Free Hunt Permits 'On Limited Basis'

A limited number of free hunting permits will be available to the public again this year for portions of the Big Thicket National Preserve. Superintendent Thomas E. Lubbert announced today.

Deer, squirrel, rabbit, wild hog, and waterfowl hunting will be allowed by permit in portions of the Lance Rosier, Big Sandy, Jack Gore Baygall, Neches Bottom and Beaumont Units of the Preserve. Shotguns, 22 rifles, or bow and arrow may be used in these units. In addition, an archery-only deer season will be available in portions of the Beech Creek Unit, and muzzle loaded rifles will be permissible in the Lance Rosier Unit.

A "Group Permit" system for a party up to 4 individuals will be available this year. Children 12 years old and under do not need to apply for a permit if they intend to hunt with a permitted adult.

Applications for permits can be obtained July 29-August 16 at

any one of the following National Park Service offices listed below:

Big Thicket National Preserve Headquarters, 8185 Eastern Freeway, Beaumont. Open 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Mon-Fri. North District Office, 503 Pine, Woodville. Open 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Mon-Fri. Visitor Information Station, 10 miles north of entrance of FM 420. Open 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily.

Persons may also obtain hunting application forms by sending a postcard to Big Thicket National Preserve, P.O. Box 7408, Beaumont, TX 77706. (Indicate which Unit you wish to hunt in on the post card.) Letter or telephone requests will not be accepted.

All completed applications must be received by the National Park Service no later than 4:30 p.m. Friday August 16, 1985. A drawing for the permits may be required, depending upon the number of applications received for each unit.

Retired pastor, J.P. Owens of Woodville, is planning a trip to Australia July 31.

Owens, along with approximately 400 other people are planning on taking a "Partnership Crusade."

Owens and Rev. J.T. Riley, pastor of Colmes-

neil First Baptist Church are the only individuals from this area who are taking part in the venture.

Liverpool Baptist Church, in Sydney, Australia is the destination point of Owens. He will be pastoring in Liverpool Baptist Church for eight days.

Whittlin' Sid Displays Craft

When the curtain rises on the 14th Annual Texas Folklife Festival August 1-4, the drama of Texas' rich past is brought back to life through a cast and crew which includes the talents of whittler Sid Owens of Woodville.

Owens brings more than 50 years of whittling experience to the Festival. He began learning his craft when he was about 10 years old. "My father wouldn't loan me his knife unless I had something to do with it, so I started whittling," he explains.

Sponsored by The University of Texas Institute of Texan Cultures in San Antonio, the Festival is an annual extravaganza dramatizing the state's ethnic diversity and pioneer heritage. A cast of nearly 6000 participants from counties throughout the state, including Tyler, share the folkways of their ancestors for an audience composed of more than 100,000 visitors. During the Festival's four-day run, the Institute's grounds are transformed into a 15-acre outdoor theater featuring scenes of pioneer Texas, culinary delights from the many ethnic groups who settled and developed the state, and 10 stages of whittling entertainment.

Headlining the event is the "Back to the Olden Days" for the Festival.

The Festival's log kitchen is the stage for the drama of Texas' rich past is brought back to life through a cast and crew which includes the talents of whittler Sid Owens of Woodville.

Smiths ply their trade. Others are cast as quilters and roof thatchers, sheep shearers and goose pluckers. Impromptu audience participation is encouraged.

Providing the soundtrack are musicians playing an accompanying score with bagpipes, zithers, dulcimers, flamenco guitars and other traditional instruments. The soundtrack includes everything from foot-stomping swing music to soulful gospel tunes.

An array of palate-pleasing foods await enthusiasts of the Festival's multi-cultural theater. The playbill features Scottish haggis and lebanese kibbe (meat loaf), which can be followed with a command performance of Wendish noodles and Ukrainian varaneke (potato-stuffed dumpling).

Dancing is yet another highlight of the Festival program of activities. Performers clad in colorful costumes present the folk dances of Chile, Norway, Mexico, Poland and many others. Audience members are offered the chance to perform center stage in the celebrated Filipino tinkling dance.

Festival curtain times are 5-11 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 1; noon to 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday, Aug. 2 and 3; and noon to 10 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 4.

Admission is \$5 for adults, \$1 for children ages 6-12 and free for children under 6. For more information or to order tickets, call 512-226-2651.


