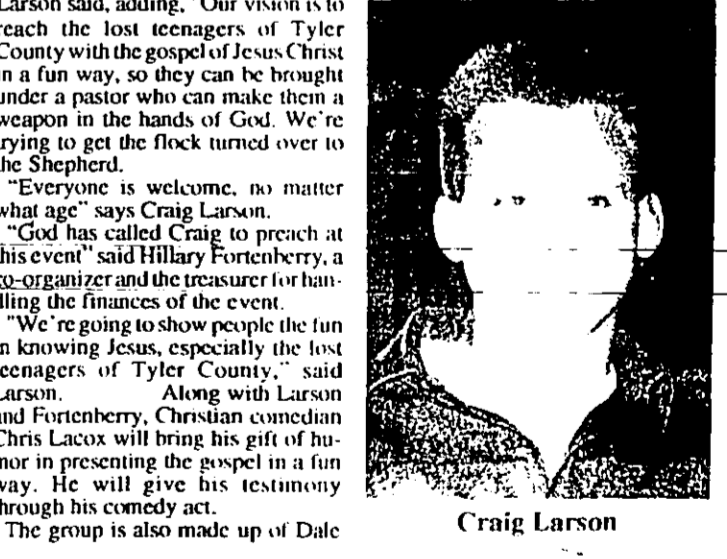
"Everyone is welcome, no matter what age," says Craig Larson.

Sawmill ghost towns subject of new book

LUFKIN — A limited edition history of sawmill and sawmill towns in eight East Texas counties, the result of research by Nederland historian W.T. Block, will be published this fall by the Pineywoods Foundation.

"East Texas Mill Towns and Ghost Towns," the first of three volumes on East Texas sawmill towns written by Block, will include Angellina, Chambers, Jefferson, Nacogdoches, Newton, Orange, Polk and Tyler counties.

"For years, W.T. Block has spent most of his waking hours visiting old sawmill sites, talking with those who lived and worked there and combing through thousands of documents. He put together the most comprehensive anthology of sawmill towns and ghost towns ever assembled in East Texas," said John Anderson of Nacogdoches, chairman of the Foundation.

Block has published two previous books, "A History of Jefferson County, Texas: From Wilderness to Reconstruction" and "Sapphire City of the Neches: A History of Fort Neches, Texas."

He retired from the U.S. Postal Service after 25 years, including 20 as assistant postmaster at Nederland and as officer-in-charge of the Orange post office. He is also retired from 10 years as postal director at Lamar University, where he received his BA degree in history in 1970 and his MA degree in 1974.

Hundreds of sawmill towns prospered in East Texas during lumbering's golden era between the 1850s and 1920s. But when the timber played out, many of the sawmills killed their towns and moved on, leaving behind overgrown forests, clusters of clapboard buildings, and remnants of concrete and steel.

Some of the sawmills and towns, however, overcame adversity by replanting their forests and diversifying their produce lines. They continue to be viable in the pineywoods today, supported by modern sawmills or other wood-using plants, as well as new forms of economic activity.

Disabled children may benefit from SSI

LUFKIN — The SSI program provides monthly benefits to more than a half million low-income children under age 18 who are blind or have disabilities. These children may qualify for disability benefits under SSI even if their parents do not. The children must meet Social Security's definition of disability or blindness in addition to meeting income, resource, and other eligibility requirements.

Children who have disabilities may now receive higher Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits as a result of a recent change in the way Social Security computes the effect of their parents' income on their payments.

For a child who is under 18, unmarried, and living with parents, Social Security may count some of the parents' income and resources as the child's. This process is called deeming.

Under the new rule, Social Security will use a single formula to calculate how much of the parents' income is deemed to the child, whether the income is earned, unearned, or a combination of the two. The new rule applies only when one or both parents are working.

Two groups of children are encouraged to contact Social Security to see if the new rule affects their eligibility: (1) children whose applications for SSI benefits were filed before Nov. 1992 and who were denied benefits based on their parents' income and (2) children for whom no application was filed because they believed their parents' income would make them ineligible.

