The Housing Authority of the City of Livingston offers safe, decent, affordable housing for low-income families, elderly persons, and those who are handicapped or disabled. Applications for our program may be placed at the Housing Authority office between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday after the 10th of the month. THERE IS NO CHARGE OR FEE TO APPLY FOR HOUSING. All registration and application procedures are handled without charge. Only when you are issued a unit will an applicant be required to make any payment to anyone. Your security deposit and first month's rent are to be paid to the Livingston Housing Authority. Rents are based on the applicant's income. Apartments become vacant from time to time and are filled from the waiting list. The waiting list is made up of applicants determined by the Housing Authority to be eligible. All persons are invited to apply for housing and are processed without regard to race, sex, religion, handicap, familial status, color, or national origin. 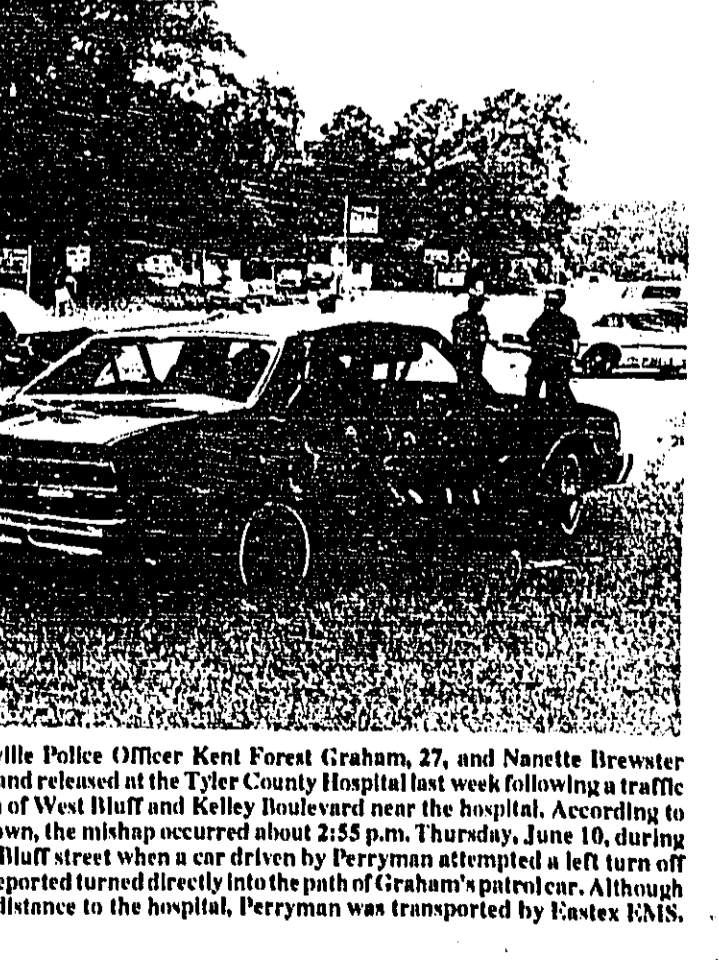
