

Nail health important, dermatologists say

HOUSTON — A dermatologist suggests "filing away" a few simple tips for nail health. Cleanliness is the biggest concern when picking a nail salon, said Dr. Ida Orengo, assistant professor of dermatology at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston.

"Acrylic and gel nails allow the nail to breathe and take in nutrients, so they can be worn longer." Some people may have an immediate, allergic reaction to the acrylic. If this happens, stop using it. A covering that is beginning to lift also creates a place for moisture to get trapped, Orengo said. "Either situation will not have this problem if they let the polish dry 15 minutes."

However, if the student has a pre-existing problem, it is important for the student to be evaluated by a physician before starting a new sport or physical education class.

It is also a goal of the Advertising Review Committee to educate lawyers and their advertising agencies about the new rules and to ensure compliance with them. Current plans include holding a joint seminar with the Texas Association of Broadcasters and publishing and distributing a booklet on the rules.

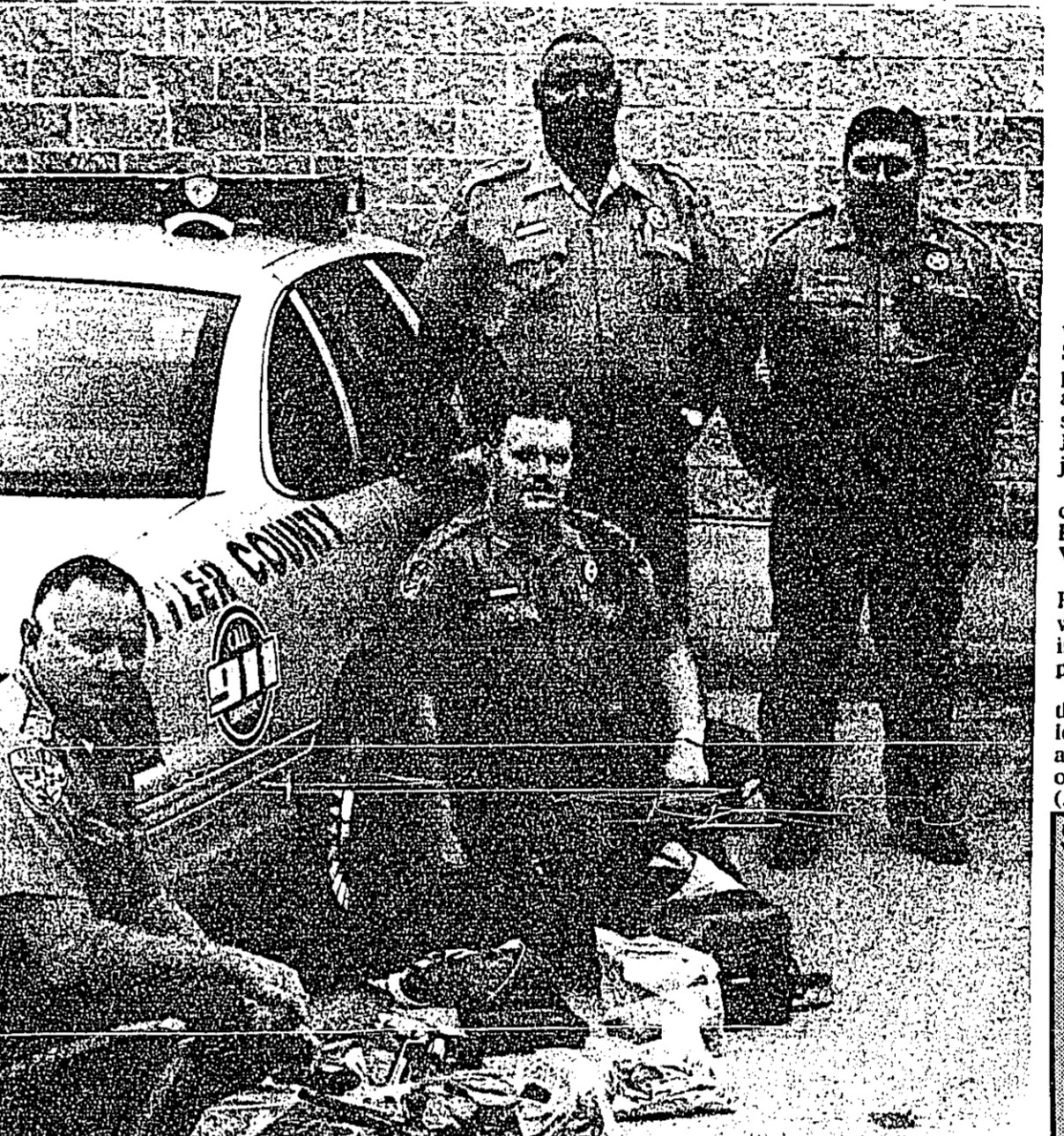

Practical parenting seminar underway

A one time \$10 registration fee will be charged per person at the door for the entire six session series.

