Full Line Radio Shack Opening

Radio Shack will be open to the public on August 1, 1990 at their new location on East Wheat Street in Woodville. The new owners and operators, Linda and D.J. Christopher, are excited about their second store opening in the area. "We want everyone to know that we are small town people who live in the area and are here to offer a service," said Linda, adding, "we feel this will add something to help and better the community." According to the Christophers, Radio Shack will offer a full line of Radio Shack equipment including telephones, satellites, audio and stereo equipment, television antennas, cellular phones and Tandy computers. In addition to this, they will have an on-site computer instructor who will offer classroom and private tutoring by appointment. One other convenience that Radio Shack offers is a Fax service available to the public. "We can transmit or receive from anywhere in the world," said Linda. The cost for this service will be \$2 to send a letter and \$1 to receive one. Be watching for Radio Shack's big Grand Opening that is scheduled for August 15, 1990.

Gib Lewis Unit Offers No Chapel Facility For Inmates Or Staff

A retired former Chaplain at the Texas Department of Corrections from Huntsville said last week he "couldn't understand why if a 2,200 man prison unit gets a chapel... why the new 1,000 man units like the one in Woodville shouldn't have one too?" The Rev. Mike Keppler who worked the TDC Units near and around Huntsville for over 10 years said further that the only dedicated "religious" space was for the Chaplain of the Unit. According to Gib Lewis Warden W.B. (Bruce) Strickland during a Chamber of Commerce Tour Monday when asked by THE BOOSTER why there was no chapel provided for the inmates, he said "That's a good question." Strickland went on to say that "Money was probably the reason... you have to provide for Muslim as well as other faiths" he said. Strickland, who had invited the Chamber of Commerce for a close-up tour of the entire facility, said there would be some space available for this in classrooms but that there was no formal dedicated space for a chapel. Strickland said further that several candidates for Gib Lewis Unit Chaplain are being considered but that none have been hired as yet. The Rev. Keppler, who was visiting as a supply priest at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Woodville Sunday, and who will be preaching again on Sunday, July 29, indicated that the needs of the inmates and the prison personnel are the same in a religious sense and something needs to be done. The Rev. Keppler said he was serving on a committee which was currently studying the question.

Matherne told the group that the monies would go for necessary supplies and that "The teachers and administrators in the five Tyler County School Districts have been very appreciative in the past with our help."

Matherne said the "Teachers usually have to come up with some of these supplies out of their own pockets and you know how tough that can be," she said.

Government Pensions May Effect Social Security

According to David Bennett, district manager of the Lublin Social Security office, spouses who have a federal state or local government job not covered under Social Security should be aware of the effect their government pension will have on any future entitlement to Social Security benefits on the record of another and also the effect of the pension on Social Security benefits on their own work record.

Some pensions earned from government work not under the Social Security system will usually affect Social Security benefits. It can affect benefits on the workers own record, and benefits payable on another's record.

Two-thirds of her state pension, \$100, will be offset against the wife's benefit, leaving \$100 per month Social Security benefit.

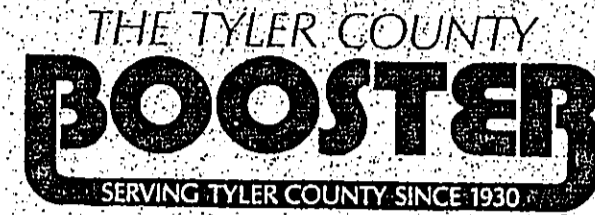

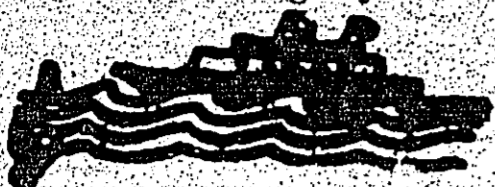

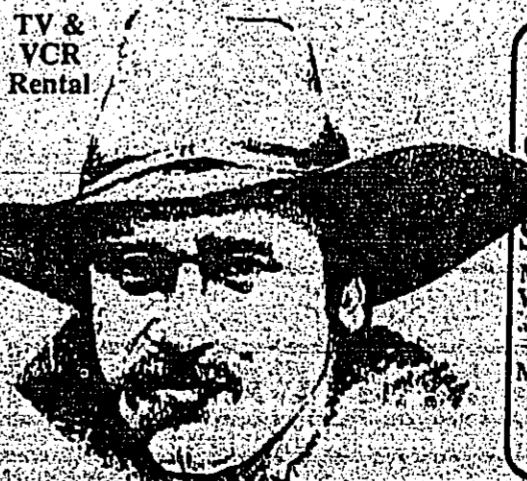
