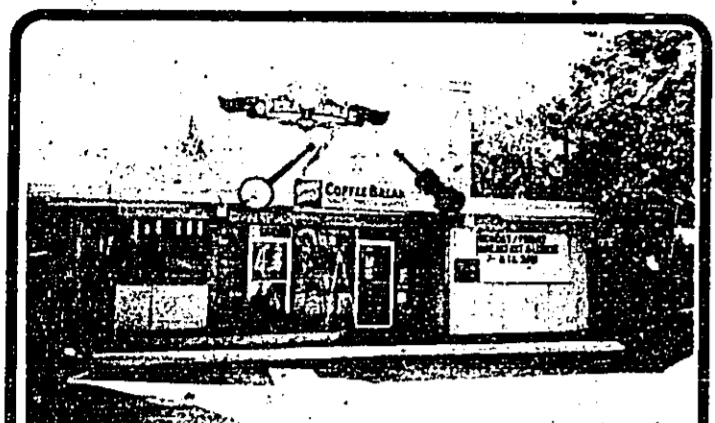

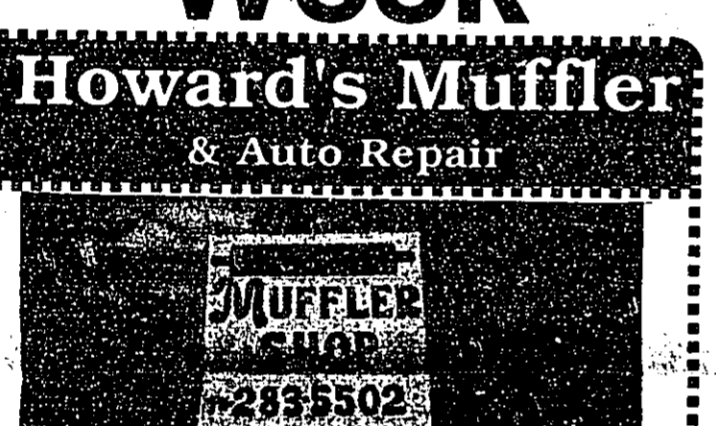

ports in Beaumont, Port Arthur and Orange. "Not only will these routes provide emergency evacuation routes from the coastal areas, but there will be important to the economic vitality of all communities along the routes."

In his remarks, Bensen said the two "key improvements" would be the expansion of Highway 69 and 96 into four-lane, divided thoroughfares. Highway 69 runs north from Beaumont through Jasper and on through Sam Augustine and Center. Bensen also noted that the expansion of these two highways will become doubly important if the proposed extension of Interstate 69 comes through East Texas.

The proposed route, which is being backed by a newly organized Texas I-69 Committee, U.S. Rep. Charles Wilson, Bensen and other leaders, calls for the interstate highway to enter Texas at Center, connect with the existing Highway 59 route near Nacogdoches and then proceed along Highway 59 through Lufkin, Livingston, Cleveland, Houston to Laredo. Bensen noted the interstate would eventually proceed into Mexico. "Another route which is being backed by Louisiana officials, calls for the interstate to turn south at Shreveport."

Softball program approved

WOODVILLE — Woodville ISD athletic director Preston Broom received the go-ahead in a special meeting of the Board of trustees to plan for a 1993-94 girls' varsity fast-pitch softball team.

According to Broom, Texas has 240 UFL varsity fast-pitch softball teams in 32 districts grouped into eight regions. Woodville's team would be in Region IV. District 14, which would put them in competition with schools including Orangefield, Vidor, Bridge City and Port Neches. "I'm excited," Broom told the board regarding his recent survey of Woodville eighth through eleventh graders. "I'm excited that we're definitely interested in participating."

He added that the Tyler County Girls' Softball League (TCGSL) has had fast-pitch teams for the past two years now, so there would be students available who already have experience with fast-pitch softball. The team, approved as a pilot project for the upcoming year, would begin playing earlier in the year than baseball teams. The school year softball playoffs occur in the month of May. The project has been estimated by Broom to cost about \$15,000, with almost half that amount consisting of expense for equipment. According to Assistant Superintendent Tommy Weaver, the money is not available in the current athletic budget, so it would have to come from other sources.

"We could charge an admission fee (for the games)," suggested Broom, "since there's a gate you have to go through to enter the facility (the TCGSL field.)" \$1,500 of the cost discussed is a field rental fee estimate to TCSS. The school year has a similar arrangement with Henning Park for the baseball team. Broom will begin signing girls for next year's team sometime within the next 30 days. He hopes to enroll as many as possible of those interested in athletics class next year, however, when asked if the girls would have to enroll in athletics in order to qualify for the team, he said no. "It could be an after-school activity... we're not going to keep a girl from playing fast-pitch ball just because she's not in the regular school schedule for athletics. And with the high school team, kids can begin playing during the school year, then sign up for the county softball league and play into the summer."

Broom stressed that college is a major potential benefit of the project. "There are opportunities for college scholarships for fast-pitch softball out there," he pointed out. "And it's hard to get a college coach to come to a summer league game. That's what we're trying to do - get as many of these kids as we can to go to college -"
