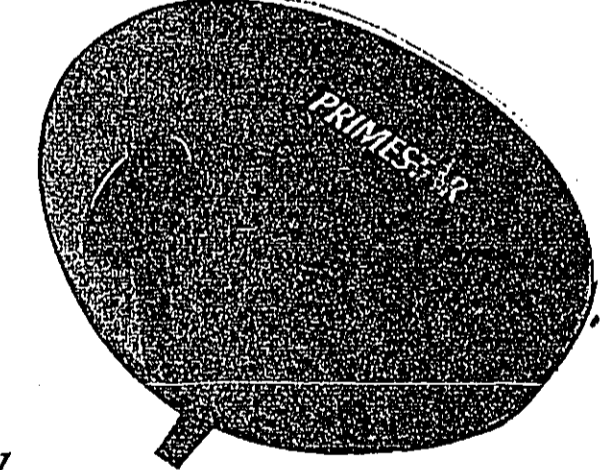

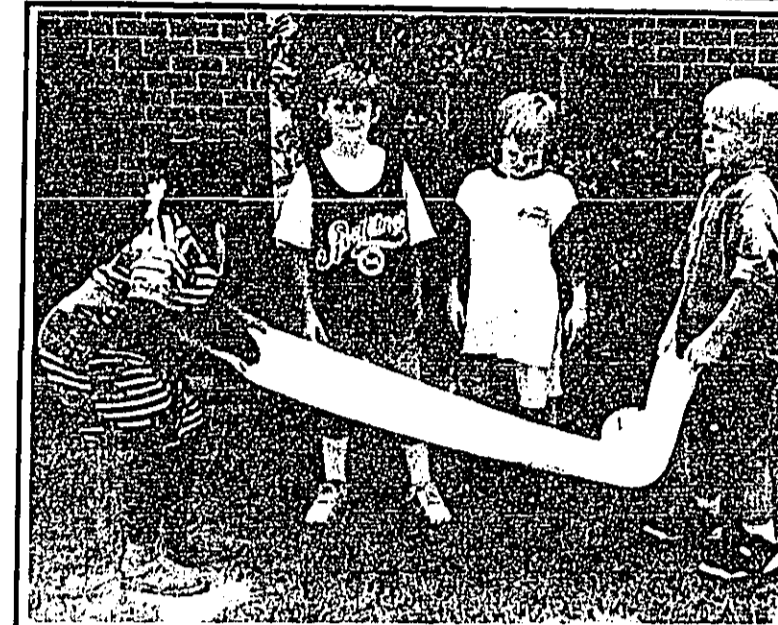

WOODVILLE — In the 1995 Texas Education Agency Accountability Summary, Woodville Independent School District was acknowledged "Recognized" for the academic performance of Woodville High School students, according to Carol Moffett, superintendent of WISD.

The acknowledgment is related to students' high performance on SAT/ACT tests. According to TEA standards, 30 percent of high school students should take the ACT/SAT and 10 percent are expected to score above the state criterion. In WISD, 68 percent of WHS students take the SAT/ACT and 15 percent of these students score above the state criterion.

Credits for Social Security work

LUFKIN — Some people are confused about work requirements for Social Security benefits. Some associate work credits with the amount of the benefit they will receive. This is not true. Work credit determines only eligibility for a benefit.

