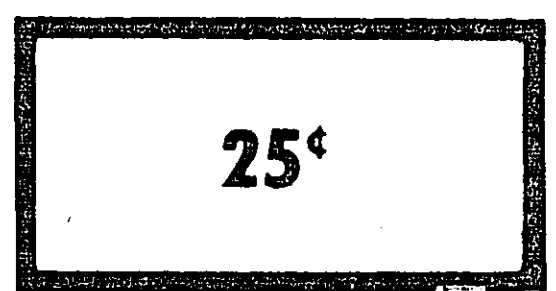

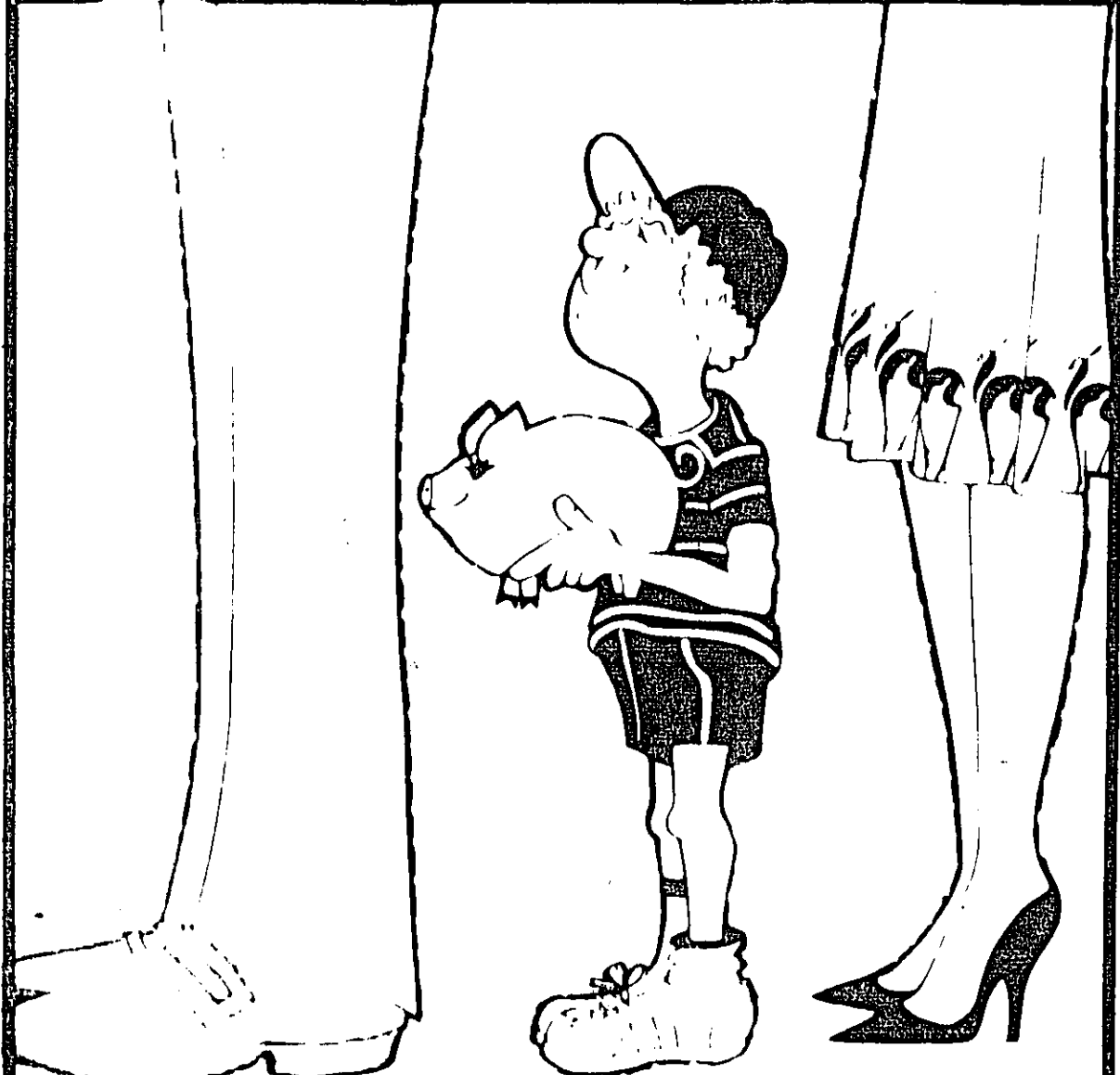

Accidents Reported

The Texas Highway Patrol investigated 15 rural traffic accidents in Tyler County during the month of March, according to Sergeant R.D. Henry, Supervisor for this Highway Patrol Sergeant area. These accidents resulted in 0 deaths and 11 injuries. The total rural traffic accidents for Tyler County for this year is 50, which have resulted in 0 deaths and 35 injuries.

The ten counties which comprise Highway Patrol Sub-District 2B-D have had a total of 552 rural traffic accidents this year, resulting in 13 deaths and 399 injuries. This compares to 551 accidents, 12 deaths, and 264 injuries reported during the same period last year (1985).

