'Sesqui-C' Plans Unfold

Plans are being finalized for the gala Warren Sesquicentennial Celebration to be held on Saturday, March 15, 1986. Opening ceremonies will be held at 11:30 a.m. at the Warren High School campus with appropriate music by the mighty Warrior Band and an impressive flag raising ceremony.

Participants and guests will enjoy an old time country fair atmosphere with old-fashion games such as Horse-shoes and Washers, Hayrides, and attempting to climb the greased pole to reach the twenty dollar prize at the top. There will be lots of booths where one can compete for prizes such as the Coke Ring Toss and Throwing the Baseball through the tire. Small children can take part in off the road Tricycle Races or search for treasure in the sawdust mountain. There will also be the popular Musical Cak Walk and Penny Toss games available.

One of the major attractions will be a huge Texas size Sesquicentennial Cake, thought to be the largest in the area. The cake will be the product of over 24 hours of baking and decorating skills by Mrs. Cobina Seiber and will be on display throughout the celebration. This will really be something to see and will be cut at 5 p.m. so everyone can have a taste of Texas.

Other planned displays include Texas History projects by Mr. George Isaacks' Junior High students and creative art objects in multi-media by High School and Elementary students of Warren and Fred. Paintings by Mr. David Drinkard, local artist and teacher, will be exhibited and available for sale.

Silvey Named Athletic Director

Gaylon "Butch" Silvey was named Athletic Director for the Warren Independent School District at the Board Meeting Tuesday, February 25. Silvey, who has held the position of Head Football Coach during the 1985-86 school year was given a one-year contract with additional compensation as recommended by the Texas Education Agency for the Athletic Director's position. Warren has operated this year without an Athletic Director.

The Board gave a one-year contract extension to Principals Woodland, Heriard, Mitchell and Morgan, Counselor Birdelle Baker and Central Office Personnel. The Board accepted the resignation of Junior High Science teacher Jeanette Pate effective the end of the 1985-86 school year.

A request by the Warren Volunteer Fire Department to use the Junior High Auditorium for a Variety Show March 7 was granted. The Board also granted the request of Administration Office personnel LaVern Hinton, Ann Reese and Billie Young to attend a workshop in Austin in June.

Election judges were appointed for the upcoming School Board election. Judges are as follows: Warren, Luther Moya; Fred, Arvus Hutto; Village Mills, W.C. Bobbitt; Abney Voting, Sandra Harri-

son. The election will be held Saturday, April 5. The date of the March School Board Meeting was changed due to a conflict with Spring break. The new meeting date is March 18.

The funds will be used to secure shelter, counseling and other services needed for juvenile crime prevention efforts in Angelina, Houston, Jasper, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Trinity and Tyler Counties. Funds also will be used to provide juveniles with shelter, shelter, regional placement centers when necessary.

This grant will help local communities meet the directives of the federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.

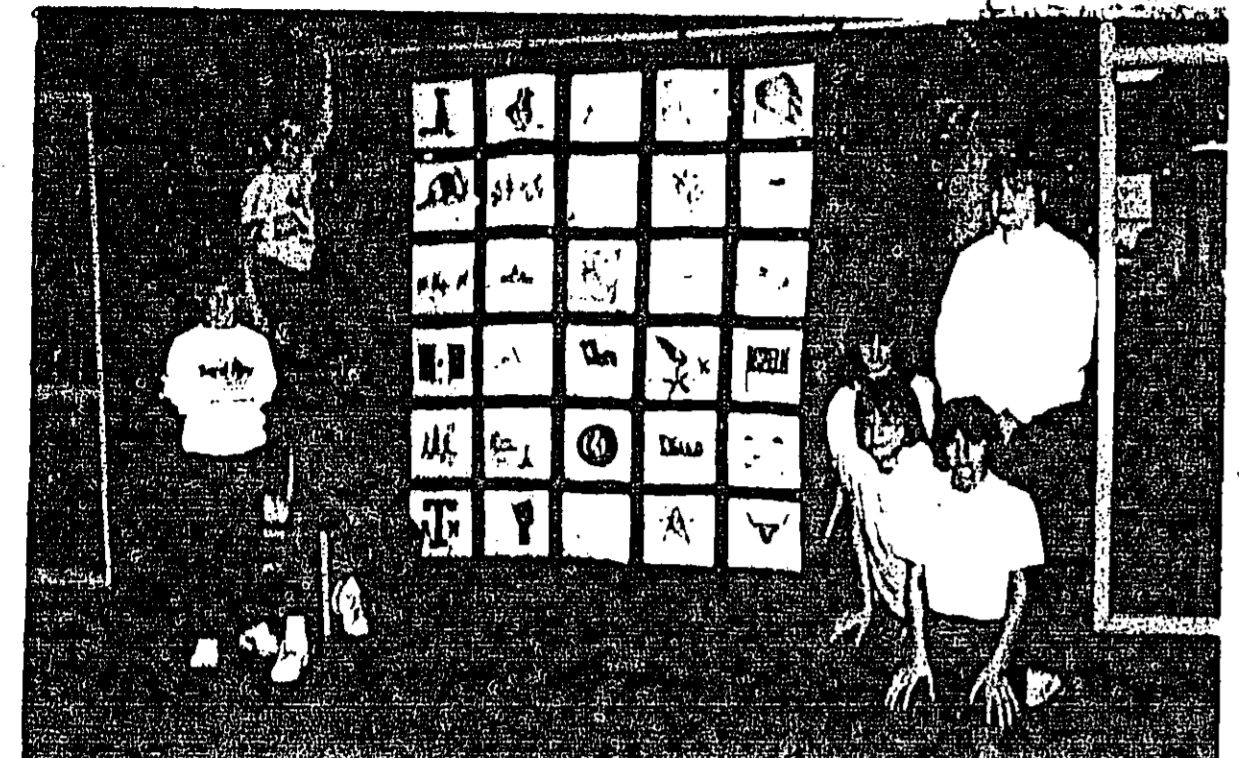