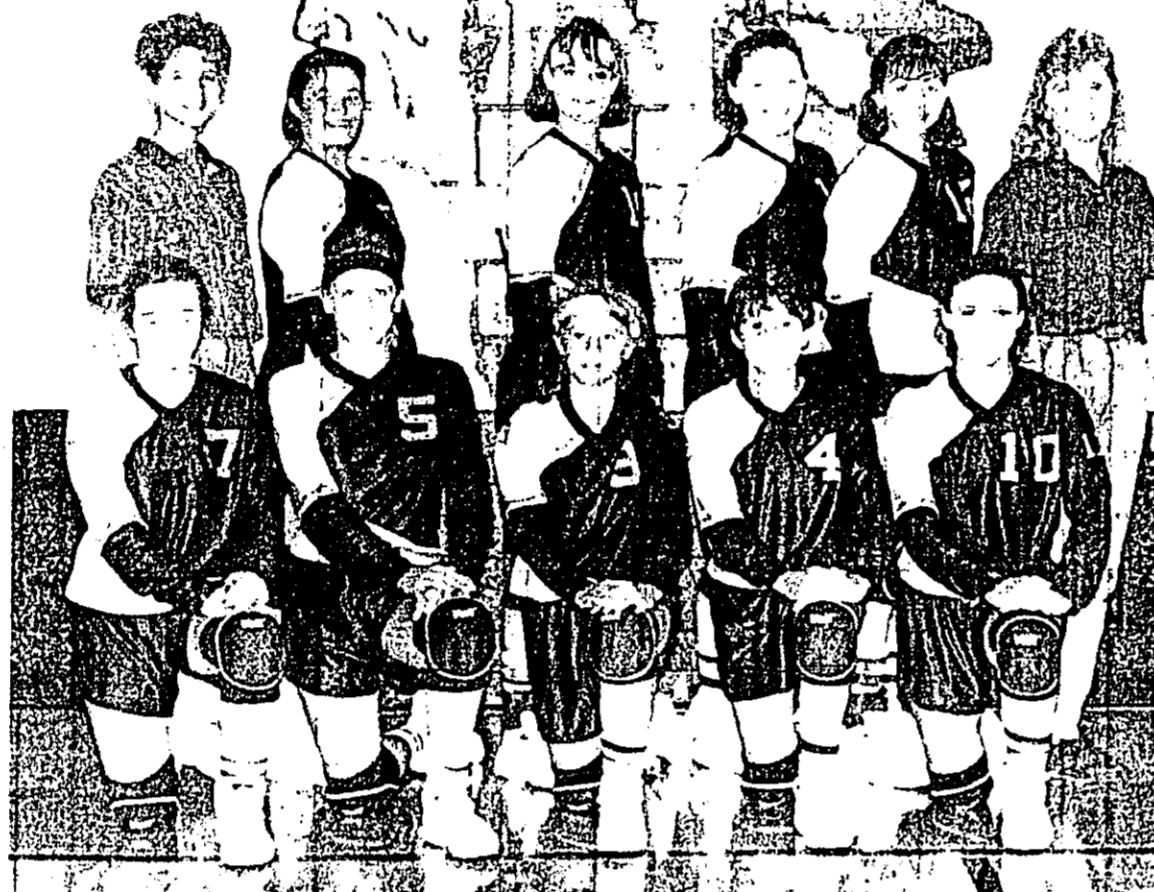

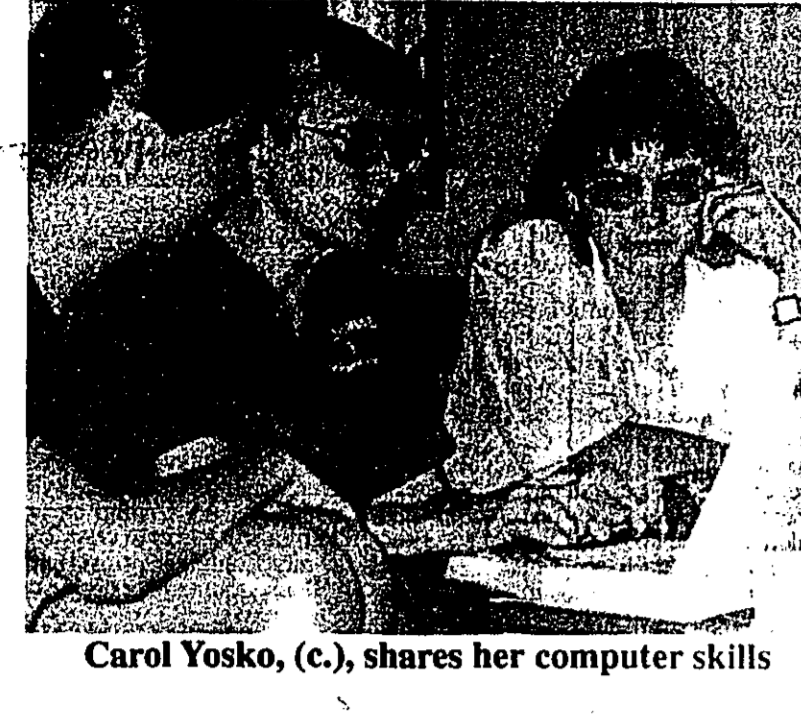

Yoskos educate Polish teens on good sentence structure

WOODVILLE — When Caryl and Ray Yosko were teenagers, Poland was a country shrouded in mystery and closed to the rest of the world. They never dreamed they would have the chance to travel to this land-locked country, much less meet any Polish teenagers. But in July, the Woodville couple not only had the chance to visit Poland, they finally met those teenagers face-to-face in the classroom.

