Contract End Eyed

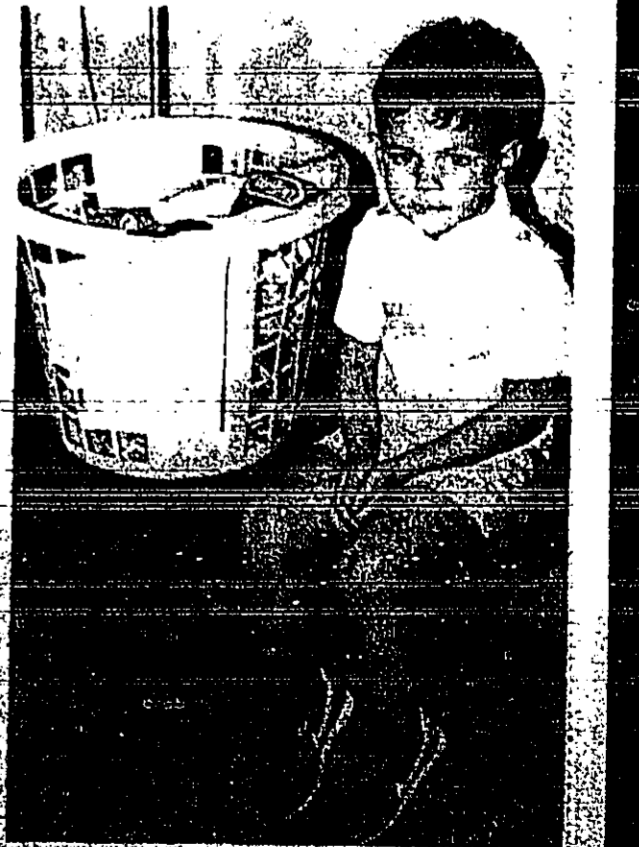
Following Executive Session Tuesday, September 24, 1985, the Warren Independent School District Board of Trustees moved forward with their intent to terminate suspended Superintendent Adolph Hryhorchuk. The motion made by Board Member Walter McPherson and seconded by Board Member Ben Read stated, "I move that the Board authorize Mr. Davis as President of the Board, to serve Mr. Adolph Hryhorchuk with a Notice of Intent to Terminate his contract and that Mr. Hryhorchuk be given due process as required by the Constitution and laws of this State and of the United States." The vote was unanimously in favor of the motion. According to Board President Harold Davis, the Notice had not been served as of Monday, September 30, but would be shortly. Pat Long, President of the Warren Unit of the Texas State Teachers Association, was very complimentary in her address to the Board. She stated, "We are very proud of the work you are doing on behalf of the students and employees of this district. Your task has not been an easy one, but you have been steadfast in doing everything possible to make our district the best it can be, and we are in full support of you. The evidence is all around us each day. Many of us have been in the district for several years and we have never seen morale higher, nor a more cooperative spirit on all campuses. We want to work with you in every possible way to ensure quality education for Warren ISD." The Board approved an expenditure in the amount of \$250, for the school nurse to attend a workshop, \$816, annually for private transportation for the child of Carl Swinney, \$5,000 for the Texas Association of School Boards to do policy updates, and \$1,895, for purchase of a Hydro-Spa for the Athletic Training Room. The Board approved the request by the Warren Volunteer Fire Department for use of the Junior High Cafeteria for a Bar-B-Que Dinner before the Homecoming Game October 25. The 1985-86 Career Ladder Committee was approved. Named on the Committee were Dixie Weeks, Neal Morgan and Alan Mitchell. A first reading was held on the Liason Committee Policy and the "Eligibility for Career Ladder - New Employees" Policy. The Board again tables a vote on the Power Master Energy Conservation Contract. Don Richey was employed as an English-Language Arts teacher for the High School subject to certification and permit.



