

Update: Gib Lewis Unit

Positions Are Still Available, But Rental Property Needed

About 74 positions remain to be filled to staff what is soon to become Tyler County's second largest industry—the Gib Lewis Prison Unit.

According to Texas Department of Criminal Justice officials, a tentative opening date of July 31 has been set for the unit.

Of the approximately 74 positions still available, 30 will be hired through the Windham School System, which serves TDCJ.

According to Vicky Hinson, who is Warden Bruce Strickland's secretary, about 60 positions have been filled so far. Many of those hires are training at other units throughout the state. Several are Tyler County residents.

Li Cindy Riley, personnel director for the unit, said that the unit will employ about 297 people, 163 of whom will be correctional officers.

Many of the correctional officers are also from Tyler County, she said. They left this area to work for TDCJ and hope to transfer back here when the unit opens.

Although TDCJ has tentative plans to open the unit around July 31, it will be mid-August at the earliest before inmates will be brought in, Riley added.

Some of the administrative people have begun to move into the area, said Riley. One of the problems they have encountered is the shortage of available rental property here.

"We have experienced difficulty with housing," said Riley. "The rental market is not good, everybody wants to sell."

Riley added that the majority of employees, correctional officers, are not prepared to buy a house right away when they move into a new area.

"Most of the correctional officers are not at their full pay scale yet, and cannot afford to buy at the present time," said Riley. "Also, many of these people don't want to buy until they're sure they will like the area."

Riley said that if some of the local people who have homes for sale would be interested in renting, it would ease the problem TDCJ is experiencing with the shortage of rental property in the area.

"These people are used to paying anywhere from \$350 to \$500 month," she said.

Riley urges anyone interested in renting property to contact Hinson at 283-2882.

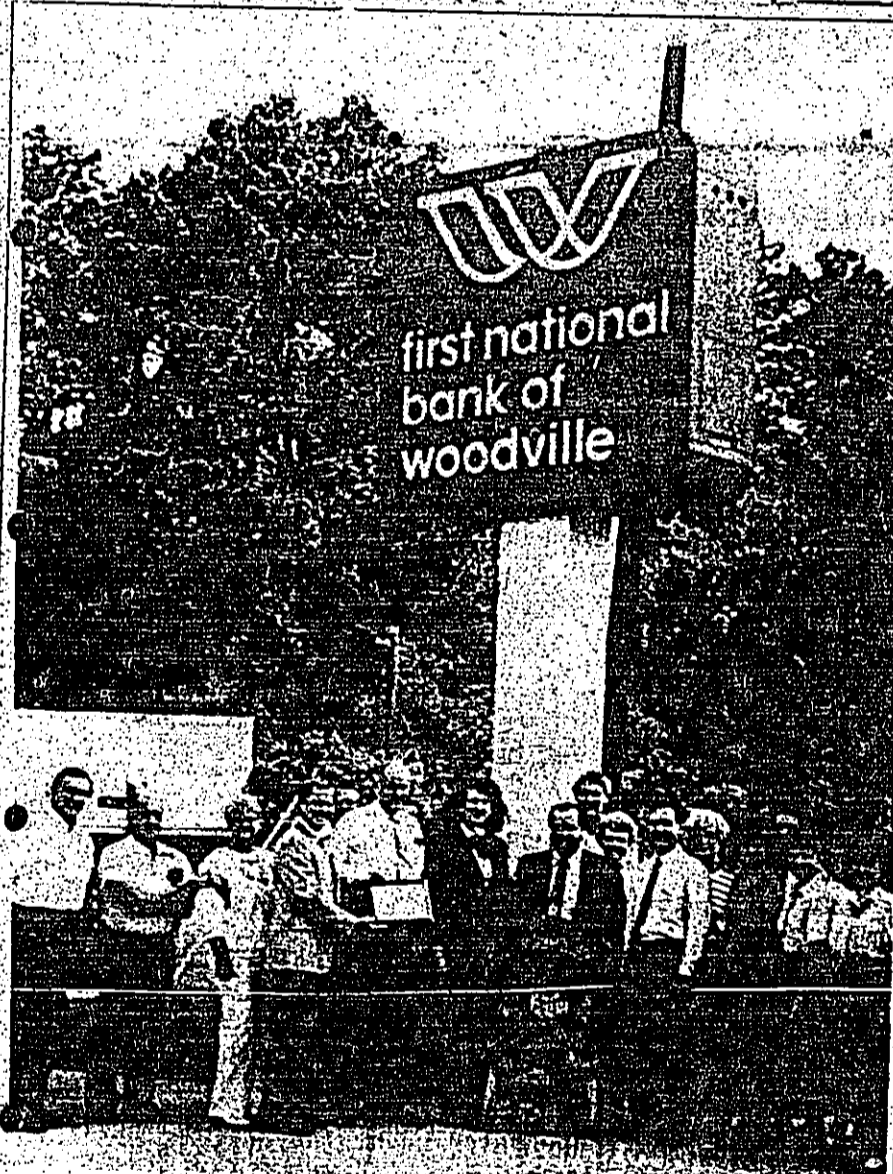

Bentsen Seeks Flood Study

Washington, D.C.—Senator Lloyd Bentsen introduced legislation Thursday authorizing a \$900,000 study of flood control needs along the Trinity River in the wake of devastating floods this spring.

