Chester High School Student Dies

The death of an 18-year-old Chester High School student has been ruled self-inflicted. The body of Kevin Wayne Daugherty was found in his Barnes-area residence at approximately 9 a.m. Wednesday. He was pronounced dead at the scene, apparently from a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head from a 12-gauge shotgun, according to Precinct 33 Justice of the Peace Harvey Stamper. Stamper indicated the youngster left a letter, but the contents of that letter have not been revealed. Chester High School Principal Raymond Wallace officiated at the funeral services for Daugherty, which were held Saturday from the Corri-

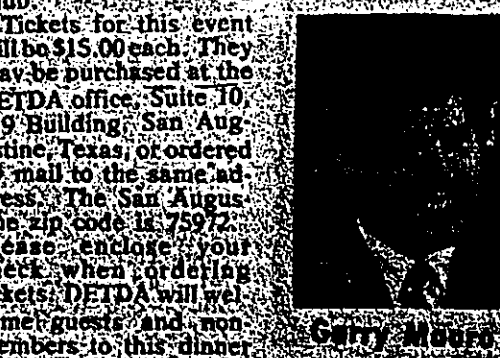

Council Okays Prison Resolve, Votes To Lower Gas Bills

Voting unanimously to support the Tyler County Chamber of Commerce in its bid to get a prison unit to locate here. Woodville City Council Monday acted also in other business to approve an audit report submitted by Certified Public Accountant Tommy Weaver; tabled bids from two Woodville banks for the depository privilege with the city and acted to reduce gas rates to customers within the city limits. As part of the audit report Weaver told the council "You did a pretty good job in keeping within your budget, collecting \$10,000 less than anticipated but also spending \$23,000 less than anticipated." Weaver told the council that the city's "Cash position was pretty tight and will be for a few years." Weaver explained, "that all the cash was tied up for operating and debt reduction purposes." Weaver, who soon leaves the employ of the City as he takes up a management office position with the Woodville Independent School District told the council that they, "Needed to effect better equipment management, institute a physical property inventory each year and strengthen internal cash flow controls." The council thanked the auditor for his "Good service for the city." In other action City Manager, Walt Davis reported a decreased price to the City from gas suppliers allowing a 50 cent reduction, down from \$5.50, for the first 1000 units of gas used. "We owe the people that much courtesy," said Councilman Doug Tolbert. Tabled for discussion were depository bids submitted from Citizens State Bank of Woodville represented by John Coker and Gene Sowarby and First National Bank of Woodville represented to Toby Spurlock. The First National Bank is the current holder of that service to the city.

As far as I know they still have it. Back in the 30's and 40's on Saturday evening all the smokers went to town and wore their khaki pants and a white shirt with a sack of Bull Durham Tobacco in the pocket with the tag hanging out. One guy would walk up to another one and asked him for a cigarette and he would always tell him he had the makings. Not too many people could afford to buy a package of ready rolls but a few would go over board and buy a package for Saturday night and Sunday. Back then it was Camels, Lucky Strike, Chesterfield and Old Gold Cigarettes. Then besides Bull Durham, smoking tobacco it was Prince Albert, R.J.R., Golden Grain, and Target. Now, cigarettes are like candy and soda water so many kinds of each it is a hard matter to find space to place them for sale.

I sent a sack of my "Durham" tobacco to my old friend Earl Smith. Don't know if he still smokes or not but he used to smoke this brand and told him to roll him a cigarette and a camel would walk a mile to put his brand on it. It is getting time to stir your ground to plant Irish Potatoes. The best way to start a fire with two sticks is to make sure one of the sticks is a match.

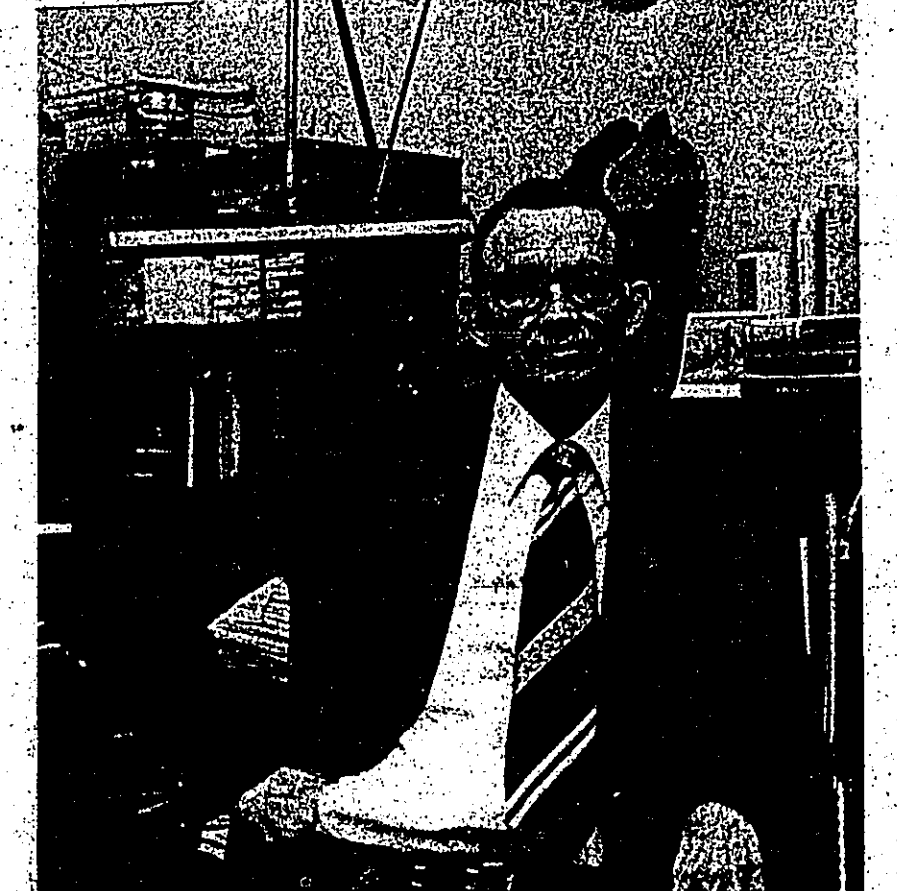
