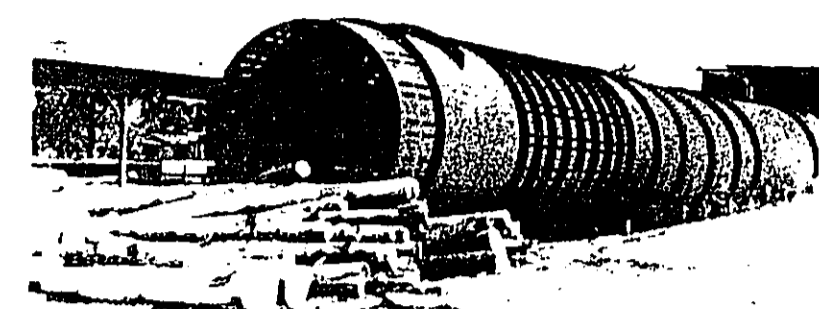

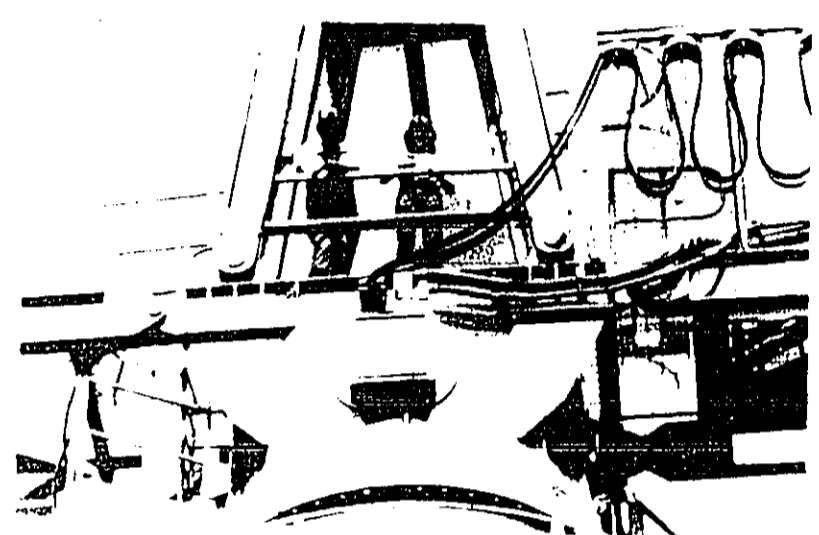
Chipper Mill To Open

Separating the crane from the infeed chute is a cement retaining wall. This wall is used mainly for protection purposes, and for the convenience of truck unloading position. The logs that are positioned around the outfeed area, and chipper are still under construction at this time. The logs that are processed through the chipper are fed into the drum.



A ninety-foot debarking drum, shown above, will serve as a major addition to the Chipper Mill. The logs travel through the spinning drum while the bark is actually beaten from them.