The Yoskos recently joined a team of 15 North American volunteers who taught English to youth in southern Poland. The Yoskos' team spent three weeks with teenage Polish students in Zakopane in the Tatra mountains, about two hours from Krakow. Caryl said the experience afforded her the privilege to live with and work with people from an emerging democracy. "By relating to the high school students, their ideas and dreams for the future gave me the insight to know that with students such as the ones I taught, the country of Poland has a very strong future," she said.

At the English language camp, the Yoskos taught basic English and conversational skills to students who boarded with the American team at the mountain retreat center. "In the past 20 years Caryl and I have served as volunteers in Africa and Haiti," Ray said. "Coming to Poland has shown us how much people here for the same things everywhere - they want to improve their English and conversational skills to live their lives, and we are happy to provide some of that help."

The service program was sponsored by Global Volunteers, a private, not-for-profit, non-sectarian organization. Founded in 1984, Global Volunteers works under the direction of local community leaders at the invitation of a local host organization. Global Volunteers sends teams of 12 to 20 volunteers to this village and sites in 11 other countries several times yearly.

The English-teaching partnership in Poland began in 1990 with the invitation to Global Volunteers by Rural Solidarity to assist efforts toward democratization of the country. Volunteers teach English as a foreign lan-

guage to children and adults in classrooms and small-groups, concentrating on improving conversational ability and pronunciation. The students learn techniques from the volunteers, most of whom are native English speakers.

Global Volunteers President Bud Philbrook feels that anyone who has the desire to assist the Polish people can be useful in the English-teaching program. "It just takes flexibility and a bit of creativity to improve students' understanding of an interest in English," said Philbrook.

Many young Poles have never met an American, and have had to learn English from Polish teachers. "It doesn't take special skills to do what we do," Philbrook continued. "You simply have to want to give of yourself and open up to the possibility of helping out," he concluded.

Volunteers are provided a pre-trip orientation packet that helps guide the teaching process. Many volunteers work in pairs to "team teach" English to groups, making the process easier for each individual.

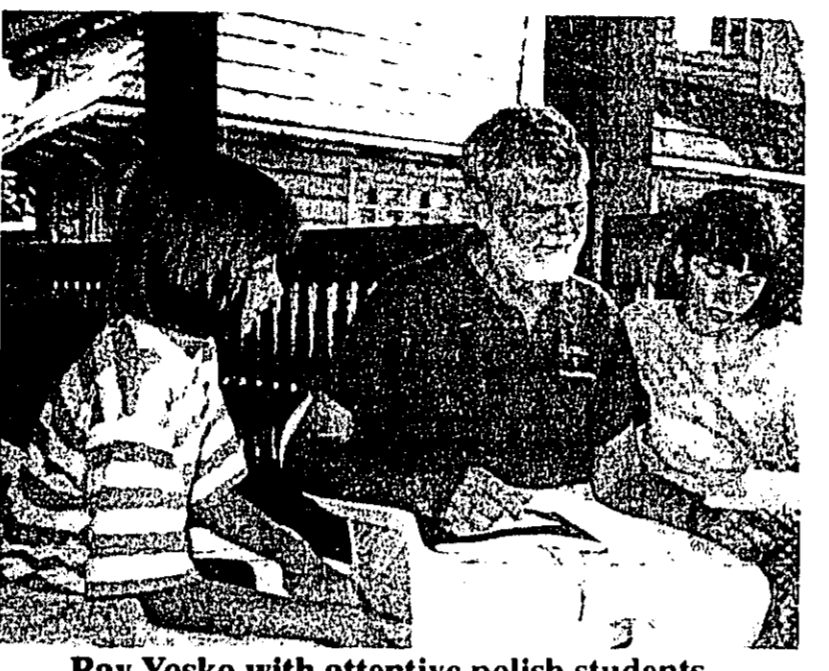
Global Volunteers also sends volunteer-English teaching teams to Russia. In addition, "Free Enterprise Initiatives" are conducted by the organization in Russia, Poland and other republics in the former Soviet Union.

