Woodville's Don W. Shaw Gets Manager Appointment

Don W. Shaw, 45, has been appointed to serve as City Secretary with additional duties as City Manager effective January 1, Woodville Mayor Tom Knapp announced at a special city municipal meeting Monday at noon.

Knapp had asked that all city employees be present for the meeting and told the city workers, "It was a real challenge with over 50 applicants. The council felt like it has

picked the best person for the City of Woodville and someone you'll be proud to work for."

"The council took lots of time and thought," Knapp said, "narrowing the selection down to nine candidates...and Don Shaw was the best all-around choice."

Shaw brings to the City of Woodville a wealth of financial expertise including a background in insurance

sales. He is a graduate of Texas Tech University in 1968. He was born in Morton, Tx, where he attended elementary and high school.

In various civic endeavors Shaw has served as Chairman of the Tyler County Fair, served as Alderman of the Woodville City Council, Chairman of the Finance Committee at the Woodville United Methodist Church; Past President of the Woodville Ro-

tary Club and Past Director of the Woodville Chamber of Commerce. He is married to

Blanche (Sissy) Risinger Shaw. The couple has two children: Nathaniel, 16 and William, 12.

These initials, (CNOR - Certified Nurse in the Operating Room), represent a standard of excellence in knowledge and experience in the operating room which exceeds the accepted standards of care. Mrs. Mack stood for the National Certified Operating Room Nurse Boards, September 21, in Houston and she received notification of this successful achievement October 21.

Hospital regulatory agencies do not require the operating room supervisor

to be certified. Because it is not required, few rural hospitals are fortunate enough to have OR Supervisors who have achieved this level of expertise, he said.

In addition to this accomplishment, Mrs. Mack received training at St. Elizabeth hospital in Beaumont for the use of laparoscopic surgical equipment. Laparoscopic surgical procedures will be available at TCH effective November 1. Surgeons from both Beaumont and Lufkin will be available in Woodville to perform these surgical procedures. It is the hope of the Surgical Department that resi-

dents of Tyler County will find this useful and prevent the inconvenience of traveling out of town.

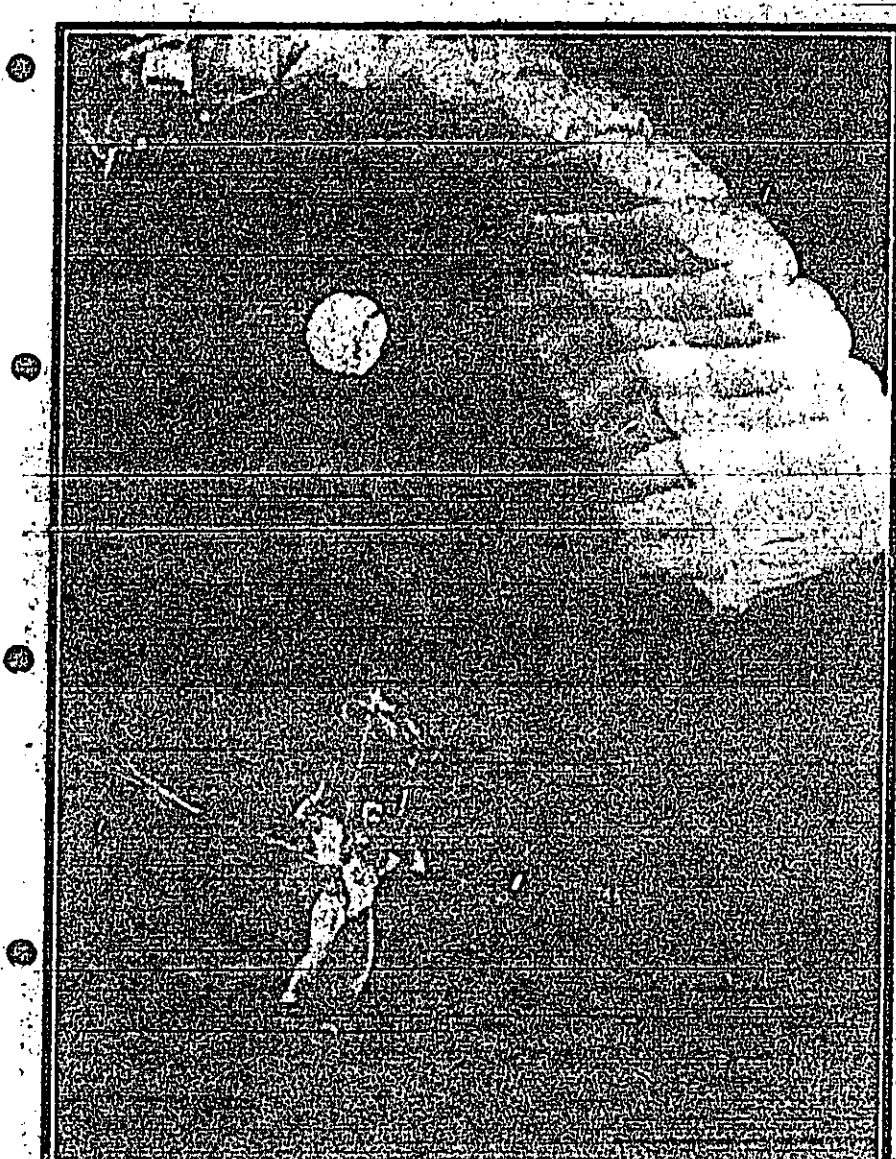
Post To Observe Vets Day Nov. 11

our area's finest storytellers recall ghost stories of Texas past.