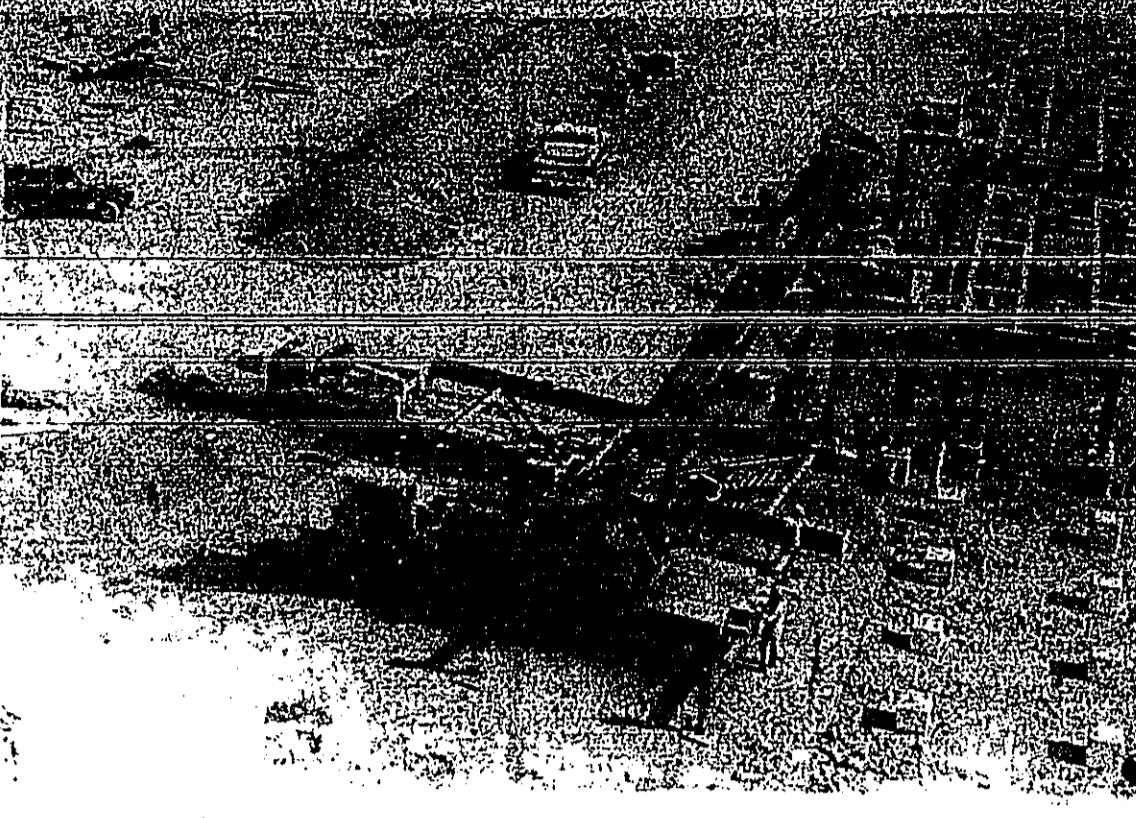

The drum is a specialized component. The drum's diameter is 90 feet, which are less than long by twice the diameter. This drum is divided into 36 sections. 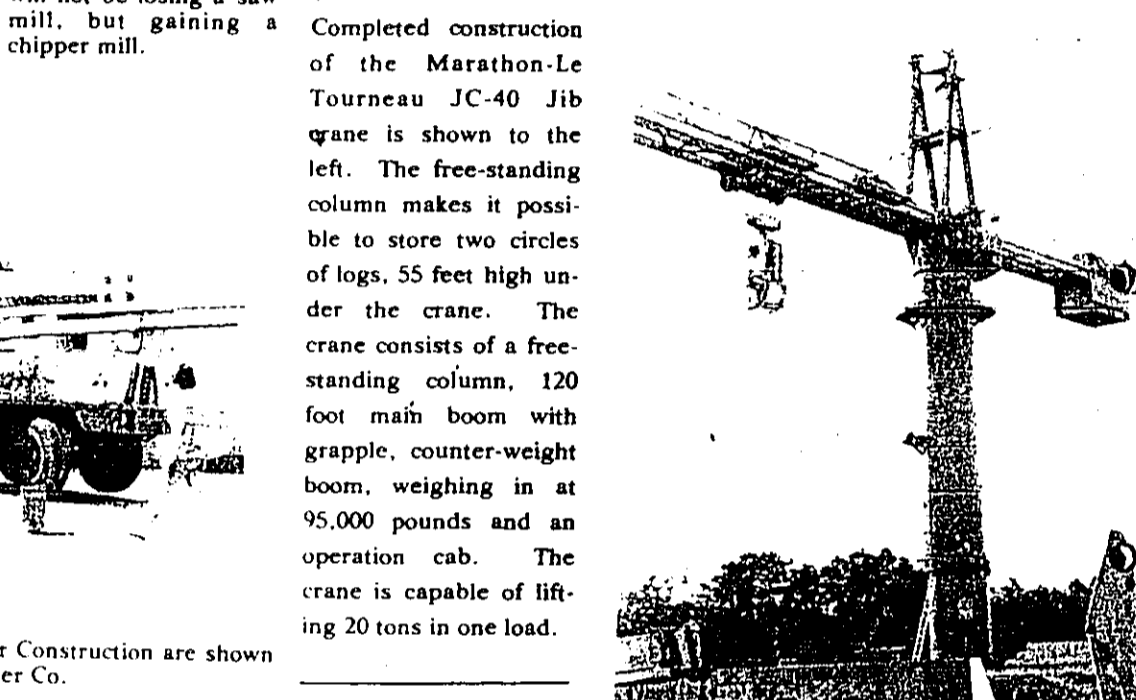
The entire chipper mill, consisting of all machinery, construction and 2000 plus yards of cement poured, has a total cost of several million dollars, according to Herring. Buddy and Lester Lowery of Huntington, have owned E & L Lumber Co. for 18 years. They also own the Lowery Bros Chip Mill in Moscow, Texas, approximately 35 miles from Woodville.

