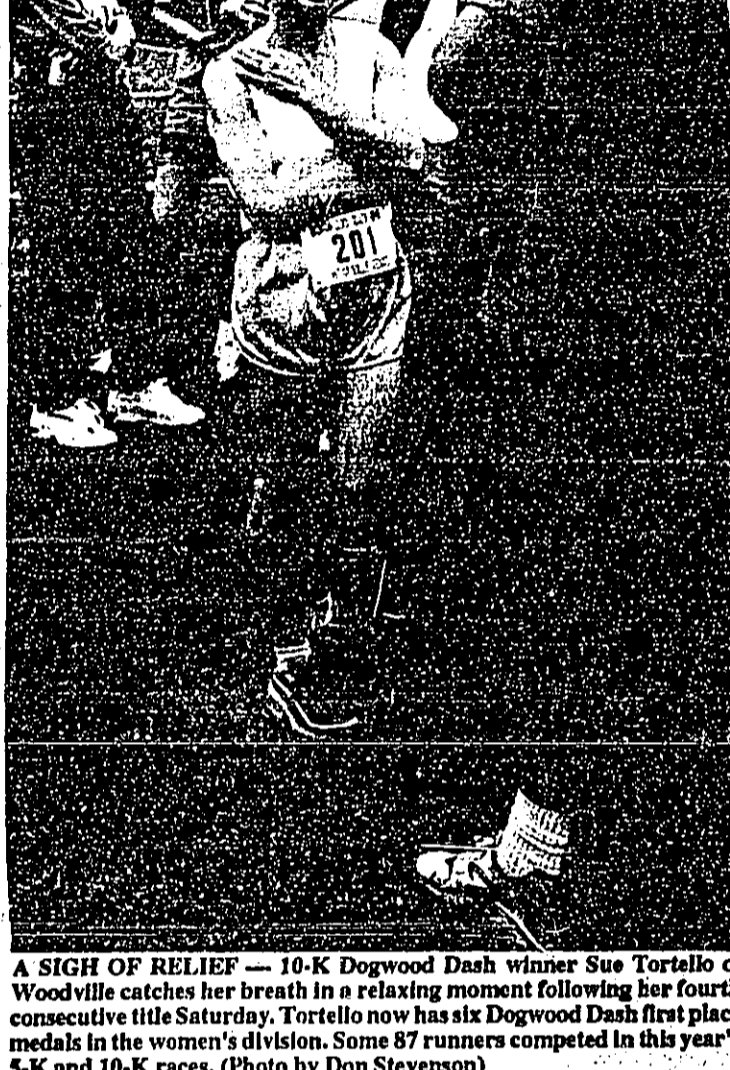

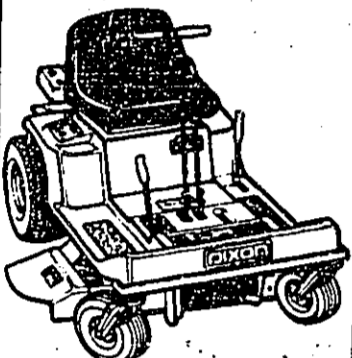

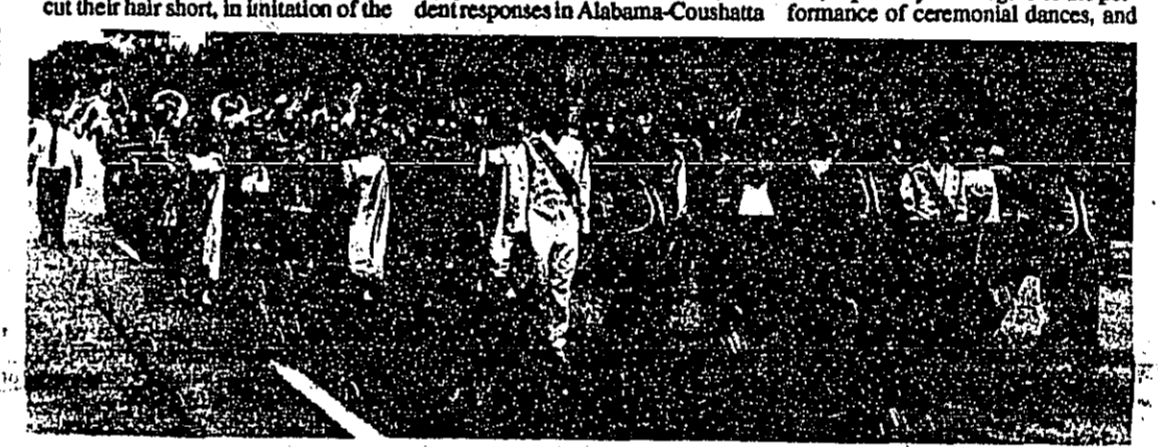
appeal in-school suspension to the board. There was no evidence that the plaintiff's parents were given notice of the suspensions, or told of any avenues of appeal. Although students receive their assignments while in detention, which is presided over by a teacher's aide, the students generally fell behind in their school work while they were suspended. In comparison to the students who attended regular classes, "according to Justice's findings, the students, and the parents of the students disciplined, encourage and support their children's participation in cultural activities. The tribe and the parents, while not requiring young men to wear their hair long, approve of the practice because of its religious significance and because of the desire to preserve the tribe's cultural heritage and traditions."