Roderic Douglas was the winning pitcher in the bottom of the third with only six hits, struck out 14, and walked five in going the distance.

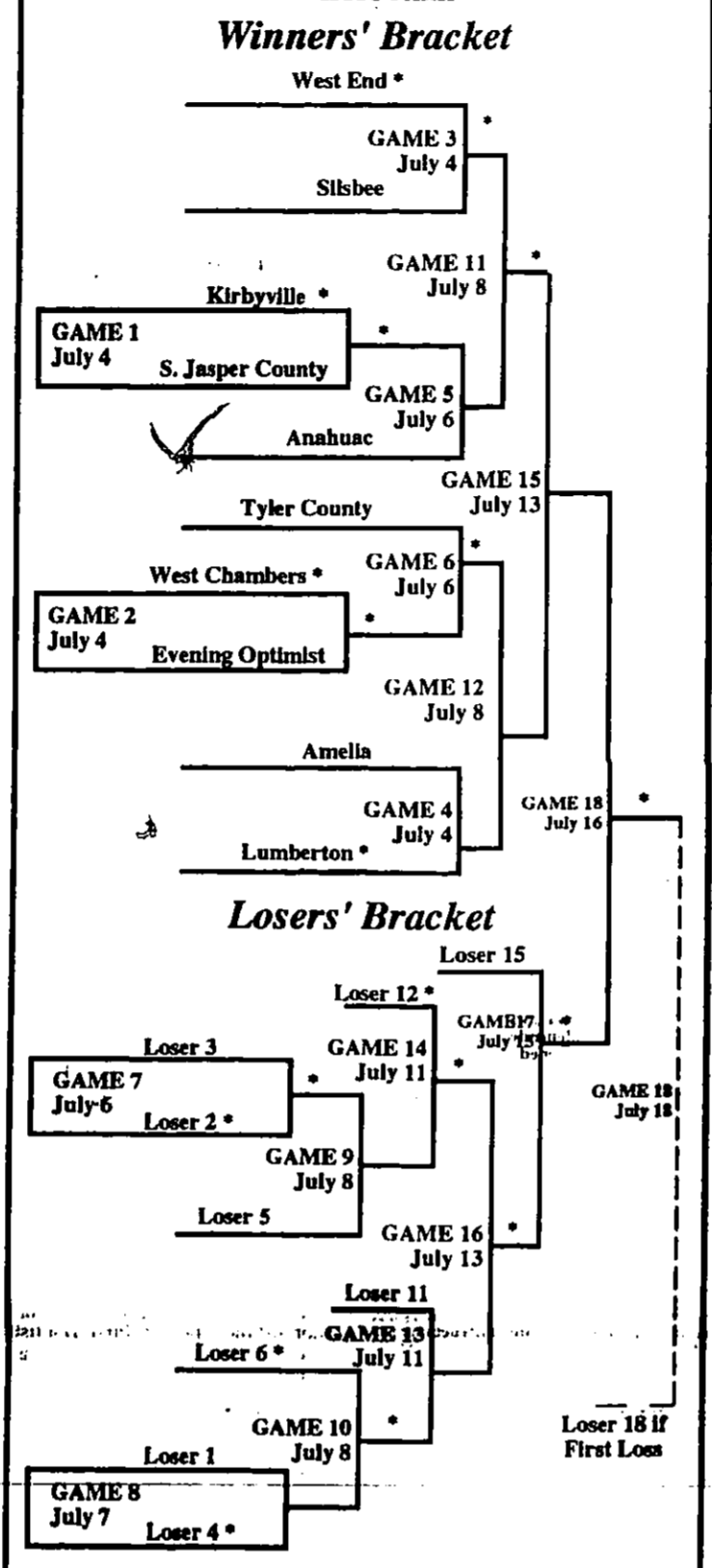

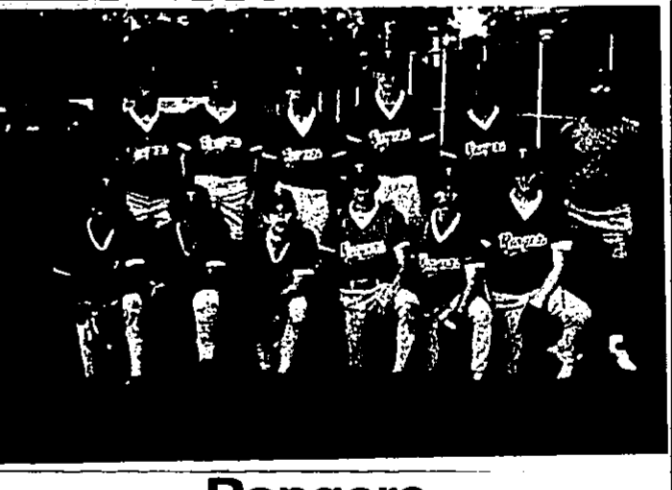

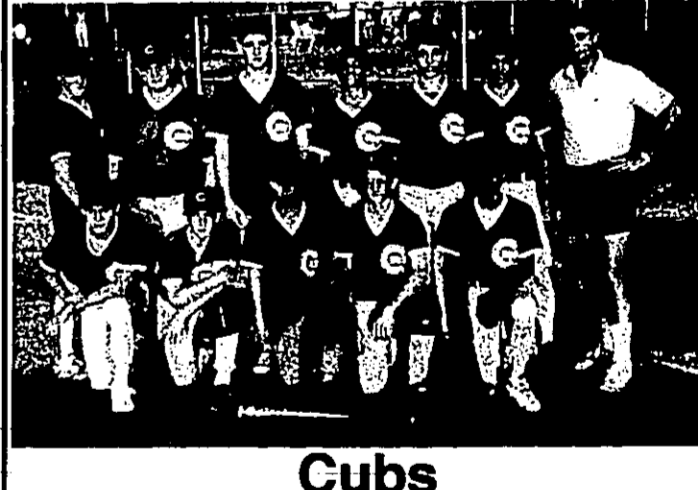

Spurger students, leaders attend Acteens convention

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — Six girls and two leaders from the First Baptist Church in Spurger attended the four-day National Acteens Convention which ended June 24 at the Birmingham-Jefferson Civic Center.
 Leaders from the church included Eva Jones and Vickie Nugent while the girls attending included Christina Blount, Erin Drennon, Emily Loving, Amber Walker, Jessica Sheffield and Holly Nugent.
 Sponsored by the Southern Baptist Women's Missionary Union, the convention is held every five years for girls in grades seven through 12.
 The primary, missionary testimonies and commissioning service, a birth-day celebration, conferences on such topics as gangs, race relations, homosexuality and sexual abstinence, and an array of missions ministry opportunities competed for the attention of 13,500 Southern Baptist teen girls and their leaders during the event.
 The teenagers opened the convention in downtown Birmingham by learning a new song, "Heart of the Younger," sung by Michele Wagner of Cleveland, Ohio, a contemporary Christian singer. The song served as the theme of the convention.
 A procession of flags of 126 countries where Southern Baptist missionaries have worked led to a challenge for the girls to commit themselves to take the Christian message to others.
 Testimonies of missionaries ranged from the difficulties of sharing the Christian faith with Navajo Indians in New Mexico to reaching out to apartment complexes and mobile home parks in Jackson, Miss., through Vacation Bible Schools, tutoring and cooking classes.
 In a series of specialized conferences the teenagers were introduced to a new Southern Baptist program called "True Love Waits" which encourages persons to commit to sexual abstinence until marriage.
 Specialists in race relations cautioned the teenagers about using slang terms in referring to people of other races "because it really hurts."
 At a conference on homosexuality, Lane Powell, professor of human relations at Samford University, Birmingham, reminded the girls that while homosexuality is a sin in the Bible that Christians should show compassion just as Jesus did in dealing with outcasts.
 To show their concern for others, the girls brought 5,000 teddy bears and 7,000 pairs of canvas shoes for their missionaries to distribute to the needy where they work.
 Between specialized conferences and general sessions, the teenagers flocked to a large exhibit hall designed as a city where they personally interviewed missionaries while making video tapes and audio cassettes for use later in their churches.