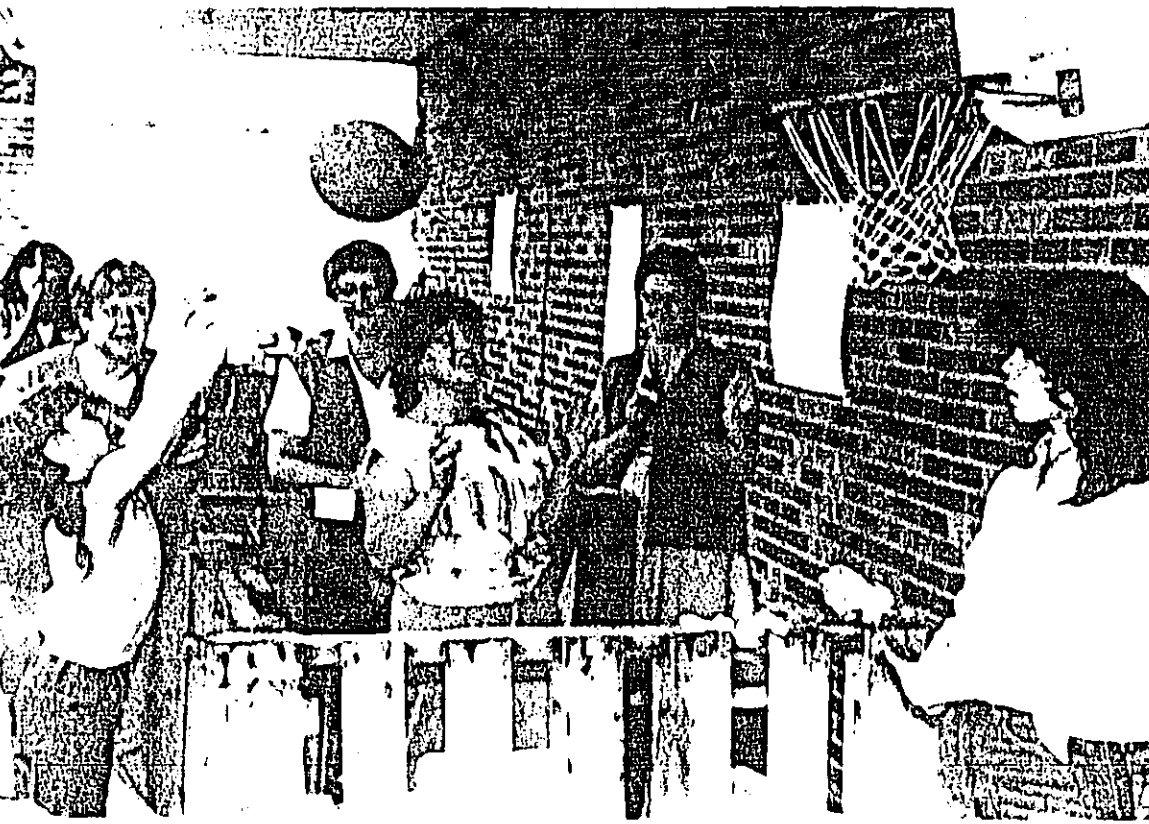

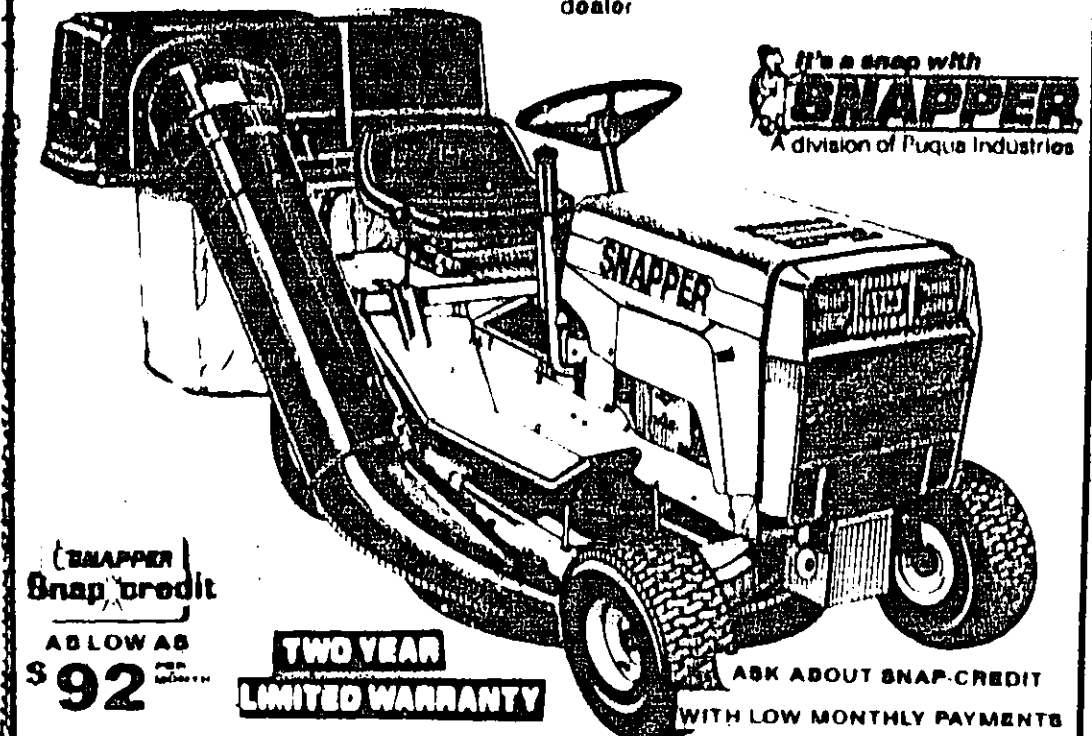