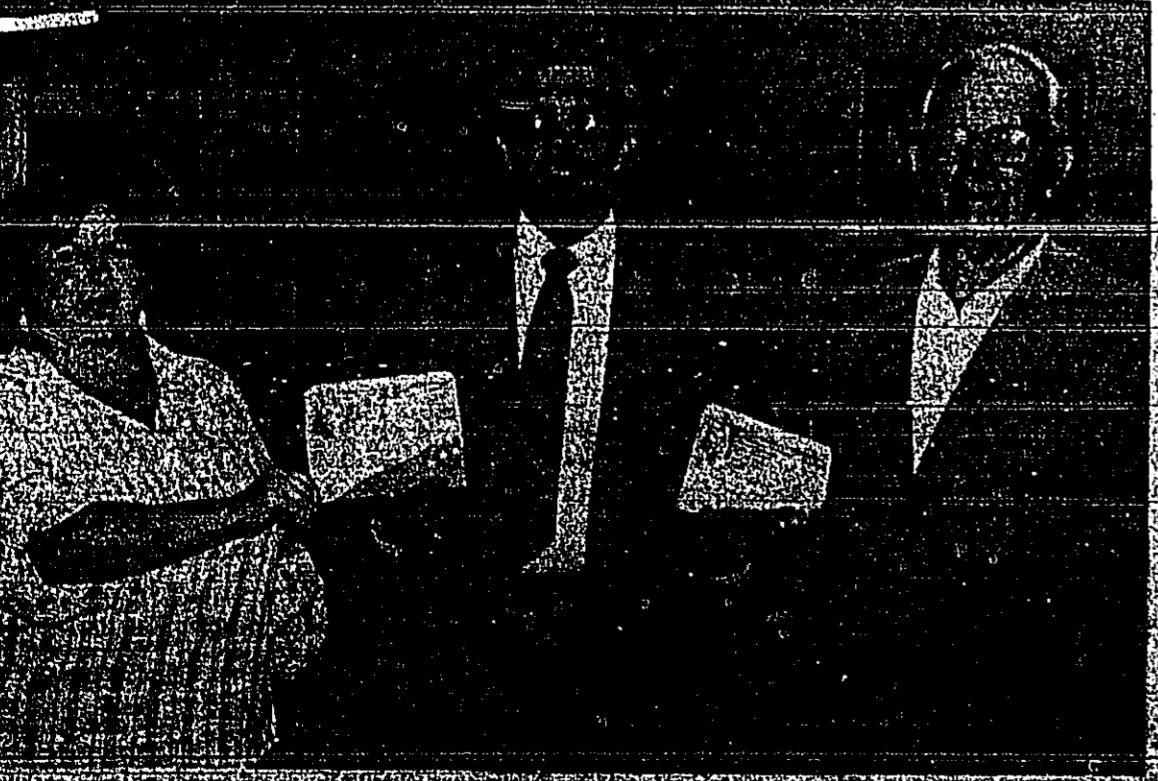

GSU Asks 5% Hike

BEAUMONT-Gulf States Utilities is filing tomorrow a Texas rate case that fulfills the company's pledge to soften the impact on residential customers as much as possible. GSU formally asked to increase 1986 residential rates in Texas by 5.5 percent, and said that because of a combination of factors, next summer's bills probably won't be any higher than they were for comparable usage at the beginning of this summer. Today, the company filed a Louisiana rate case that calls for a 30 percent increase in residential rates. GSU said Louisiana's residential rates are higher than Texas' in the following year. "We are pleased that we have been able to hold the residential rate increase down to this level," a company spokesman said. "We know our Texas customers have been concerned over reports that the company might ask for 38 to 42 percent rate hikes. That was never our intention. Although our plan to submit a rate moderation plan was overshadowed by state historical about what residential rates would be in June, a Texas residential customer paid \$105.50 for 1,000 kilowatt hours. That of the seasonal rate dropped to \$102.50 in September because of the 5.5 percent increase in next summer's bills. The company should be negligible for Texas residents. GSU's residential rates will drop in the following year.