Each service program is led by a trained Global Volunteers team leader. The teams also receive instructions on necessary health precautions, information on local culture and language, and tips on responsible travel.

Most volunteers view this opportunity as an alternative to a standard vacation, Philbrook said. As such, the volunteers pay their own costs for transportation and lodging at the site, project and program expenses.

Three-week trips are scheduled throughout the year to Indonesia, Tanzania, Vietnam, Poland and Russia. Two-week trips are scheduled to Jamaica, Costa Rica, Mexico, Spain, Italy and Greece, with one-week programs offered in the south U.S.

Tobacco should not be banned

The debate over what to do, or not to do, about tobacco has gone on long enough.

There's a question in my mind that tobacco is a drug, an addictive drug. There's no question tobacco is harmful. Denial, the tobacco question should not be a political issue. But it is. It's also a money-talks-wisdom-walks issue. Money vs. health. Money vs. facts. Money vs. common sense.

It's time to treat tobacco as a health issue. It's also time to do something about it and move on.

As harmful as I believe tobacco to be, I don't think it should be banned. Tobacco prohibition would not work any better today than liquor prohibition did in the '20s. We don't need the police - metro, state, federal or lifestyle - Sherifflocking folk's bathubs. But tobacco does need to be stringently regulated, just as any drug product is regulated.

Regulation may conjure up invasion of privacy, limits on freedom and restriction of rights. But government has a responsibility to protect its citizens, especially those without the knowledge, wisdom or inclination to protect themselves. That would be children. That would be adolescents.

Some 90 percent of all smokers begin smoking before age 21, and 60 percent start before age 14. Let's keep people from becoming hooked as kids. Let's practice prevention. Prevention's not a new concept, but it's one too often ignored in addressing our nation's health and in trying to curtail the skyrocketing cost of health care.

Tobacco may be good business for the tobacco industry, but it's bad business for everyone else. In Texas alone, the cost of health care, lost income and lost productivity caused by tobacco use exceeds \$4 billion a year. Because of tobacco's effect on human health, we all pay higher health insurance rates, life insurance rates, physician fees, hospital charges and city, state and federal taxes.

We have an opportunity to actually do something about a national health problem. We need to act. We need to act because of the cost and, more importantly, because of the kids.

We should make it illegal, nationwide, for anyone under 21 to possess a tobacco product, illegal to sell tobacco to anyone under 21 and illegal to advertise or otherwise promote tobacco to kids. We should make it illegal for cigarette vending machines to be accessible to kids. And we should back these legislations with stiff, meaningful penalties.

Let's treat tobacco as a health issue, do something about it and move on.

What is needed when applying for SSI

LUFKIN — East Texans who apply for supplemental security income (SSI) payments can speed up their application by knowing what to have available when contacting Social Security. SSI is a federally administered program for those age 65, disabled, or blind, and who have limited income and resources.

Credits for Social Security work

Some people are confused about work requirements for Social Security benefits. Some associate work credits with the amount of the benefit they will receive. This is not true. Work credit determines only eligibility for a benefit. Before any Social Security benefits can be paid, a worker must have enough credit for work covered by Social Security to be eligible - or insured, as it is called.

The job itself determines if a worker is covered under the Social Security system. This is set by law and presently at least nine out of every 10 jobs are covered. The tax rate itself is also set by congress. However, the base - the amount of earnings that tax is paid on is determined by the national increase in the average wage.

Before any Social Security benefits can be paid, a worker must have enough credit covered by Social Security to be insured. Social Security credits are measured in units called quarters of coverage (QC's). Both wage earners and self-employed people earn these credits based on their calendar-year earnings.

A wage earner's earnings are generally covered from the first dollar earned during the year up to the maximum that counts for Social Security. In 1995, this base amount is \$61,200 for the Social Security trust funds - or 62.6% of the total tax rate. Beginning in 1995, the base amount for the Medicare portion of the tax, 1.45% will be paid on all earnings - with no upper limit. The total tax rate for Social Security and Medicare remained at 7.65%.

