Dick Davis Files For Tax Assessor Post

Richard "Dick" Davis filed December 12th for the position of Tax Assessor & Collector for Tyler County.

Dick is a life long resident of Tyler County, born in Woodville and attended Kirby High in 1941, chosen as most outstanding boy of the class. Going on to Sam Houston State for two years where he earned as Who-who's my Sophomore year. After serving three years in the U.S. Navy, reaching the rank of Spec. 1 First Class, I came home and went to the University of Texas in Austin, receiving a BBA Degree in 1949.

For the next twelve years I was in the Supermarket business with my Father when I became the Woodville School Tax Assessor and Collector in 1963 through 1969. During this six years we mapped the entire District which is about one third of the County and set up a delinquent ledger for delinquent taxes. In other words I ran the tax office like a business and had a perfect audit record for all six years.

In 1969 I became Manager of Southeast Texas Savings & Loan. It grew from \$3 million to over \$33 million in deposits and from one small office in Woodville to a large two story home office and branch offices in Kountze and Livingston. I was the Chief Loan Officer and Appraiser as well as Administrator of all offices for thirteen years. In 1982 I went to Aztec Savings & Loan in Copperas Cove, Texas as President. There we made V/A loans to men on Fort Hood to build off base housing to the tune of over \$500 thousand per month. After the Savings & Loan was sold to some Fort Worth investors, we moved to Austin where my two children live. While in Austin we both received our Real Estate License (Con'td On Pg. 8-A)

With a little bit of hammering, the tree was securely fastened to the wall.