Bentsen earlier proposed legislation providing direct disaster payments to farmers in Texas and other states affected by this year's flooding. It would give farmers who have suffered 1990 flood losses the same assistance offered following natural disasters in 1988 and 1989.

The new Bentsen legislation, a resolution, does not require action by the full Congress, only by the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee. The Senator said he is hopeful the committee will consider his proposal at a meeting scheduled for next week.

"The Corps of Engineers reports that while the spring floods were devastating they would have been much worse but for existing flood control facilities along the Trinity," Bentsen said.

Senator Bentsen said the Corps estimates flooding along the Upper Trinity River Basin caused damages of as much as \$300 million and says an additional \$2 billion in damages was prevented by the flood control measures. He said the Corps is still working on estimates for the Middle and Lower Trinity River Basins.

"It's good that we have flood protection along the

Trinity River but we obviously need more," Bentsen said.

"I recently went to Liberty, Texas to get a first hand look at the flood damage and saw a Trinity River that was almost 30 feet high—6 feet above flood stage—and 5-6 miles wide. Normally, the river is 200 feet wide at this point."

"Fifty four Texas counties have been declared disaster areas so far. The Federal Emergency Management Agency has received some 5,000 requests for help. The Red Cross tells me that more than 1,300 homes along the lower basin have been damaged or destroyed by the flood. A lot of people won't be returning to their

homes or businesses for some time yet and when they do go back many will find devastation."

"This resolution is intended to help us identify flood control strategies to alleviate this hardship. Flood control projects already in place on the Trinity paid for themselves almost five times over during this year's flood. They have, in fact, paid for themselves some 10 times over since they were built," Bentsen said.

"Anyone who has witnessed the personal tragedies, resulting from this year's flooding in Texas will understand the urgent need for action on my proposal. I'll be pushing for swift approval," Senator Bentsen said.

When 10 books have been completed a certificate will be issued and a book bag awarded. The children will also receive a gift certificate for a treat at

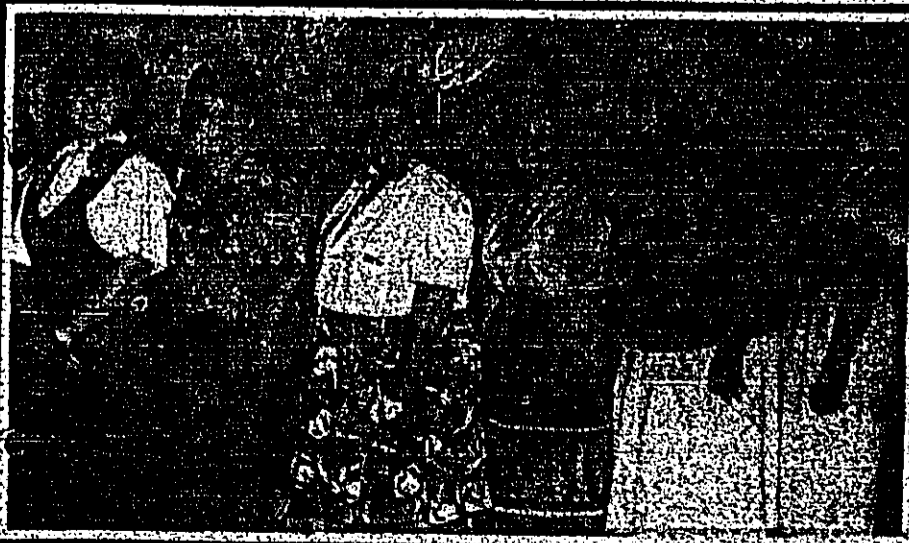
Dairy Queen. Children who complete reading a total of 30 books during the six-week period will be eligible for an additional treat token.

