## Denton man survives 20,000 volt accident

DOUCETTE — Discussed by both electrical and medical officials as "a very very lucky man," a 26-year-old Denton contractor not only survived coming into contact with a 20,000-volt Gulf States Utility power distribution line but escaped serious injury. David Jackson was reportedly installing a television cable line near Doucette Monday morning when his head came into contact with the power line. According to J.D. Spurlock of the Woodville GSU office, the mishap is believed to have occurred about 10 a.m. Monday when the man - who was working under contract for Friendship Cable - was in a bucket truck hooking what is known as a messenger line to a GSU utility pole. "I don't have all the details as to how it happened, but apparently the man somehow stuck his head into one of our high voltage lines," Spurlock said. Following the mishap, Jackson was carried in the back of a pickup truck to the Tyler County Hospital in Woodville by his fellow workers. "Our first indication that something was wrong came when we got a report of power being out at about 10:05 a.m.," Spurlock said. He said that a repair crew dispatched to the area on the Old Doucette Highway met the cable crew's pickup and were asked for directions to the hospital. Spurlock said the crew began leading the pickup into Woodville when they encountered a Tyler County Sheriff's Department patrol unit which then escorted the injured man to the local hospital. According to Tyler County Hospital Administrator Jim Gainer, the injured man was in surprisingly good condition considering the massive electric shock he received. The victim was listed in very stable condition when he was transferred Monday by Eastex Ambulance to the burn unit of See SHOCK, pg. 3A

## Garbage transfer station design okayed

WOODVILLE — Preliminary drawings for Tyler County's solid waste transfer station were given the green light by county commissioners Friday during a special meeting in Woodville. Wayne Stolz of the engineering firm of Everett Griffith Jr. and Associates, presented the preliminary design drawings and noted that the final plans would be ready by about July 1 or 2. "At that point, we'll be ready to go out for bids," Stolz told the commissioners. The transfer station will consist of a garbage compacting unit as well as a pair of open bins in which people may dispose of appliances and waste lumber and limbs. "One thing we are proposing for this transfer station is to allow citizens to drive through and dump bagged garbage or leaves or what ever into the compactor," Stolz said, noting that the preliminary plans call for a ramp to allow residents to pull their vehicles into the compactor building, dump their garbage directly into the compactor and then drive out. "This access is intended mainly for those with small quantities of garbage. They can pull up to the compactor bin, get out and be on the same elevation and the hopper. The operator will be in the immediate vicinity so he can help, observe and make fee collections," Stolz added. Under the plan, those with large quantities of garbage, such as commercial trash collection companies, will have another access point to the compactor. The design would allow them to back their collection trucks up to the compactor bin - from the side opposite the drive through area - and dump their trash directly into the hopper. "The dump area is entirely under roof but the space for two open containers will be outside the building," he said, noting that the containers would be used to dispose of items that cannot be compacted, such as appliances, scrap building materials and other large pieces of metal and wood. ## Clark warns of scam

WOODVILLE — A warning regarding a telephone fraud being perpetrated out of Las Vegas, Nevada, was issued last week by Tyler County Criminal District Attorney James A. Clark. The DA noted that the scam is being presented by a party who gives his name as Kevin Osborn and who claims to be working for Silver Mountain Enterprises in Las Vegas. "The caller offers the party called a 1993 Mustang delivered immediately the next day after receiving by wire transfer (Western Union) the sum of \$4,600," he said. "After being informed about such a scam made to a local resident, Clark contacted the Fraud Division of the Las Vegas Police Department and learned that Silver Mountain Enterprise is not a company but a bogus operation. The Las Vegas authorities also said the name Kevin Osborn is false and is used by someone who also poses as a lawyer. The address given for the company is nothing more than a mail drop. The FBI also was notified of the matter by Clark, who issued a request to area residents to report to his office immediately any such call. He asks that those receiving such a call should attempt to get all the information available from the caller. "And, for goodness sake, do not send any more of a local resident, Clark said. Clark added.
