Commerce Head Is DETDA Guest

Cathy Bonner, Executive Director of the Texas Department of Commerce and a key figure in Texas' Economic Development efforts, will address the Deep East Texas Development Association at its annual meeting in Lufkin Friday, January 24.

The meeting will be held at Crown Colony Country Club, beginning at 6 p.m. with a reception in Ms. Bonner's honor. The dinner meeting begins at 7 p.m.

A highlight of the meeting will be the presentation of DETDA's annual "Silver Bucket Award," which is given annually to a Deep East Texas leader. Last year's award went to former Tyler County Judge Allen Sturrock of Woodville.

Reservations for the DETDA meeting may be made by calling DETDA's office in Lufkin, 639-4734. Tickets are \$20 per person. Recently appointed by Governor Richards to a

two-year term, Ms. Bonner heads the State's ninth largest agency with an annual budget of more than \$300 million. She is responsible for the State's economic development efforts, workforce training and re-training, and tourism activities.

Prior to her appointment, she was director of Economic Development and International Relations for Governor Richards' Policy Council, which was created in 1991 to advise the governor on policy concerning domestic and international relations and economic development.

Ms. Bonner also served

as chair of the 1991 Texas Inaugural Committee for Governor Richards.

"Cathy Bonner has a strong interest in economic development for rural Texas, and will have a message of interest to the people of Deep East Texas," said DETDA President Tony Bennett.

Ms. Bonner is a 17-veteran of the advertising and marketing business, has managed accounts for Fortune 500 companies, and has been awarded twice the American Council for Economic Development Award for materials produced for the State of Texas.

VA Slashes Interest Rates

Washington-The Veterans Administration has slashed interest rates on VA loans to 8 percent, the lowest in 14 years, in an attempt to give Veterans a better chance to buy homes. This puts VA-guaranteed interest rates at a full two points below where they were in 1990 and clears the way for even more U.S. Military Veterans to buy and own their first homes, said U.S. Sen. Phil Gramm. The Senator also expressed hope that the interest rate cut would stimulate the economy. "Veterans who already own homes under VA loans should consider refinancing at this new, low rate," Gramm said. He noted that the rate cut means the typical mortgage payment under a VA loan will drop by \$121 a month.



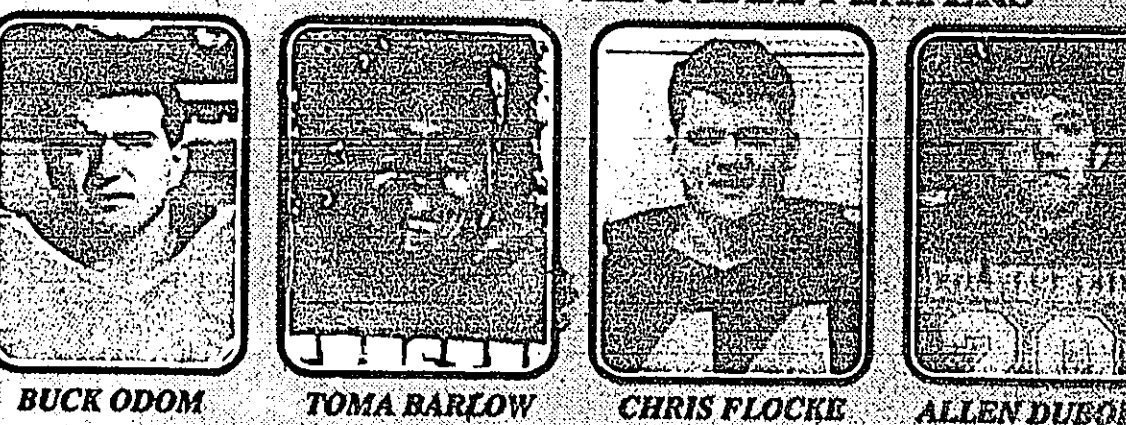

PREVENTING ELECTRICAL FIRES AT HOME

Electricity serves us well, and safely if we treat it with the respect it deserves. Most often we think of electricity when we consider the danger of electric shock. But another hazard is electrical fires. Recent reports indicate that arcing or overloaded electrical circuits rank second only to cigarettes as a cause of multiple deaths. Fires caused by electrical wiring are still a major cause of death. If a breaker or fuse "blows" often or repeatedly, have an electrician check it immediately.

The smell of burning plastic, warm wall receptacles and flickering or dimming lights signal serious wiring problems.

Electrical cords (especially extension cords) can be overloaded or short-circuited easily.

Aluminum wiring in some homes built between 1965 and 1973 can pose hazardous situations because it expands and contracts easily and can come loose at connection points.

If a cord or plug gets warm, it is overloaded.

REPAIR WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- Discard damaged extension cords (even slightly damaged ones).
- Use only extension cords designed for outdoor use for electrical needs outside.
- Don't overload circuits.
- Keep appliances and motors clean and in good working order.
- Don't leave appliances such as clothes dryers running when you're away from home.
- All appliances and extension cords should carry the mark of a recognized testing facility, such as Underwriters Laboratories.