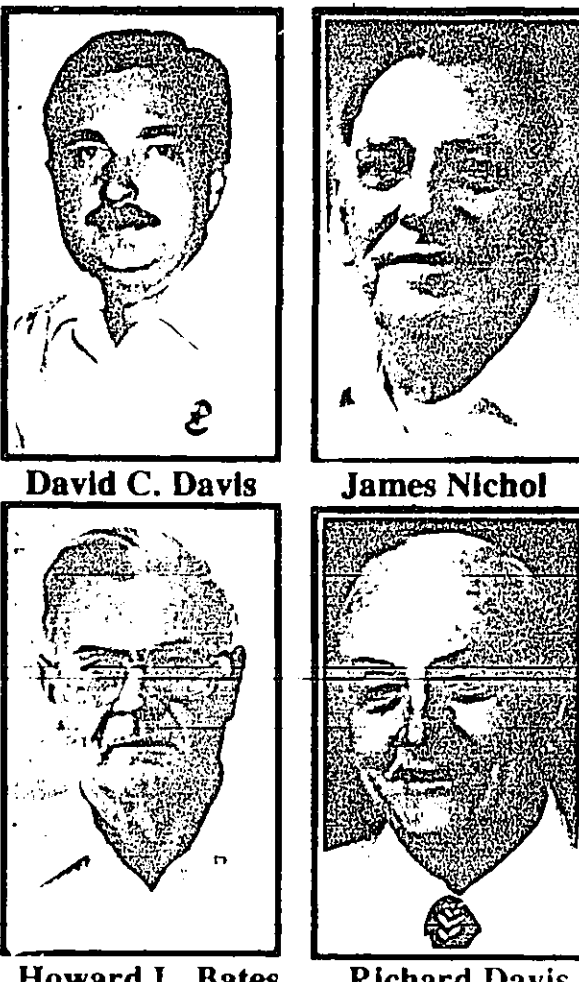

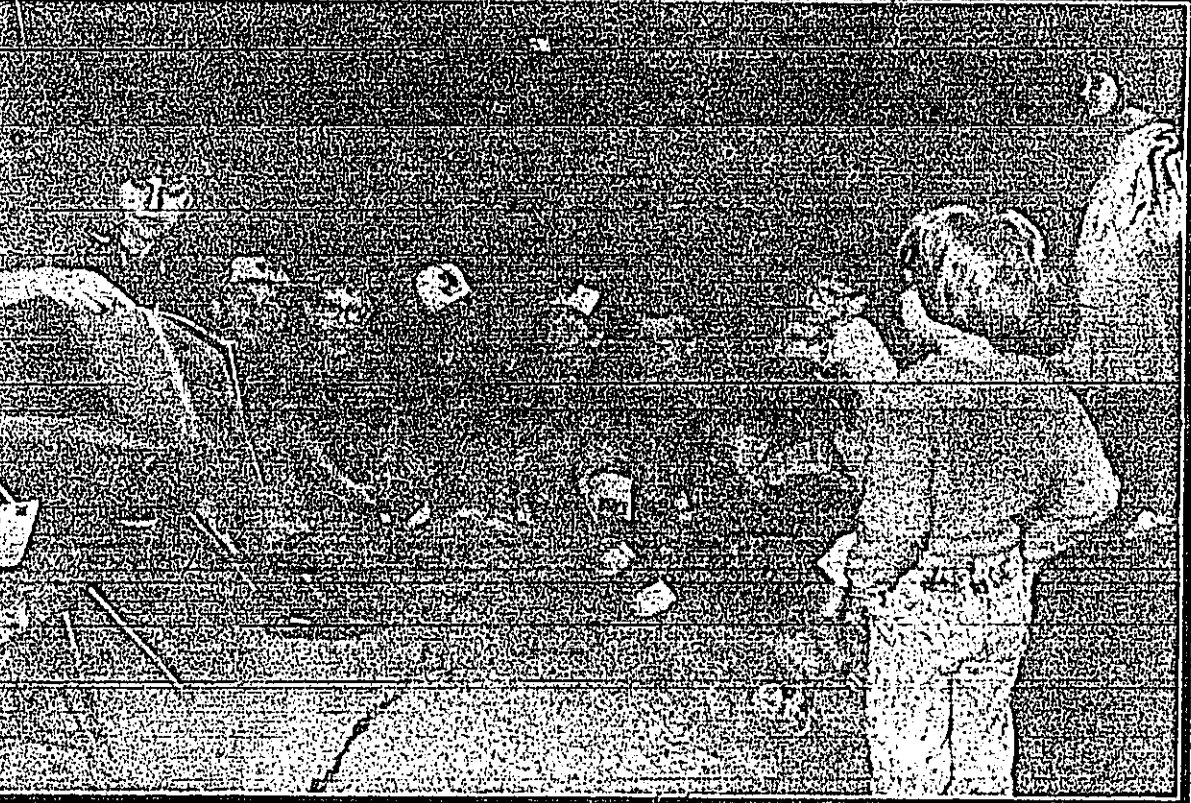

Eugene Waldrep

