

Life Flight Helipad Dedication Set Nov. 24

Texas Governor Mark White has personally provided the quick and death for victims of disaster.

From its early days with a phone in the middle of Hermann Hospital's emergency room and single flight crew, Life Flight has grown to encompass a fleet of five helicopters, with bases in Houston, Galveston and Beaumont. Life Flight services hospitals and

patients within a radius of 150 miles from each of the three cities, with operations extending throughout Southeast Texas and Western Louisiana.

More than 50 medical centers around the U.S. have emulated the Life Flight program with similar air ambulance programs.

The dedication of the Life Flight Helipad is the culmination of a County wide project that has been led by Woodville Police Officer Scott Yosko. Along with Yosko's leadership there have been donations from the public in the form of materials, labor and cash contributions. Without this public support this project could not have been completed without public funds.

Life Flight will arrive for the festivities, which begin at 10:00 a.m. Tyler County Hospital is a member of the Affiliated Hospital Systems (AHS), the health care system subsidiary of the Herman Hospital Estate.

In a visit to Hermann Hospital on October 10, White congratulated Life Flight, the nation's busiest hospital-based air ambulance system,

for more than 27,000 life-saving missions.


Tree Of Lights To Help Needy Kids
