Tyler County Emergency Care Facility Holds Formal Opening

The long awaited dedication for the new Emergency and Waiting Room at Tyler County Hospital was held Thursday, Feb. 28. According to Hospital Administrator, Tom Sturdivant, the new additions were much needed and made possible only with the help of the Tyler County Hospital Auxiliary and the TLL Temple Foundation.

To date, the renovations are completely paid for with \$20,056.31 from the Auxiliary, \$86,093 from the TLL Temple Foundation, and another \$86,093 from the hospital.

Sturdivant gave special recognition during the dedication ceremony to the Tyler County Hospital Auxiliary, represented by Jane

McElveen; the Temple Foundation, represented by Assistant Executive Director, Buddy Zeigler; Mrs. Ona Lee Seamans, hospital board of directors chairman; Thomas Fortenberry Contractors, represented by Mr. Paul Hicks; the Engineering Firm of Goodwin-Lasiter, represented by Phillip Goodwin; and Mr. Perry, retired hospital board member, who played an active part and was extremely influential in getting the renovation project off the ground.

Also present during the ceremony was Tyler County Judge Jerome Owens, Tyler County Commissioners Riley, Sawyer, Mahan and Barnes; and many other supportive Tyler County citizens.

Boy Scouts Eye Youth Center Funds While Board Considers Next Move

The Tyler County Youth Development Center, Inc., which has been dormant for about two years since it stopped providing service to children in December, 1988, may be the object of an appeal from the Three Rivers Council Boy Scouts of America for some \$18,000 in unused funds and assets for the beleaguered Camp Umland Scout Camp facility in Woodville.

According to Charles Beard, Executive Director for the Boy Scout Organization headquartered in Beaumont, "We are checking into whether or not we qualify in this request. The Boy Scouting organization was the original named beneficiary in the incorporation papers, should the Youth Center dissolve its operation," Beard said.

According to Beard, "We have an attorney who is checking with the Secretary of State to see if we still qualify. Camp Umland really needs the money," he indicated.

The scouts kicked off their annual fund drive in Woodville Tuesday.

According to TCYDC President Don Stevenson the operating board of the organization has been "inactive" for the past year but is scheduling a meeting "Sometime this month".

Stevenson said action taken by the board about a year ago in deeding the youth center facility located on Springhill Road to the Sabine/Neches Baptist Area Association, headquartered in Kirbyville, "May have been a mistake."

Stevenson said several break-ins and vandalism seemed to indicate that a reconsideration of that action might be necessary.

Stevenson said several "housesitters" were allowed to reside in the three bedroom home in order to protect the property of the organization. Commissioner Precinct 1 Maxie Riley said that several of his workmen had "seen someone driving off with a portable building" located behind the facility recently, Riley said it was he concern that the Youth Center property "Go to help the kids of Tyler County."


B.C. McCoy, who heads the Sabine/Neches Baptist Area Association said Tuesday the Youth Center Facility had been considered as possible

Prison Hospitality House under a Missions proposal submitted by The Rev. Bo. Owens of Colmesneil. Currently the Baptist Association's custodian of the property is The Rev. Bill Swearingin. The property is now listed "For Sale" by Patton Realty of Woodville. According to Real Estate Agent Lane Patton "The price is \$20,000 and highly negotiable...terms are very flexible", Patton added.

Stevenson told THE BOOSTER Monday about a recent letter he received from former TCYDC President The Rev. J. R. Johnson inquiring about the disposition of the unused funds belonging to the organization urging him "to take some kind of action with the money."

Stevenson indicated he would call a meeting of the TCYDC board soon to discuss the money issue and other matters. The organizations president also indicated he might be in favor of asking for the youth center facility back if that was the wish of his operating board.

Tyler County Probation officials have indicated that there is a "definite need" for the Youth Shelter concept and services that were delivered in the past by the Youth Center organization.

Grand opening festivities are planned for the week of March 11. (See Pg. 4 for more information.)






Woodville High School Students Honor Troops




