
# New Nursing Home Will Offer 70 Jobs

Woodville City Fa-thers met Monday and agreed to plat and restriction changes allowing a 90-bed nursing home to be constructed, full speed ahead, on about two-thirds of the acreage existing in the Timberland West Subdivision located south of Hwy 190 at the west city

The council was pleased to hear from Jeff Smithers, representing Smithers Construction Company, that the facilty would create a \$780,000 annual payroll in hiring some 70 person-

Smithers told the council that Healthcare Development Inc., currently owns nine nursing homes and has 11 under lease. The newest facility comparable to the one scheduled to be built in Woodville, is located in Crockett.

Smithers said the facility would cost \$2 million to construct.

Tom Knapp inquired as to the resident costs at the home to which Smithers replied," \$32 to \$71 for Medicare and \$45 for private pay."

"It sounds like a real asset to the community"! Knapp said.

Smithers said his firm developes nursing homes in Texas, Arkansas and Missouri.' The one in Woodville would contain some 30,000 sq. ft., be said. The 70 jobs would equal about \$60,000 or \$75,000 per month.

Smithers said the existing facilities in Woodville were "At about 95 percent of capacity and his firm has been permitted by the state to proceed with the project.

Smithers said his firm, "Would move quickly and the project ought to be completed in 6 or 7 months.

#### Public Notice

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Company), in accordance with the rules of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), hereby gives notice of its intent to implement a new schedule of telephone rates in Texas for Directory Assistance Services, effective August 1, 1991, unless otherwise determined by the Commission. The Company has filed an application with the Commission to restructure and change the rates for Directory Assistance Service.

To help recover its costs, the Company is proposing to increase the rates for Directory Assistance calls from \$.30 to \$.40 per call (after the three-call allowance). Southwestern Bell is proposing that there be no change in the number of free Directory Assistance calls allowed each month (currently three) and that customers who qualify for exemption of Directory Assistance charges because of visual or physical handicaps continue to be exempt from these charges. The company also proposes to begin charging \$.25 per call for Directory Assistance from pay telephones.

If approved by the Commission, this proposed rate change for Directory Assistance will increase the Company's annual revenues by \$15.4 million, which is an increase of approximately one half of 1 percent in the Company's adjusted revenue for the twelve-month period ending December 1990. This proposed rate change would affect approximately 900,000 residence customers, approximately 155.000 business customers, approximately 500 private pay telephone owners and all customers who make Directory Assistance

Senate Joint Resolution 42 proposes a constitutional amendment that would authorize the newly created county education districts to hold elections to exempt from ad valorem taxation a percentage of the market value of the residence homestead of a married or unmarried adult. The percentage exempted could not exceed 20% of such market value, and the amount exempted could not be less than \$5,000. The amendment would also authorize county education districts to hold elections to exempt from ad valorem taxation not less than \$3,000 of the market value of the residence homestead of a disabled person or a person sixty-five years of age or older. Finally, the amendment would authorize elections in county education districts

for the taxation of certain tangible personal property exempted from ad valorem taxation by the legislature. The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows: and to provide for the taxation of certain tangible personal

that would allow the legislature to pass general laws authorizing Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board or its successor to issue and sell up to \$300 million of general obligation bonds to finance educational loans to students. The maximum net effective interest rate to be borne by the bonds would be set by law. The amendment would also anthorize the legislature to provide for the investment of bond proceeds and to establish an interest and sinking fund to pay the bonds and provide for the investment of such fund. 