The E & L Lumber Co., now producing specialty as a sawmill, will convert to a chipper mill. The chipper mill will be a conveyor belt then processed through a shaker screen which separates the "too small" or "too big" chips from the accurate size needed. A conveyor belt then

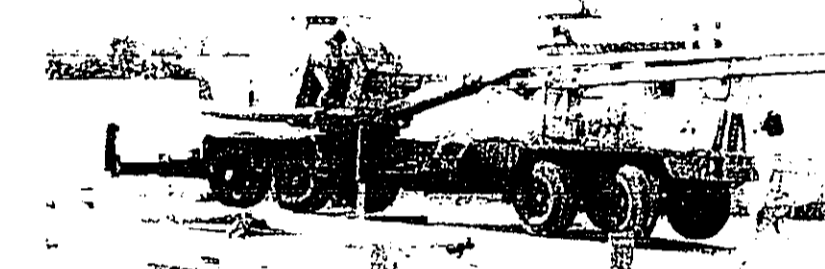

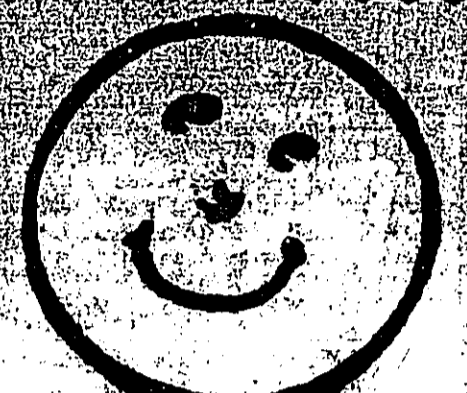

Just Thinking

We are discussing what it is in body the gospel and be Jesus a Christian. Last week's article mentions faith and repentance. Let us continue:

One must confess his or her faith in Jesus Christ. With the mouth confession is made unto salvation, Romans 10:10. This confession is the belief that Jesus is God's Son.

One must be baptized into Christ for the remission of one's sins. The scriptural subjects are penitent believers who confess Christ, therefore no infants were baptized in New Testament days, only "men and women," Acts 8:32.

Baptism is an immersion, for that is its meaning. Sprinkling is not the word used nor the mode described. However, a burial is both referred to and described, Romans 6:4-5; Acts 8:38-39.

Baptism is for the remission of sins, Acts 2:38. The blood of Christ was shed for the remission of sins, Matthew 26:28, and it is in the act of baptism we receive the atoning benefits of His blood. We are baptized into His death, Romans 6:3-4. We put off the body of the sins of the flesh in baptism, Colossians 2:11-13. We are baptized into Jesus Christ and thereby put on Christ, Galatians 3:27. By baptism we "wash away our sins," Acts 22:16. It is the time at which we are born again, John 3:5.

Baptism is done by the authority of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Matthew 28:19. There are many baptisms taught by men that differ from this scriptural pattern, but they cannot be the "one baptism" of the Bible, Ephesians 4:5. That which is "in the name of the Lord" Acts 10:48, must be by His authority, thus in obedience to His commandments.





