Absentee Vote Ends At 324 For Aug. 10th Election

Absentee voting for the Saturday, August 10 election ended Tuesday with 324 Ballots cast, according to County Clerk Donaco Gregory.

On election day, August 10, all Tyler County voting boxes will be open from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m.

Each school district is also conducting an election August 10 on behalf of the newly-formed Tyler County Education District (CED).

Voters in the CED election must cast their ballots in the school district in which they reside.

On Saturday, CED voting will be held in the usual school election voting locations.

Amendment election

Voters statewide are being asked to vote "for" or "against" the following proposed amendments to the state constitution:

Amendment No. 1 - "The constitutional amendment to allow voters of a county education district to adopt certain exemptions from the district's ad valorem taxation for residence homesteads and to provide for the taxation of certain tangible personal property."

Amendment No. 2 - "The constitutional amendment providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds to provide educational loans to students."

Voters should vote "for" Amendment No. 1 in the countywide election if they want to adopt any of the three county education district proposals. They should vote "against" Amendment No. 1 if they want to prohibit county education districts from granting optional homeowner exemptions and from taxing personal property. If Amendment No. 1 passes, voters can still vote not to tax personal property in the community by voting "against" the county education district proposal concerning taxation of personal property. They also have the option of defeating the homestead and over-65 exemptions at the CED level.

CED election

Voters are being asked to vote "for" or "against" the propositions that are on the CED election ballot:

Proposition 1 - "The taxation of all personal property, other than manu-

DETCOG Gets 'Favorable Review'

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments received a favorable review recently from the Economic Development Administration when a three-man EDA evaluation committee from Washington and Austin inspected the Council's efforts in Deep East Texas.

The evaluations team was made up of Al Garcia, chief of EDA's regions office, Civ'l Rights Division, in Austin; I.W. (Bill) Oliver, EDA community planner and program officer from Washington, D.C.; and Marvin Hagermeyer, chief of planning and technical assistance from EDA's regional office in Austin.

The team visited with Louis Bronaugh of Lufkin, president of DETCOG; John Thompson of Livingston, chairman of DETCOG's economic development committee; Elgin Davis of Livingston, Polk County's minority representative on the DETCOG board of directors; Joe McMurrey of Coldspring, San Jacinto County Judge and past DETCOG president; and Walter Diggins of Jasper, DETCOG executive director.

Diggins reported that the evaluation team suggested DETCOG may not be getting as much federal funds as the council should be, and that it may receive increased allotments in the future.

Diggins also said the Council is also being considered as a model demonstration project for export products through the East Texas area.

Reggie Williams, a 4-year letterman and Woodville High super-athlete and "Most Valuable Player" of his 3-A district decided to make the important trip to Stevenson where he will start his new baseball career at Tarleton State.

According to Tyler County Allstar Head Coach Gary Hemmigan, "Reggie was mainly recruited because of his power hitting and should be a mainstay on the Texans baseball squad." Reggie, who is also an all-district football running back, had to make a tough decision to drop the pigskin in order to play baseball.

Pitchers Mark Dorsey and Coy Laverne signed also and will be joining Reggie. Mark, an all-district right-hand pitcher from Woodville, and who lead the Eagles in wins, will hopefully be trying to make a name for himself at Tarleton State.

Laverne, from Warren, who was the "Most Valuable Player" in the East Chambers Tournament and in District 24-AA will pack up to go also as all three were members of the Tyler County Big League All Star Team. That team advanced to a Second Place Standing in the State Tournament in Waco and were defeated Thursday in the finals by San Antonio.

Tarleton Coach Jack Allen said, "I believe all three of these players can play college baseball and will definitely be an asset to our program here at Tarleton State. We feel fortunate to be able to land these players for our team."

The fourth local talent from Woodville High is Shannon Foster. Foster was also an all-district defensive tackle for Woodville.
