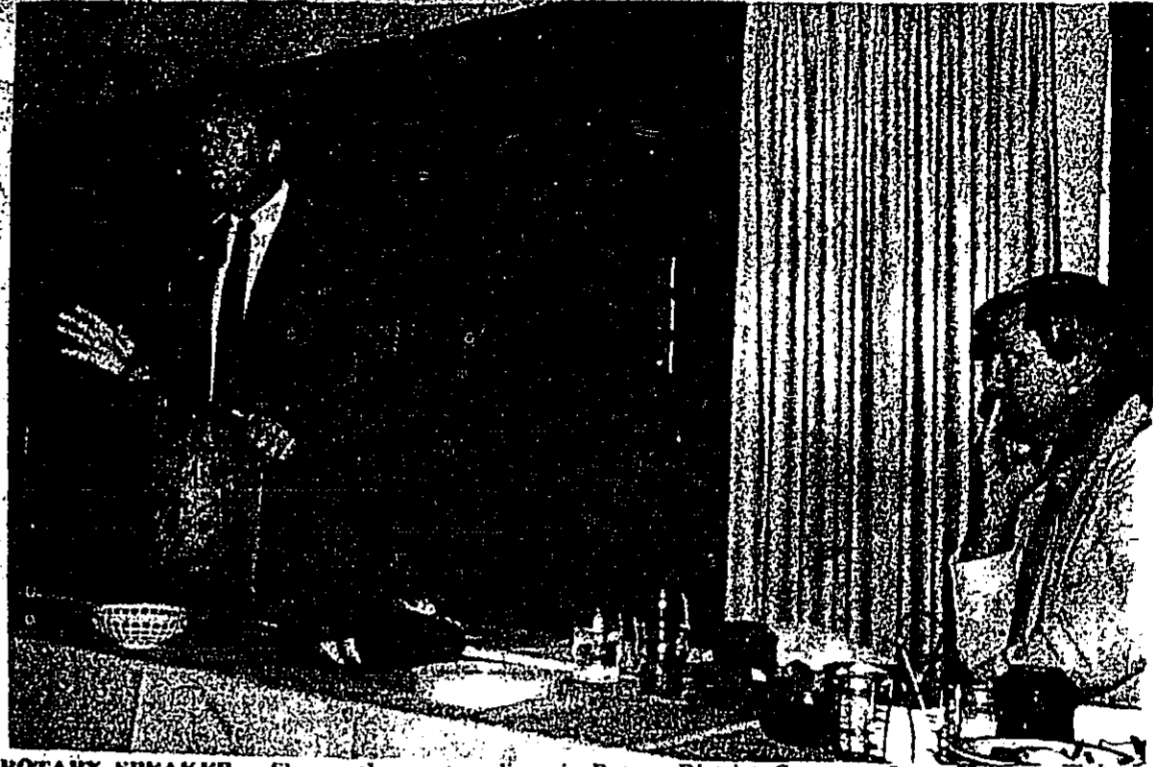

## Schools Open Sept. 3

The schools of the Woodville Independent School District will open for all students on Tuesday, September 3. Teachers begin their work year on Monday, August 26, according to Dorman Jackson, school superintendent. The school registration for all senior high school students new to Woodville Public Schools, or who attended Woodville schools but failed to register before the end of school in May, should register now at the principal's office in the Woodville High School building. Students in grades 6-8 who are new to Woodville should also register now at the middle school principal's office on the high school campus. Students in grades K-3 who are new to the Woodville schools or who did not register in the spring should enroll now at the principal's office at the Wheat school building from 8:30 am to 3 p.m. Students in grades 4-5 should register at the principal's office in the Woodville Intermediate School at 405 N. Charlton, Tuesday, September 3, will be the first day of classroom instruction, and will be the first day that school buses will operate.
