Colmesneil Kicks Off Academics

The Colmesneil ISD announces that the 1991-92 school year will begin for teachers on August 23 and for students on August 26, according to superintendent Larry Stinson. New students to the district will need transcripts, immunization record, social security number and birth certificate when enrolling at each campus.

School will begin at 8:05 a.m. and continue until 3:10 p.m. for a full day of school on August 26. Buses will run and meals will be served in the cafeteria on that day.

The Colmesneil school serves nutritious meals each school day. Elementary students may purchase lunch for 85 cents and breakfast for 50 cents. High school students may purchase lunch for \$1 and breakfast for 50 cents. Reduced prices for breakfast are 25 cents and reduced price for lunch is 40 cents. If you now get food stamps or AFDC for your child, your child can get free meals.

Applications for the free or reduced price meals will be given to each child. Completed applications should be returned to the school as soon as possible. Incomplete applications cannot be processed. In addition to the lunches the cafeteria also serves a snack bar with a variety of salads, sandwiches, baked potatoes, fruit, ice cream, etc., for grades 7-12.

All adult lunches will be \$1.50 and breakfasts 50 cents. Parents are requested to pay for breakfasts and lunches with a separate check. There will be no charges allowed. Colmesneil ISD offers vocational programs in Vocational Home Economics and Vocational Agriculture. Admission to these programs is based on enrollment in the Colmesneil ISD.

It is the policy of Colmesneil ISD not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, handicap or age in its employment practices as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

Rural Traffic Report

The Texas Highway Patrol investigated a total of 21 rural traffic accidents in Tyler County during the month of July according to Sergeant Roy D. Henry, supervisor of Highway Patrol Area 2B-4. As a result of these accidents, troopers reported 15 injuries and 3 traffic fatalities. Thus far in 1991, Tyler County Troopers have responded to a total of 1257 rural traffic accidents since January 1, which have resulted in 7 deaths and 86 persons being injured.

In the ten East Texas Counties that comprise Highway Patrol Sub-District 2B-B; Angelina, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, Shelby, Trinity and Tyler; Highway Patrol Troopers have responded to a total of 1257 rural traffic accidents since January 1.