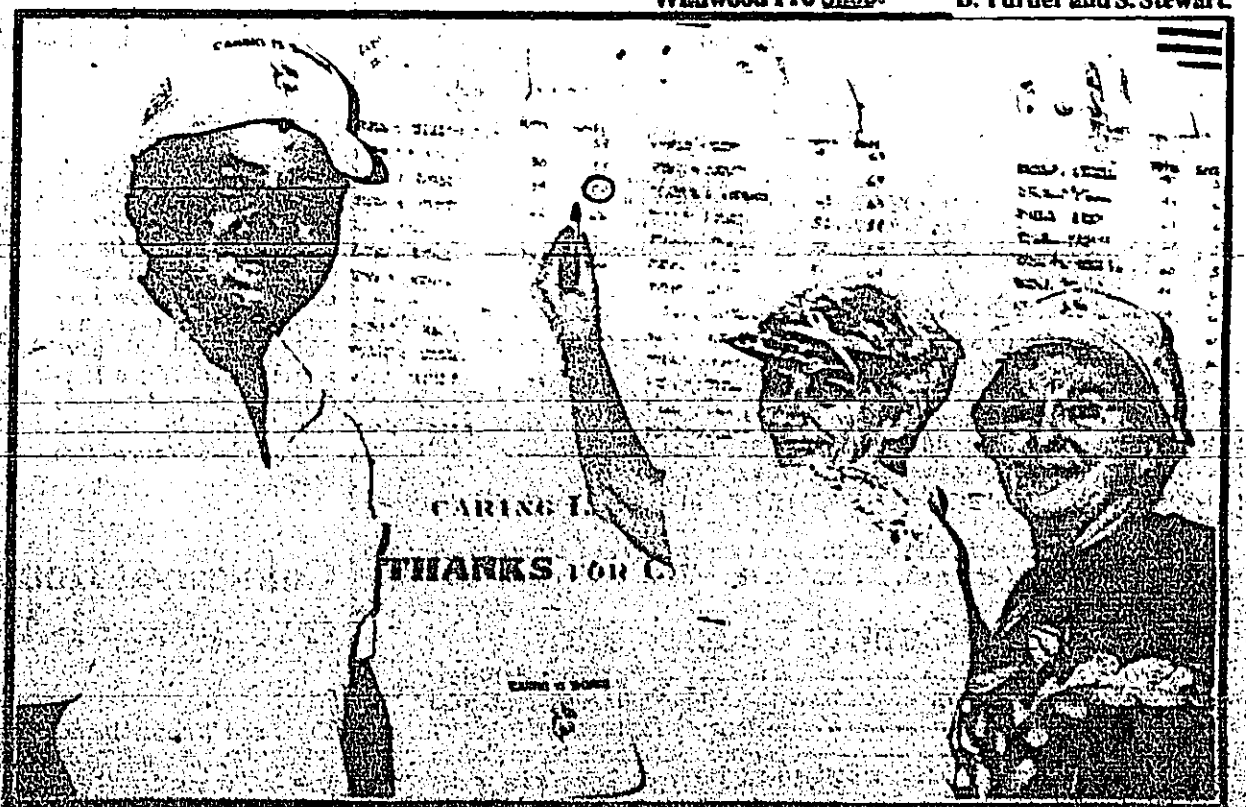

Can Sunglasses Delay Vision Loss?

Medical reports indicate the sun may play a role in the development of cataracts, growths on the eye's lens, and in the development of melanoma (cancer) within the eyes. Now researchers are finding another irreversible eye problem to sunlight.

Much like the chance of developing 'skin' cancer is increased by daily exposure to sunlight, eye physicians believe the sun's ultraviolet and blue-violet rays are involved in the advancement of Aging Retinal Disease (also called macular degeneration). This is usually a slowly progressing form of vision loss which primarily affects older adults (A fast-progressing but less common form of the disease can be treated with lasers.) It robs adults of their central vision for reading or watching TV. (Fortunately, complete blindness never results from this disorder.) It is the fastest growing cause of blindness in the U.S. It occurs more frequently among females, those with blue or green eyes, and those who have high blood pressure.

More recently eye doctors have noticed that "drusen"

spots at the back of the eyes may be an early indicator that Aging Retinal Disease will occur later in life.

Nearly one third of all adults have the drusen spots on their retinas. Sunlight is believed to be involved in drusen formation. Special sun goggles called SuperVisors have been developed to help protect the eyes from harmful sun rays thought to be a contributory cause of Aging Retinal Disease. You will want to ask your eye doctor if you have drusen spots during your next eye exam.