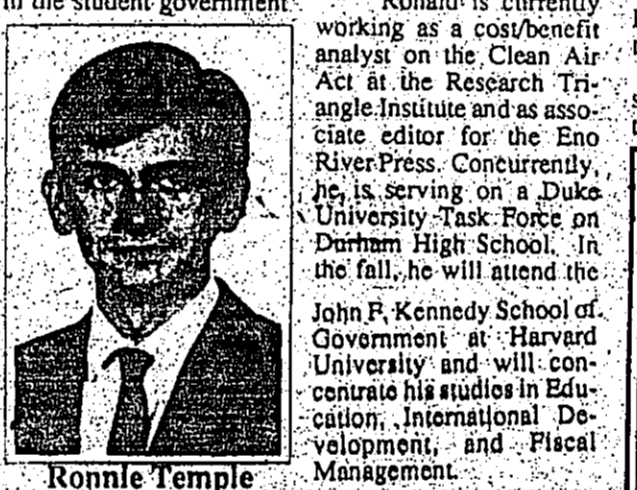
Maltby-Carlton Wed In Colmesneil

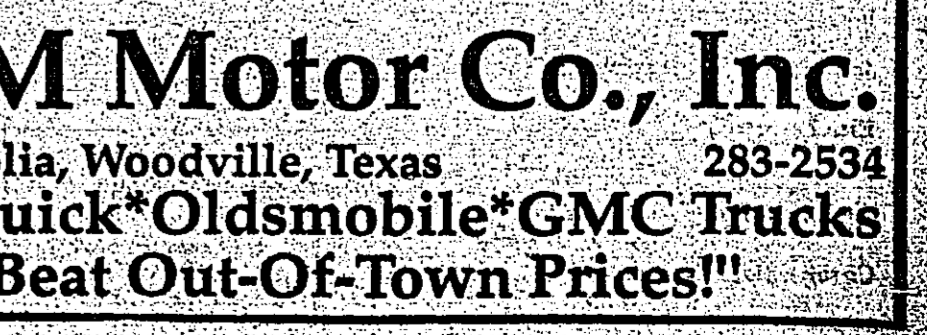

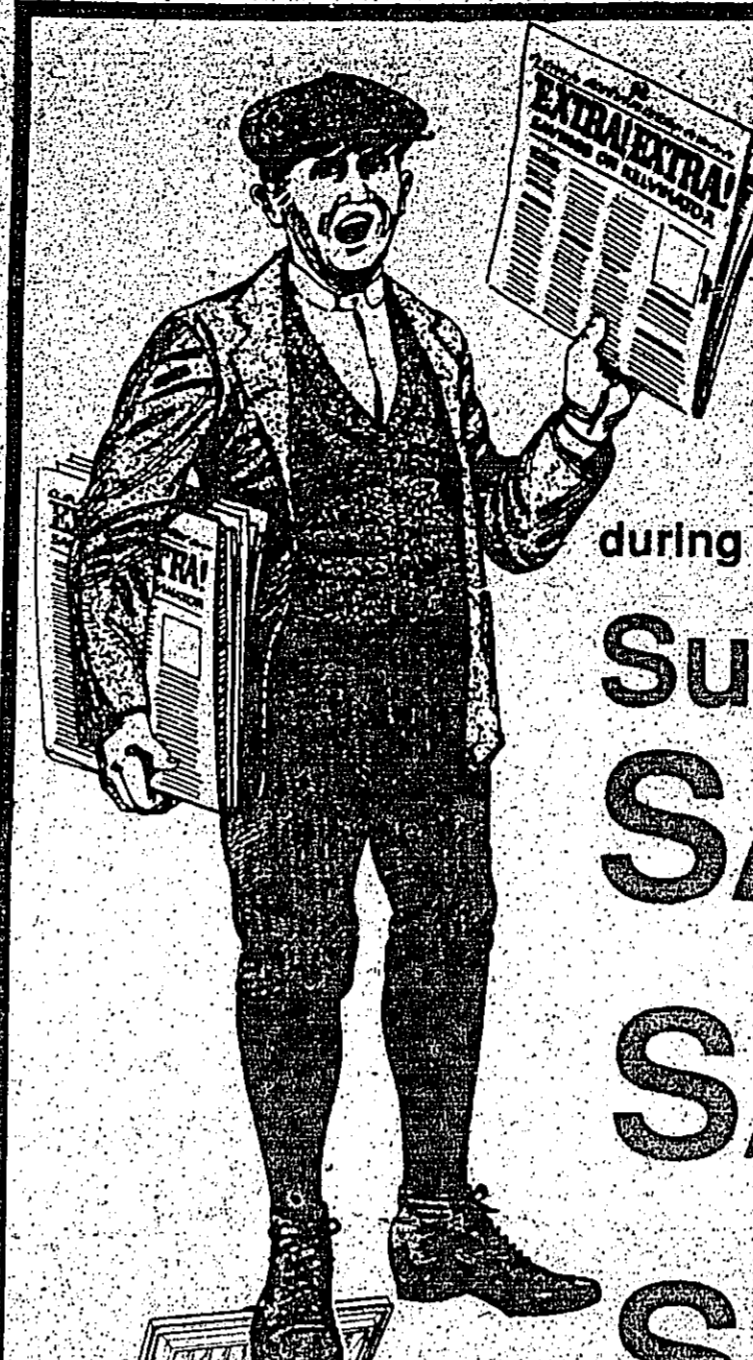

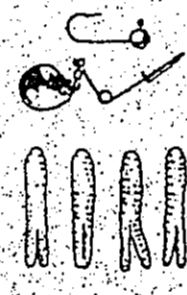
