### Rural Accident Report Given

The Texas Highway Patrol inviestigated a total of 8 rural traffic accidents in Tyler County during the month of April according to Sergeant Roy D. Henry, supervisor of Highway Patrol Area 2B-4. As a result of these accidents, Troopers reported 8 inju-

ries and one traffic fatality. Thus far in 1991, Tyler County Troopers have investigated a total of 39 motor vehicle accidents which have resulted in-4 deaths and 33 persons being injured.

## Property Tax Protest and Appeal Procedures

The law gives property owners the right to protest actions concerning their property tax appraisals. You may follow these procedures

- if you have a concern about: the value placed on your property;
- · exemptions that may apply to you;
- cancellation of agricultural appraisal;
- whether your property is taxable: which local governments should be taxing
- your property; or you think the appraisal district has done

something else that adversely affected you. Informal Review: The taxpayer may contact an appraiser at the Appraisal District at

806 West Bluff or call 409-283-3736. Review by the Appraisal Review Board: Il you can't resolve your problem informally with the appraisal district staff, you may have your case heard by the appraisal review

The appraisal review board (ARB) is an independent board of citizens that reviews problems with appraisals and other concerns listed above. They have the power to order the appraisal district to make the necessary changes to solve problems. If you file a written request for an ARB hearing (called a notice of protest) before the deadline, the ARB will set your case for a hearing. You'll receive written notification of the time, date, and place of the hearing. The hearing will be informal. You and the appraisal district representative will be asked to present evidence about your case. The ARB will make its decision based. on the evidence presented. You can get a copy of a protest form from the appraisal district office at 806 West Bluff.

Note: You shouldn't try to contact ARB members outside of the hearing. The law requires you to sign an allidavit saying that you haven't done so before the ARB hears. your case.

Review by the District Court: Alter it decides your case, the ARB must send you a copy of its order by certified mail. If you're not satisfied with the decision you have the right to appeal to district court if you choose to go to court, you must start the process by filing a polition within 45 days of the date you receive the ARB's order. If the appraisal district has appraised your property at \$1,000,000 or more, you must file a notice of appeal with the chief appraiser within 15 days of the date you receive the ARB's order.



The Company has filed an application with the Commission to restructure and change the rates for Directory Assistance Service.

To help recover its costs, the Company is proposing to increase the rates for Directory Assistance calls from \$.30 to \$.40 per call (after the three-call allowance). Southwestern Bell is proposing that there be no change in the number of free Directory Assistance calls allowed each month (currently three) and that customers who qualify for exemption of Directory Assistance charges because of visual or physical handicaps continue to be exempt from these charges. The company also proposes to begin charging \$.25 per call for Directory

Assistance from pay telephones.
If approved by the Commission, this proposed rate change for Directory Assistance will increase the Company's annual revenues by \$15.4 million, which is an increase of approximately one half of 1 percent in the Company's adjusted revenue for the twelve-month period ending December 1990. This proposed rate change would affect approximately 900,000 residence customers, approximately 155,000 business customers, approximately 500 private pay telephone owners and all customers who make Directory Assistant