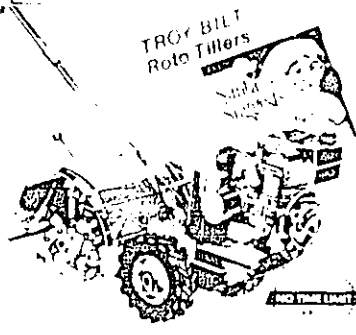

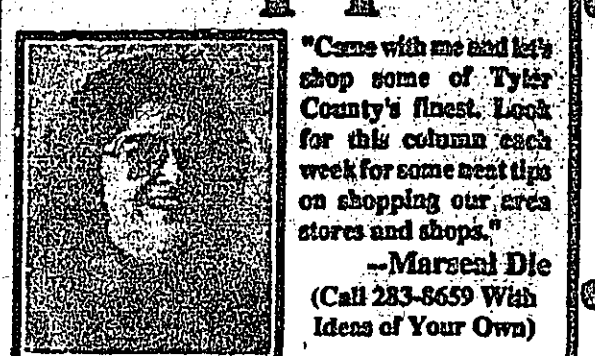

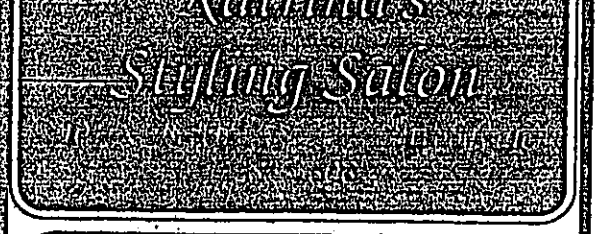

