## Woodville Leaders, Village Staff Await FAM Tour

Heritage Village Museum will be among the stops on this year's Fall Familiarization Tour, sponsored by the East Texas Tourism Association of Longview. On the bus, due to arrive at The Village this Saturday, September 17, at 10:15 a.m., will be approximately 50 people in one way or another tourism, including Tour Directors from both inside and outside the state, Travel Club representatives, Travel writers and personnel from the Texas Tourist Bureau entry points in Amarillo, Waskom, Langtry, Denison, and Harlingen. Although Heritage Village has only been scheduled for a brief visit, a representative of The Village will board the bus at the Indian Reservation and give the visitors an advance preview of what is being done to restore the Village to its former prominence as a major tourist attraction in East Texas. ## New Feature Added Corn Husk Dolls Attraction

A presentation tea will be held at Heritage Village Museum next Tuesday afternoon from 2 to 4 p.m. to introduce the pioneer collection of corn husk dolls, created exclusively for the Village Museum by Judy Walls of Woodville. The collection includes six dolls in authentically researched dress, carrying out varied pioneer activities. There is Pioneer Pauline, carrying firewood; Pioneer Priscilla, sweeping; Pioneer Penelope, picking flowers; Pioneer Polly with her egg basket; and Pioneer Prudence, reading the Bible. Mrs. Walls and her husband moved to Woodville from Houston six years ago, after seeing a segment on the area on the Eyes of Texas. Once they looked over the area in person, they fell in love with it and made their move. And a good one it's been for Tyler County, as Judy Walls has become involved with the library, where she works part time, the Little Theatre and now, her cottage industry of creating dolls made completely from corn husks and cork silk. Raised on a dairy farm in Illinois, where her grandmother taught her to make simple corn husk dolls, Judy has developed her skills into the making of fully detailed dolls, complete with overskirts, aprons, bonnets, and corn silk hair, each one bearing a tag describing the costume and its historical background. Tea will be served in the Village Museum Store from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 20, and the public is cordially invited to attend.