Justice ruled that the Native American Indian movement is a religion and, therefore, entitled to First Amendment protection. "While it may seem rather nebulous and unstructured to persons versed in more traditional religions, such as Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism, or Islam, (it) is certainly a religion, as is aptly demonstrated by its system of beliefs concerning the relationship of human beings and their bodies to nature and reality."

According to Justice, the disparity in the children's participation in cultural activities, and the fact that the children are not allowed to wear their hair long, is a violation of their religious beliefs. The court also found that the school's policy of requiring students to wear their hair short is a violation of the First Amendment.

in closing, Justice stated, "The granting of preliminary injunctive relief is in the public interest, as it promotes tolerance for the diverse viewpoints, and fosters understanding and sensitivity toward Native American students and, indeed, toward all students who have beliefs which fall outside of our society's mainstream, ethnocentric belief system."

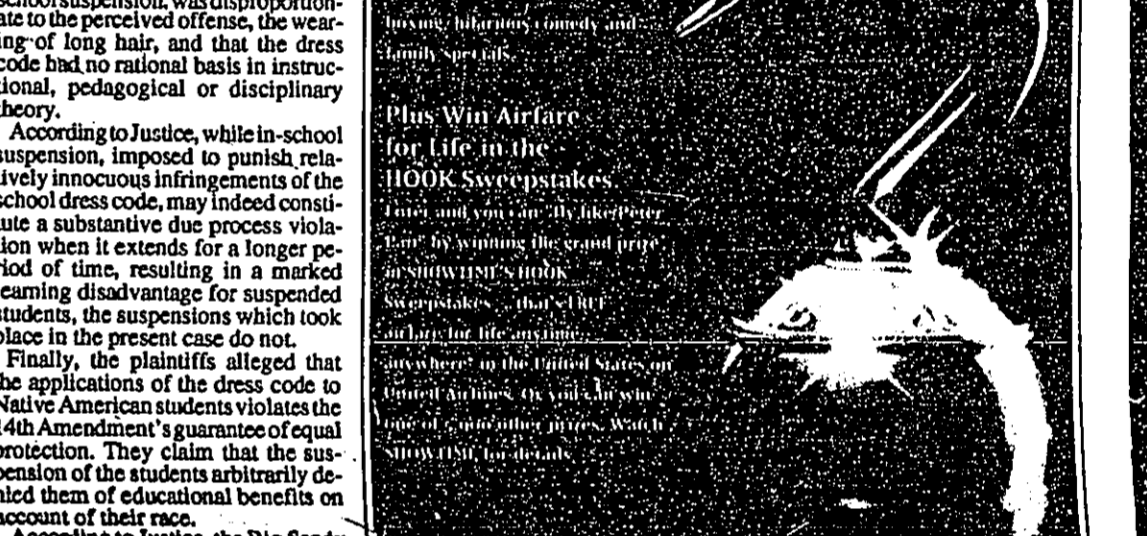
In addition to seeking fees incurred in the pursuit of the preliminary injunction, the plaintiffs are also seeking interim attorney's fees, which are available to plaintiffs who prevail in First Amendment actions. "I am very appreciative of the support shown by the tribe, Tribal Council and tribal members, and consider this a fitting tribute to the courage these students showed in standing up against the school which was persecuting them because of their religious observances," Donald Juneau of New Orleans, attorney for the plaintiffs, said.

Big Sandy ISD Superintendent Thomas Foster declined comment at this time, as he has not yet received a copy of the ruling. Mike Buchanan of Dallas, attorney for Big Sandy ISD, was unavailable for comment.

