## TDC's Scott Points To Payroll

It won't be formally named until the TDC board meets in the next few months. Scott told the group of the tremendous overcropping in the present TDC system and the solution said the TDC "was deep in the design development of the unit to be located here," saying the unit would be in "campus style." Scott said bid packages will be let for the project in April and July anticipating a \$12 million price tag for the project. The unit will employ 255 employees, 167 contractual, fulltime employees. Annual payroll will be \$6.5 million. "We plan to be here for awhile...we're considering recession proof when the economy is bad our business sky-rocketed." "I pledge to work with your community and county leaders. All of you will be invited to our open house just before we begin to operate. I hope we've made a friend" he said.

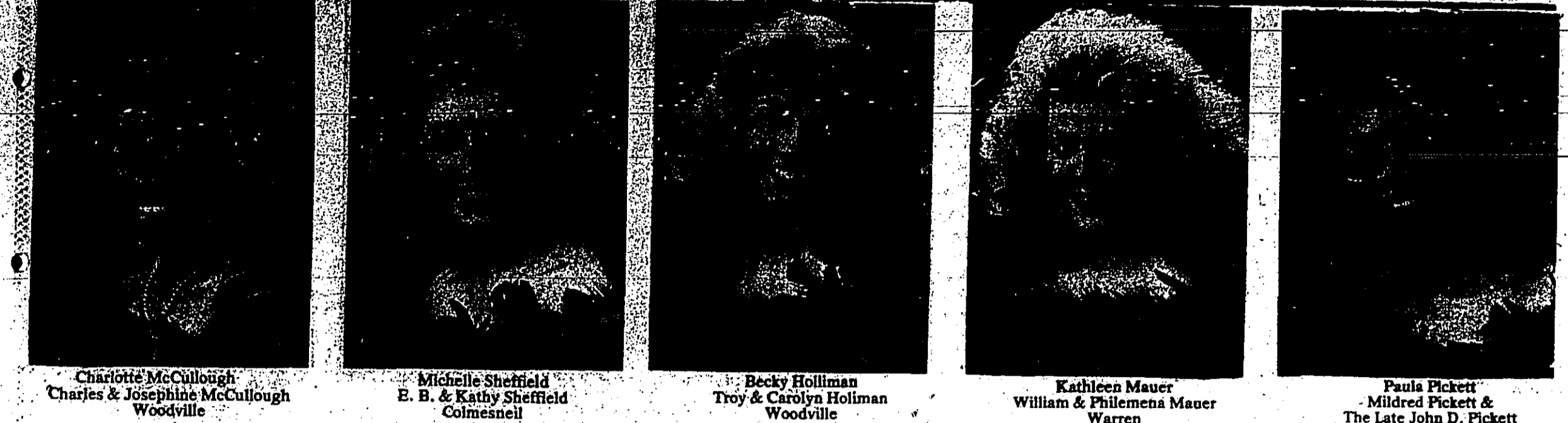

**TAX TIPS**

Partnerships, S-corporations, Personal Service Corporations, and Trusts under the 1986 code generally are required to conform (change) their tax year to the tax year of the owners, partners or beneficiary. Compliance requires the filing of two returns, one for twelve months ending with a 1987 month other than December, at short period. Income from the twelve month return is reported in the year earned. Short period income may be reported ratably over four years. All losses are reported when incurred.

The Revenue Act of 1987 provides an election permitting the mentioned activities other than trusts, to retain their fiscal year or to change to a year other than a required year. To qualify, the activity must file an election by March 31, 1988 and make any "required payments" before April 15, 1988.
