In Ag And Science Warren Offers New Courses

Program is the development of viable community by providing recent training and assistance in agriculture and its related industries, expanding economic opportunities principally for persons of low and moderate income.

The objectives of the Texas Community Development Program are:
OBJECTIVE 1: To improve public facilities to provide better human services, principally for low and moderate income persons.

OBJECTIVE 2: To improve housing conditions, principally for persons of low and moderate income.

OBJECTIVE 3: To expand economic opportunities that create or retain jobs, principally for low and moderate income persons.

OBJECTIVE 4: To provide assistance and public facilities to eliminate conditions hazardous to the public health and of an emergency nature.

Warren has also had four students, John Foxworth, Alan McKee, and Dusty Swafford, walk across the stage and receive the highest degree awarded by the State F.F.A. Association, the Lone Star Farmer Award. Dusty Swafford, accompanied by Cody Swafford, fiddled her way into the hearts of F.F.A. members again this year and brought home the second place award in the State F.F.A. Talent Contest.

Warren has been busy getting their animals ready for the Tyler County Fair. Many hours of hard work and dedication have gone into raising these projects. These projects have held students to a higher level of achievement, pride, and responsibility in themselves and their capabilities.

Many people have the misconception that agriculture is all farming and ranching. Similarly the biggest misconception about agriculture science courses in high school is they prepare a student

for a career working on a farm or ranch. The reality is that agriculture and its related industries are a driving economic force in Texas and the United States.

Program enrollment is estimated to be up to 20 percent of the world wide Texas More specifically, Texas agriculture employs 790,000 people, generates 13 billion in cash receipts, and has a total economic impact of about .65 billion each year.

The new agriculture science courses are beneficial to the prospective producer, who tend to be academic in nature and are geared toward preparing students for a postsecondary education and a career in science related fields. With the current decline in college enrollments in ag-

riculture, these courses have been developed to meet the needs of the prospective producer.

The summer program involved a visit to San Antonio where chapter presences attended the state F.F.A. convention.

Here, the Warren F.F.A. Chapter was ranked superior among all the F.F.A. chapters in the state.