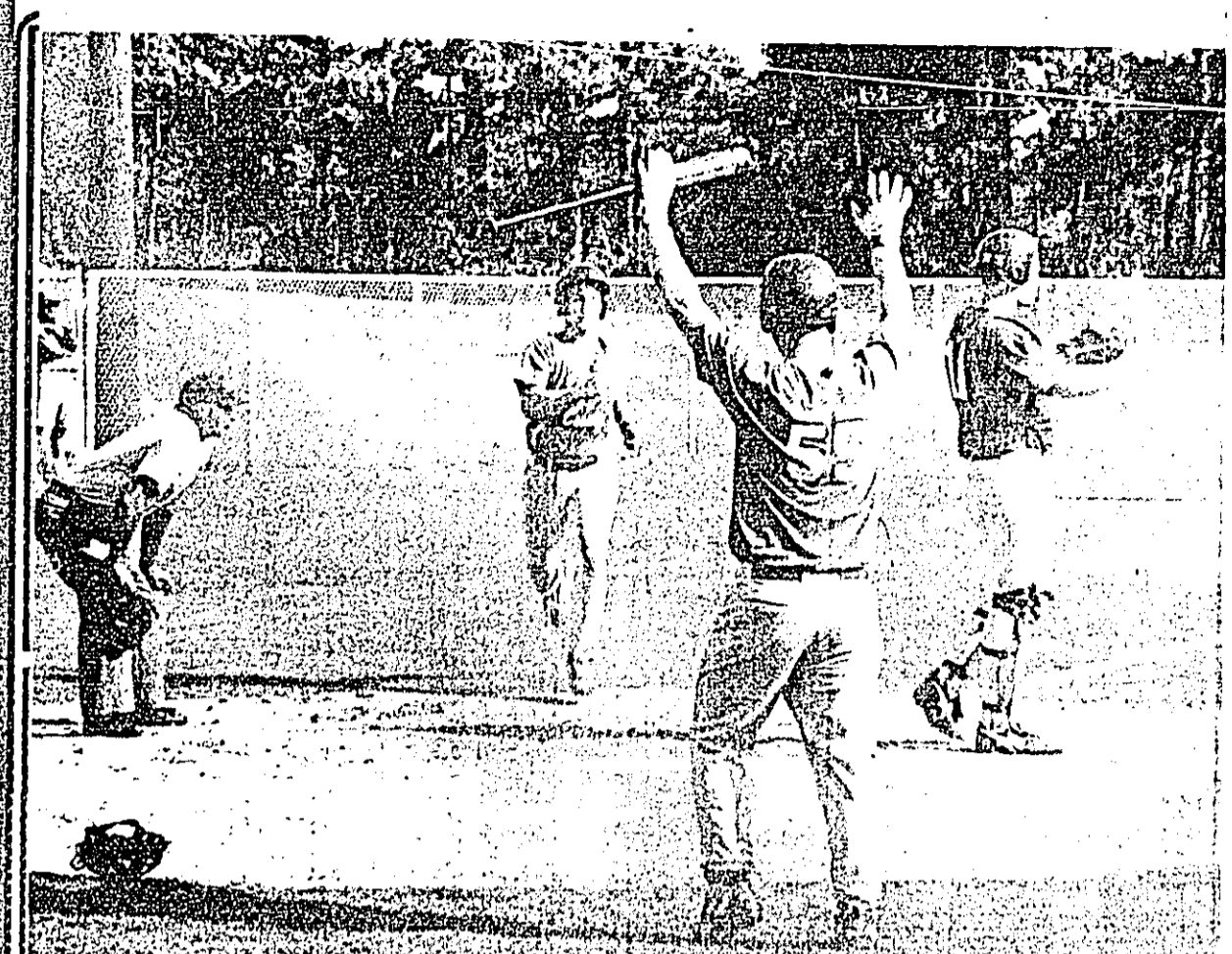
Practical Parenting is being sponsored by the Family & Consumer Sciences division of the Texas Agricultural Extension Service of Tyler County.
