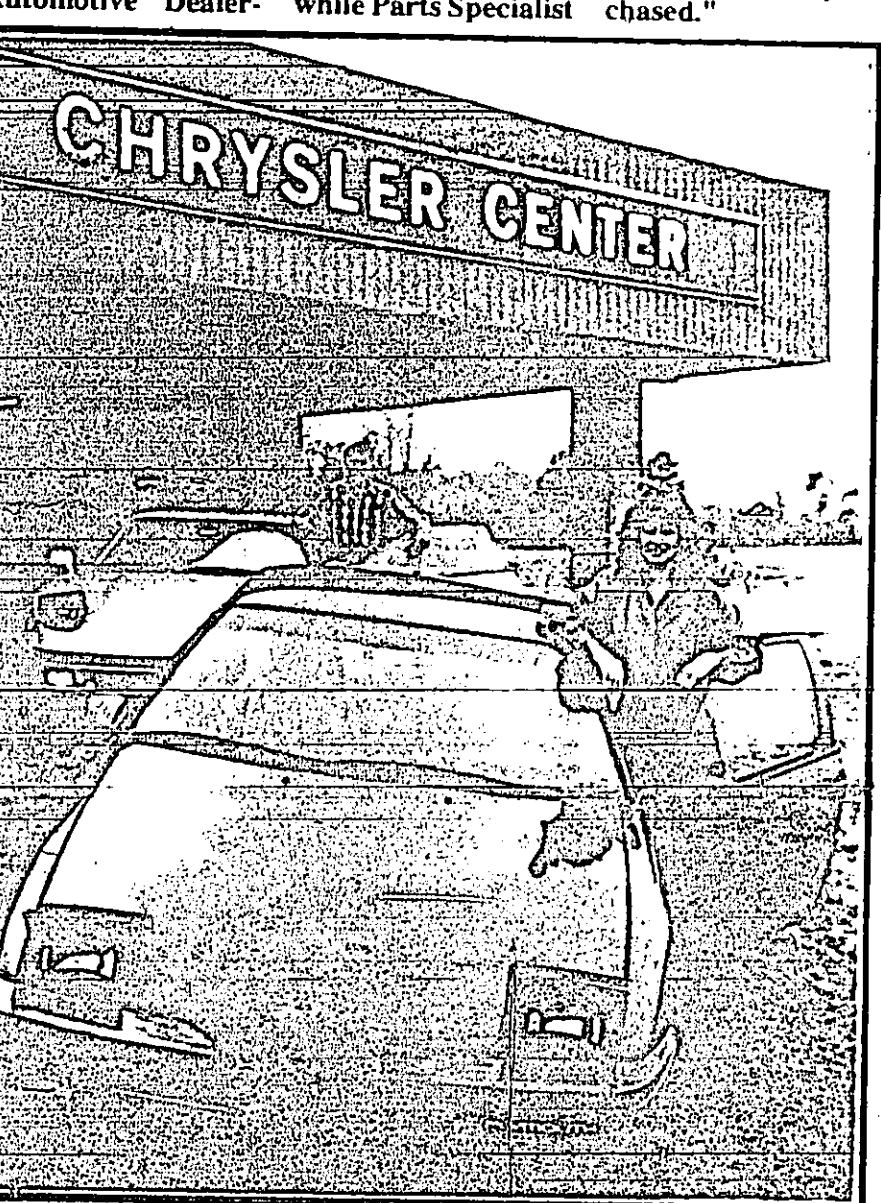

Federal Housing Program Funded

A new federal housing program which will offer loans to low and moderate income people in rural areas has been funded for FY 1991 with \$100 million. The program falls under the existing Section 502 program.

For unsubsidized guaranteed loans \$30 million is available. This new rural loan guarantee program is designed to expand homeownership opportunities for low and moderate income people in rural areas by guaranteeing rural housing loans in places

where insufficient mortgage financing is available from other sources. The program is designed in particular to assist moderate income people who have been squeezed out of federal housing programs by the growing number of low and very low income individuals.

Guaranteed loans will be allocated based on the needs of each state, but these loans are made to individuals. Eligible uses of guaranteed loans are the acquisition or construction of single family homes which are located in rural areas more than 25 miles from densely populated areas.

Loans are expected to be made beginning in April or May, 1991. Further information can be obtained from the Farmers Home Administration, Mr. Jim Craun at (202)382-1482.

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to introduce new optional services, Personalized Ring™ and ComCall™, beginning March 18, 1991.

Personalized Ring™ is an optional service that provides single-line customers the ability to manage incoming calls by allowing up to three directory numbers to share the same line. One of the numbers is called the "master" number; the others are called the "dependent" numbers. A regular ring is provided for the master number and unique distinctive rings are provided for up to two dependents.

ComCall™ is an optional service that provides single-line customers the ability to set up internal intercom communications among multiple telephone extensions. A distinctive ring is heard to alert all extension users of an intercom call. Customers must subscribe to the optional service Three-way Calling for ComCall™ to function. (The monthly rate for Three-way Calling is \$2.10 for residence customers and \$2.65 for business customers.)

Personalized Ring™ and ComCall™ are intended for use by both residence and business customers. Personalized Ring™ is expected to generate first-year revenues of \$1.8 million.

ComCall™ projects first-year revenues of \$53,000.