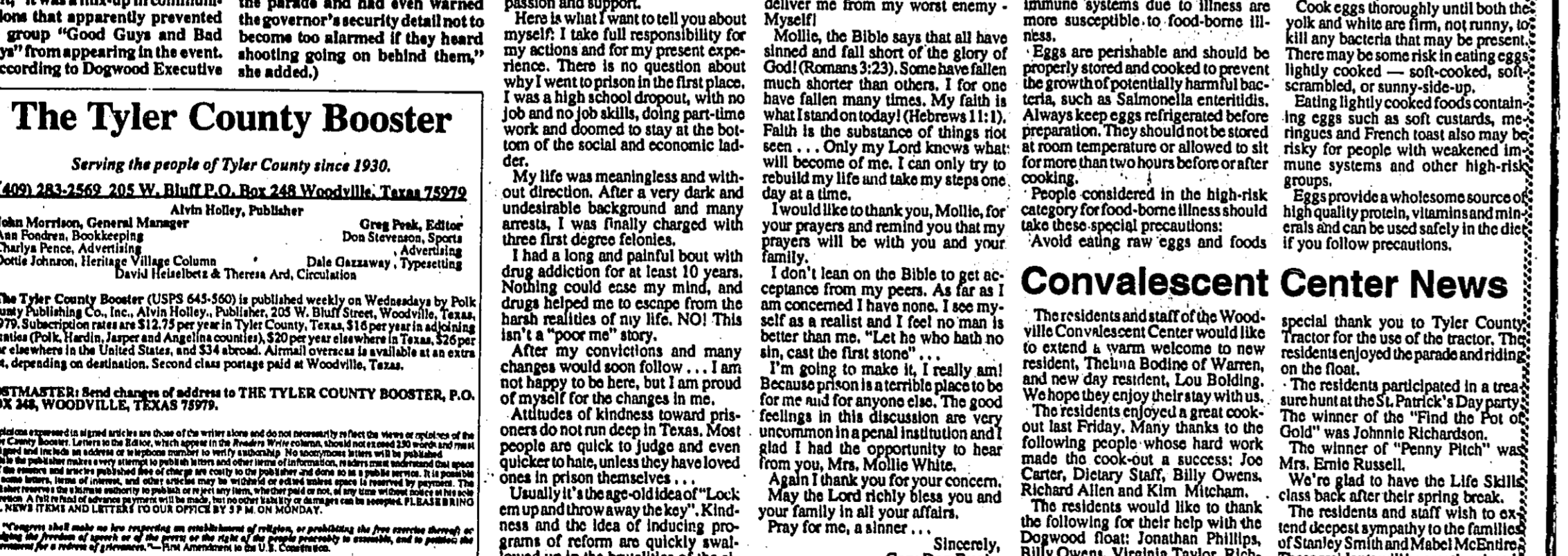

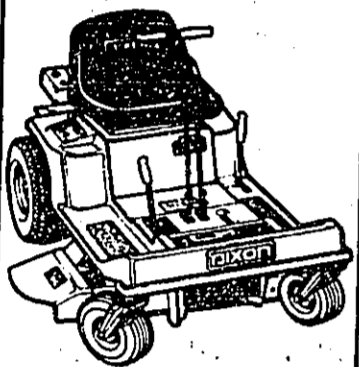

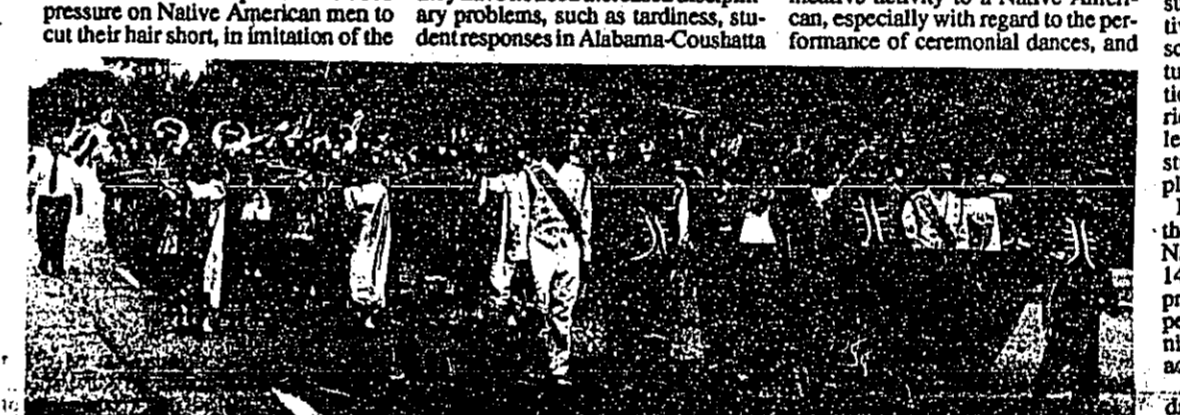
