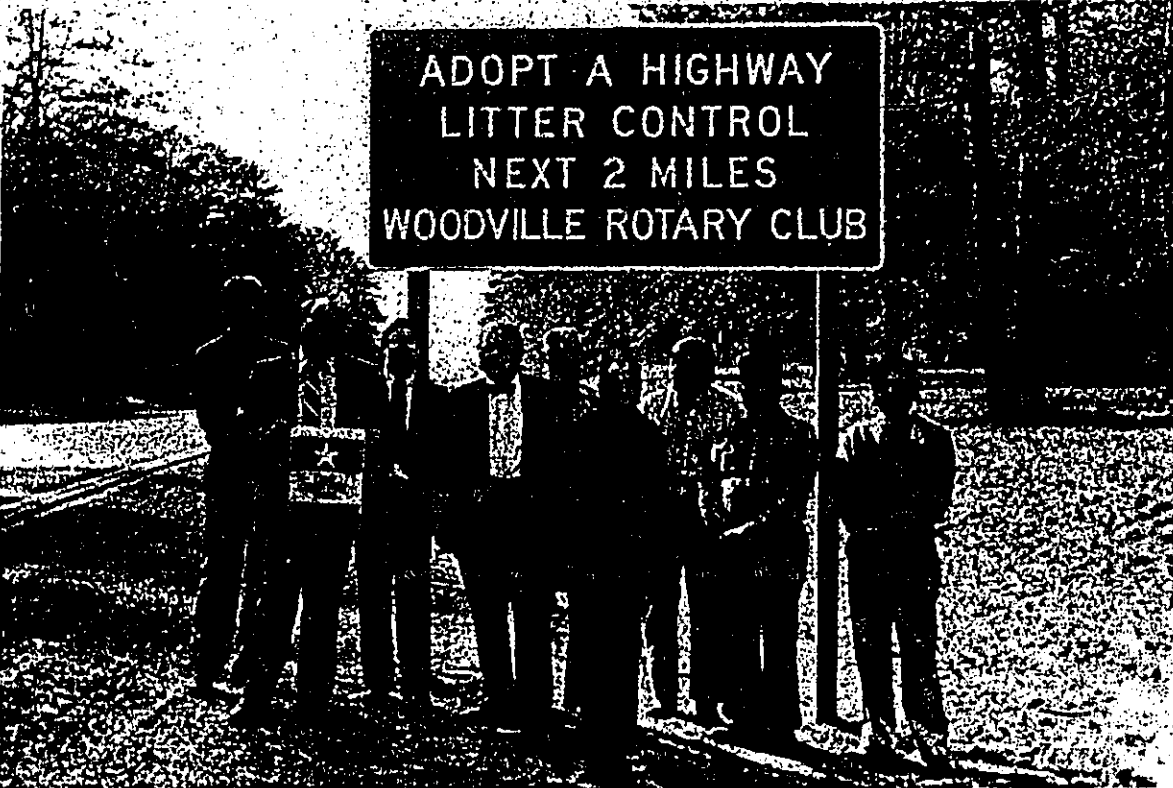

County Judges-Commissioners To Meet

Some 600 county judges and commissioners from across Texas are expected at the 29th Annual County Judges and Commissioners Conference at the College Station Hilton, February 24th and 26th. "Back to the Basics of County Government" is the theme of the annual conference, says John Gilmartin, county officials program specialist with the Texas Agricultural Extension Service, The Texas A&M University System. The conference is an educational program of the V.G. Young Institute of County Government, a part of the Extension Service. Conference highlights include a scheduled address by Gov. Bill Clements at 11 a.m. on Thursday, February 26, and an address by Texas Supreme Court Chief Justice John Hill at 10:30 a.m. on the selection of state, district and appellate judges. Also on Thursday morning, Theodore Maher, program leader for county government with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D.C., will discuss the role of Extension in local government. Reagan Brown, former Texas Commissioner of Agriculture and Extension Service sociologist, will address a Wednesday evening banquet. Dr. Zerle L. Carpenter, Extension Service director, will give opening remarks at the Thursday morning session, which will include a report on the Texas Association of Counties and how to do legal research and use attorney general opinions. The conference officially gets under way at 1:30 p.m. on February 24, with a welcome by Dr. Milo Shult, Extension Service associate director. Discussions that afternoon will deal with professionalism, county and district retirement systems, and the inner workings of the county commissioners court. Separate sessions for county judges and commissioners will be conducted Wednesday, February 25. The county commissioners session will deal with such topics as: overweight permits for county roads, solid waste management, subdivision plat approval, county purchasing, ethics, emergency 911, public officials' liability and good public relations. County judges will focus on topics relating to the Texas Penal Code and common misdemeanors, criminal procedure rules, civil procedure rules, probate proceedings, DWI cases, misdemeanor probation and juvenile offenders.

Dewberry Creek Animal Clinic Formally Opens

Tyler County has attracted a new doctor to settle in Woodville. He specializes in treatment of small animals. Larry A. Phillips has built the Dewberry Creek Animal Clinic at 1304 South Magnolia (Southern edge of Woodville on Hwy. 69) and celebrated with a grand opening social event on February 16, 1987. Phillips graduated from Texas A&M as Senior Commander with a B.S. and continued his graduate studies, receiving a doctor of veterinary medicine in 1966. Following two years of military service, Phillips settled in Dallas with a three-doctor animal clinic, which he later bought in 1972. He has been active throughout the community serving as a consultant to the Dallas Zoo from 1972-1985 and on the Board of Directors of the Dallas County Veterinary Medical Association. Assisting at the clinic will be Phillips' wife, Carol Ann. She is the daughter of the late Fred and Joanna Bennett (Woodville natives) and a former Dogwood Queen. The couple have two children: Karen, a Woodville High School Junior, and Bryan, a Woodville First Grader. Among these will be: applied, preventive, and boarding; in addition to surgery and medical treatment.