...the company's entire request is approved for next year, 1,000 kilowatt hours will cost 105.50--the same as in June. As part of the rate case, GSU is asking for elimination of the seasonal rates that are higher in the summer than in the winter. The company is requesting that the seasonal rates be discontinued by next summer. With the drop in rates made possible in September because GSU had reduced its fuel and power costs and with the elimination of the seasonal rate differential, the direct effect of the 5.5 percent increase of next summer's bills should be negligible for Texas residents. GSU's residential rates will drop in the following year.

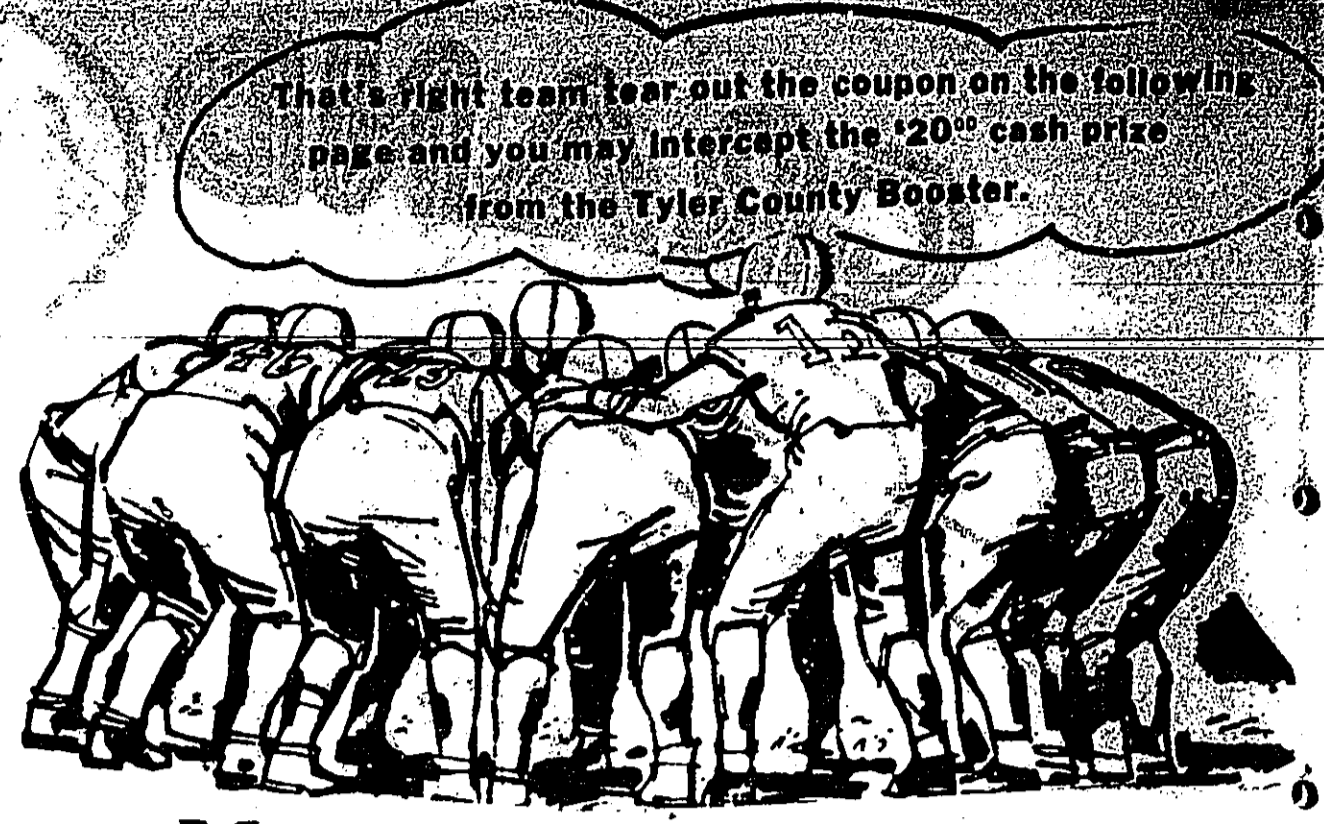
