Candidate Peterson Calls Self 'Anti Drug, Pro Environment'

"I am the true anti-drug, pro-environment candidate in this race," said Donna Peterson, the Republican candidate opposing Charlie Wilson for the District 2 seat in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Peterson, speaking to about 200 members of the Tyler County Farm Bureau in Warren, told voters to look at the actions of political candidates, rather than listening to the words.

"I volunteered my time and my own money to show the youth of America that success and drugs don't mix. It's that important to me," Ms. Peterson, who is the first female from Southeast Texas to graduate from West Point Military Academy, has volunteered hundreds of hours over the last 10 years speaking to young people across the country on a "Say No To Drugs" crusade.

Peterson received cheers and a standing ovation when she told the crowd that she is committed to three principles: "Nobody burns our flag, nobody drugs our kids and nobody declares war on the United States of America." Then Peterson added, "My background, unlike that of my opponent, shows a strong commitment against drugs. I have already notified most of our local law enforcement agencies to assure them that I will work side-by-side with Senator Gramm and President Bush to oppose the 1990 crime bill and to prevent the loss of federal funding from our rural anti-drug task forces. And when I say it, you can believe it."

Ms. Peterson also trusts herself as the true pro-environment candidate. She points out that she has the support of the groups most closely associated with environmental concerns, farmers, ranchers and timber growers. When a group of concerned citizens in the Liberty County/Houston Lake area called Peterson to invite her to a hearing opposing a toxic waste site in the area, with only a few hours' notice, "I immediately re-arranged my campaign schedule to attend the hearing," Peterson said. Oct. 23 Commodities Soon

The distribution of U.S.D.A. commodities for certified recipients of Tyler County has been scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 23, 1990 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. The location will be the Lion's Den in Woodville.

Only those persons who are certified for 1990 will be able to receive commodities. No applications for certification will be taken on the day the commodities are distributed. The first sign-in numbers will be reserved for handicapped and/or elderly (60 years old or older) persons who do not have an authorized representative to get their food and must come themselves. In order to prevent long waits, we recommend that these people not come to the distribution site before 9 a.m. The distribution will be conducted by Tri-County Community Action, Inc. of Center with the assistance of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court.

Rules for participation in the program are the same for everyone without regard to age, race, marital status, color, religion, sex, handicap, national origin, or political belief.
