County okays 1995 budget

-No tax increase included in \$4.6 million plan-

WOODVILLE—A \$4.6 million 1995 budget that includes no tax increase was approved Monday by the Tyler County Commissioners.

The county's new spending plan, which goes into effect on Jan. 1, does include an across-the-board 3 percent pay increase for all county employees, the first granted in several years.

"I'm only making a few changes in the budget from the current year," County Judge Jerome Owens said. "We did away with our part-time help and the employees will receive a 3 percent pay increase."

"We have worked hard on this budget," he added. "Obviously, it's hard to squeeze things down to do it without a tax increase, but I feel it is a real good budget for the most part. It gives almost everyone what they need and it does it without an increase in taxes."

The tax rate adopted Monday was an overall 56 cents per \$100 valuation. Of this total, 31 cents is allocated to the general fund, 20 cents for the road and bridge fund and 5 cents to pay off the jail bonds.

The 31 cent general fund rate is expected to generate \$1,319,598 during the coming year, up by only \$7,661 from the \$1,311,937 projected under the 1994 spending plan. The 20 cents road and bridge rate is projected to generate \$836,349 in 1995, or \$3,711 more than the \$832,638 budgeted for 1994.

The 5 cents rate allocated to the jail interest and sinking fund is expected to provide the county with \$27,948 in 1995, which reflects a \$5,090 increase from the \$22,858 listed in the 1994 budget.

Although not part of the county's budget, the general fund - the largest fund in the budget - will increase by less than \$100,000 in 1995, going from the 1994 budgeted level of \$2,577,858 up to \$2,691,126.

Revenue for the general fund - which covers all county departments with the exception of the road and bridge and other special activities - is projected to be \$2,693,673 in 1995, up by almost \$100,000 from the \$2,598,157 listed in the 1994 budget.

In addition to the property tax income, other major revenue sources for the general fund include a projected \$250,000 from the 5 cent sales tax - up by \$45,000 from the 1994 budget; \$200,000 for housing prisoners from other counties - up by \$25,000 from the 1994 budget; \$90,000 in county clerk fees - unchanged from 1994; and \$51,000 in sheriff's department fees - unchanged from 1994.

In the county's road and bridge fund, overall allocations to the four precincts total \$1,377,224 in 1995, up by only \$22,000 from the 1994 budget.

Soileau replaces Haley on ballot

LUFKIN—Former State Rep. Curtis Soileau of Lumberton was selected Saturday as the Democratic candidate for the District 3 state senate seat vacated last week when incumbent Senator Bill Haley relinquished his governor position.

Soileau was given the nod to replace Haley on the general election ballot by a vote of the 17 county Democratic Party chairman during a meeting held Saturday in Lufkin. The new senate candidate, who will face Republican Drew Dixon in November, received an ovation from a large crowd of spectators gathered for the meeting when the decision was announced.

"I'm deeply honored to have the opportunity to represent the Democratic Party in East Texas," Soileau said. "We're going to run the type of campaign that deals with the issues, not the candidates."

Following his selection, Soileau said he believes the senate seat is very important to the people of the region and vowed to work to provide the service East Texans need.

"We want to make sure we're available to the people to review their comments on what things should be changed and what things are working now," he said. "The only way to effectively represent your district is to find out what the people want."

A Lumberton attorney, the candidate received a bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Lamar University and attended South Texas College of Law in Houston.

Soileau served two terms as a state representative from 1983-92. He was first elected to the Lumberton City Council at the age of 19 and in 1982 was elected as the city's mayor at the age of 21.

During the special meeting of the Senate District 3 party chairman, the first ballot gave Soileau seven votes with State Rep. Elton Bomer of Montalba receiving six and State Rep. Jerry Johnson of Nacogdoches garnering four. Two other candidates for the job, State Rep. Billy Clemons of Pollock and San Augustine Mayor Curt Goetz did not receive any votes.

In the second round, the bottom three candidates, Johnson, Clemons and Goetz, were dropped from consideration and another show of hands gave Soileau the seat.

Chester vote set on ELC

-Village Mills expanded local calling vote delayed-

TYLER COUNTY—While residents in the Chester telephone exchange will be joining much of the rest of Tyler County telephone customers in voting on Expanded Toll-Free Local Calling (ELC), residents in the Village Mills exchange have been put on hold regarding the issue.

Eastern Telephone Cooperative, Inc., which serves the Chester area, is set to mail out ballots to their customers on Sept. 5.

The Chester telephone customers recently filed a petition for ELC service with both Woodville and Corrigan.

If approved, customers in the Chester exchange would be able to call and be called by customers in Woodville and Corrigan without long distance charges.

Under the ELC regulations, 70 percent of the Chester telephone customers who return their ballots must vote "yes" in order for expanded toll-free service to be granted. If 70 percent or more of those voting approve the ELC service, the monthly ELC fees will be added to all customer bills in the exchange.

One complication which will affect the ELC service between Chester and Woodville is that the two cities are located in different Local Access Transport Areas (LATAs). Because of this, if voters approve ELC between the two cities, a petition would have to be filed in U.S. District Court to win federal approval to establish the ELC service.

Because of this, even is Chester voters okay ELC service between both Corrigan and Woodville, local calling to and from Woodville could occur at a much later date than between Chester and Corrigan.

The Chester ELC balloting is the third to be scheduled for Tyler County.