Airman Parker Graduates Basic

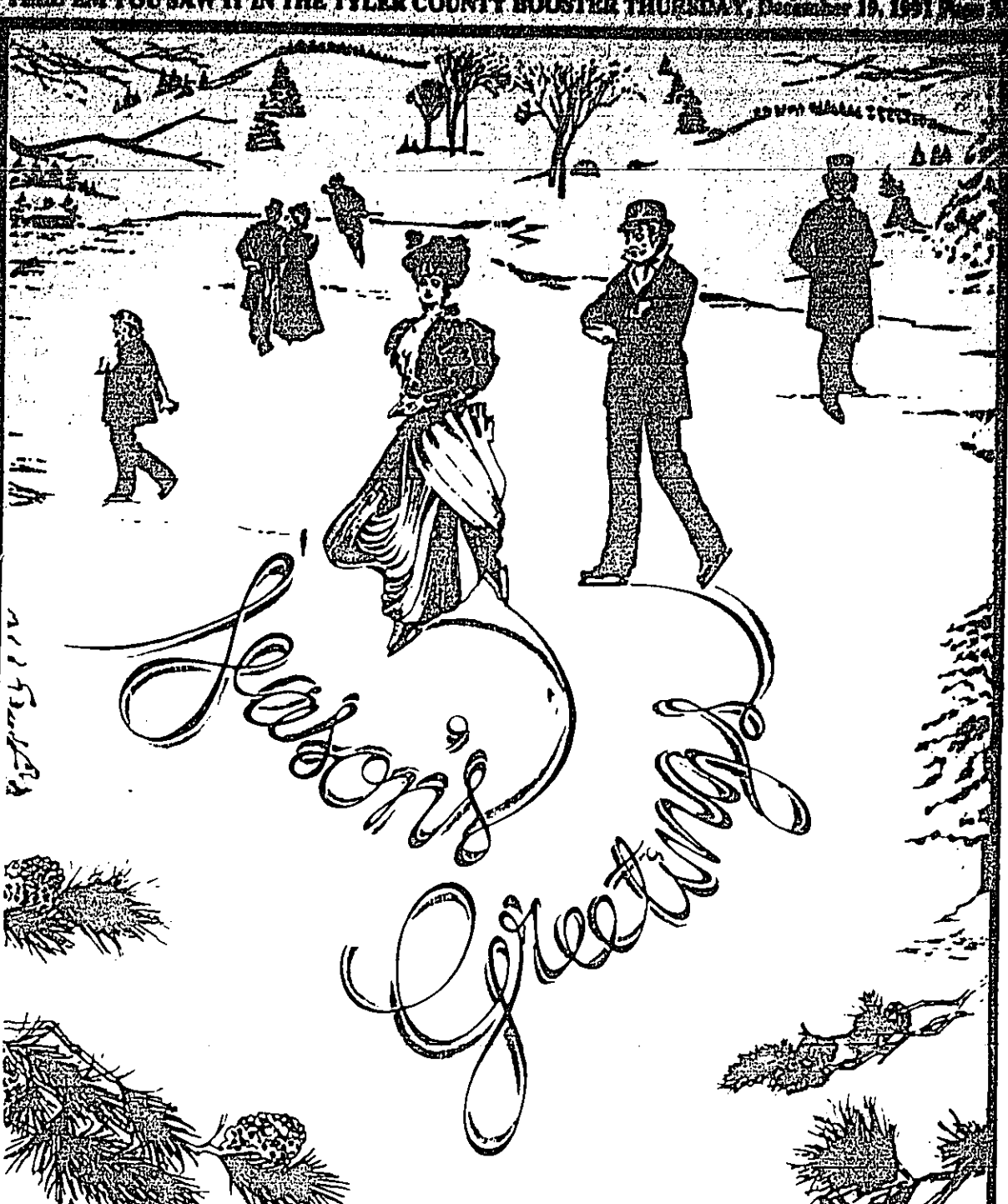

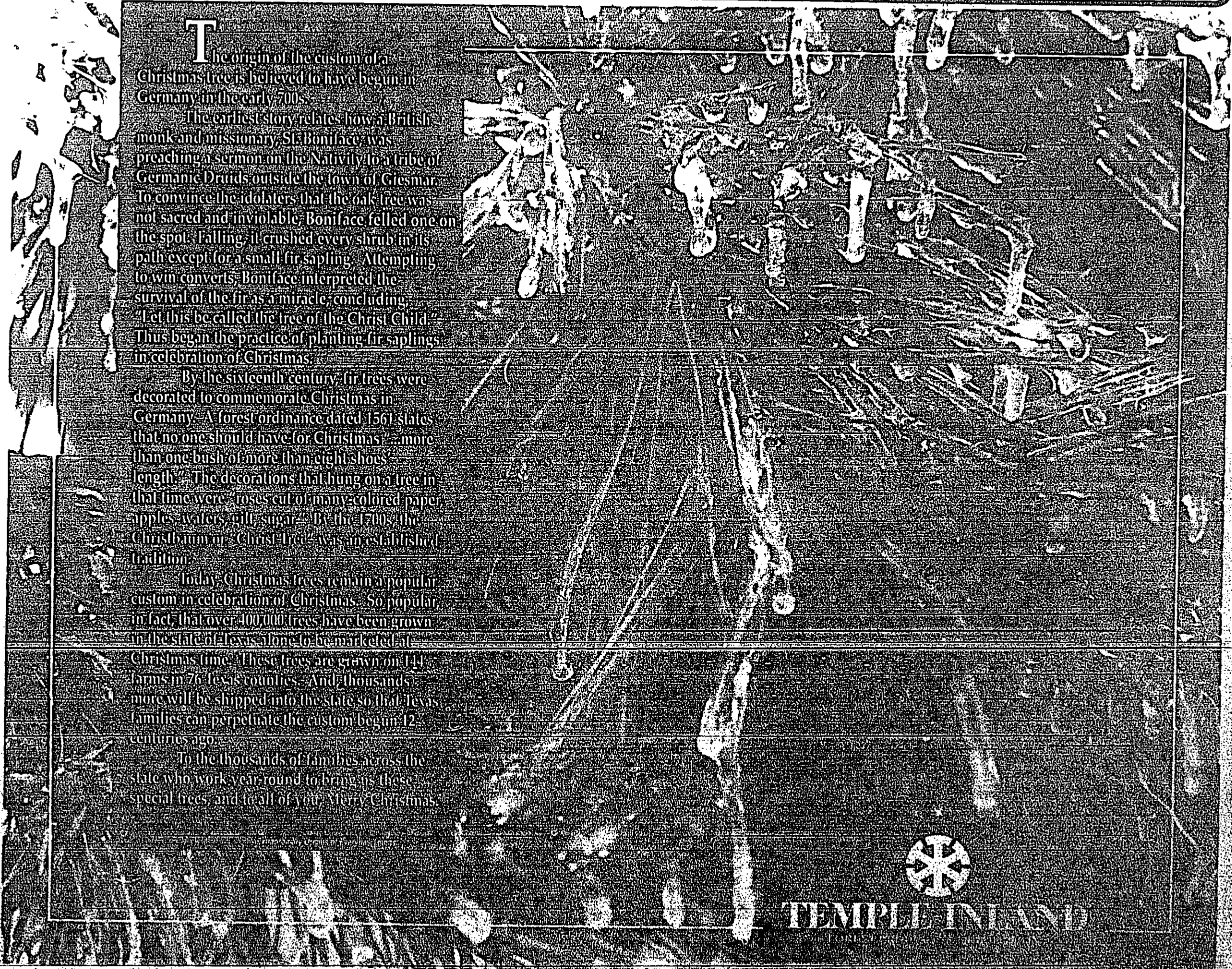