In 1995, a worker earns one quarter of coverage (QC) for each \$630 of earnings. If on a job under Social Security, if total earnings are at least \$2,520 for the year, four quarters will be earned. This is the maximum quarters that can be earned in one year. The amount of earnings needed for a quarter will increase if average wage levels rise.

There are several factors that determine the number of QC's needed to be insured for benefits. For retirement, a worker will never need over 40 QC's. Every worker born in 1929 or later will need 40. Those born before 1929 will need less QC's - 1 per year less as their year of birth moves away from 1929. For example, a worker born in 1922 needs 33 quarters to be insured.

There are different rules for disability benefits. A worker must have earned a certain number of QC's, depending on age at the point of disability, and some of these QC's must have been earned during a specific time preceding the disability onset. Workers who become disabled under age 31 require less QC's than those over this age, and a worker under age 24 could need as few as six QC's.

Generally, the number of QC's needed on a deceased worker's record for survivors to receive benefits, depends on the worker's age at death. If the worker was under retirement age, less QC's are needed. For very young workers, as little as six QC's may be needed for insured status. About every three years a worker should check his/her Social Security records to make sure the record is properly posted. To do this, take advantage of SSA's toll free number 1-800-772-1213 - and ask for Form SSA-7004.

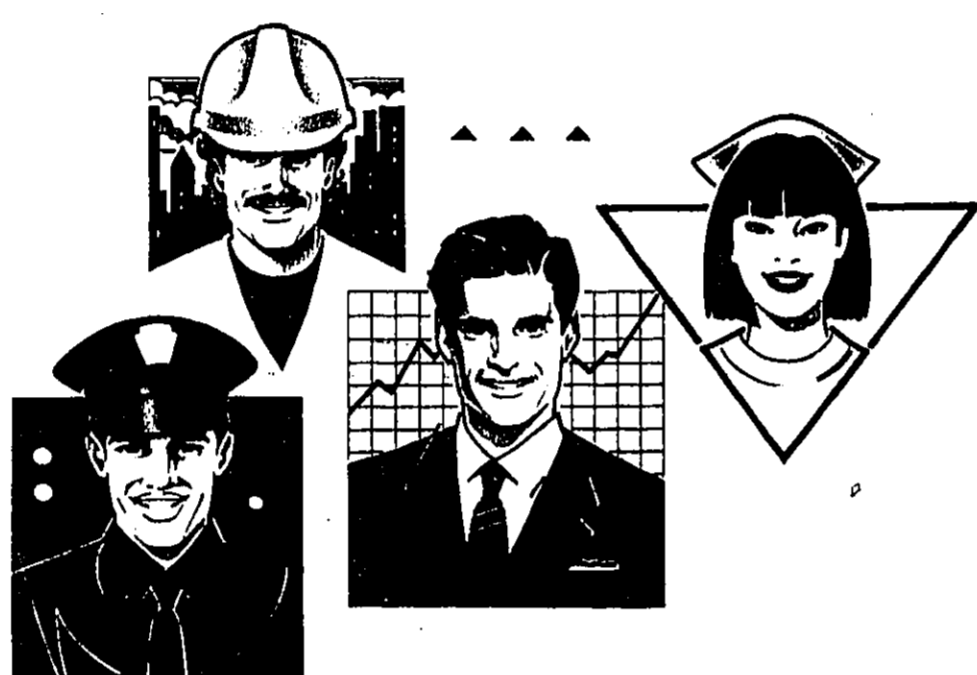
Most Social Security business, including filing for SSI, can be done by telephone. Applications and other necessary forms are completed by phone and mailed for signatures. Proofs needed to determine eligibility may be submitted by mail, also.

Since SSI is such a complex program, citizens are urged to contact Social Security rather than try themselves to determine eligibility for benefits. For more information, take advantage of Social Security's toll free number 1-800-772-1213.

* his or her Social Security card or a record of the Social Security number; * proof of age, a birth certificate or the oldest other proof of age available; * information about any income and resources, such as payroll slips, copies of tax returns, bank books, insurance policies, car registration, and burial fund records. Parents or guardians applying for benefits for a child will also need to furnish information about their income and resources; * information about the place he or she lives, including the amount of the mortgage and property taxes on a home he or she owns, the lease and landlord's name if renting, and the cost of food and utilities; and * if disabled or blind, the names and addresses of doctors, hospitals, and clinics that have treated the applicant so that medical records may be obtained.

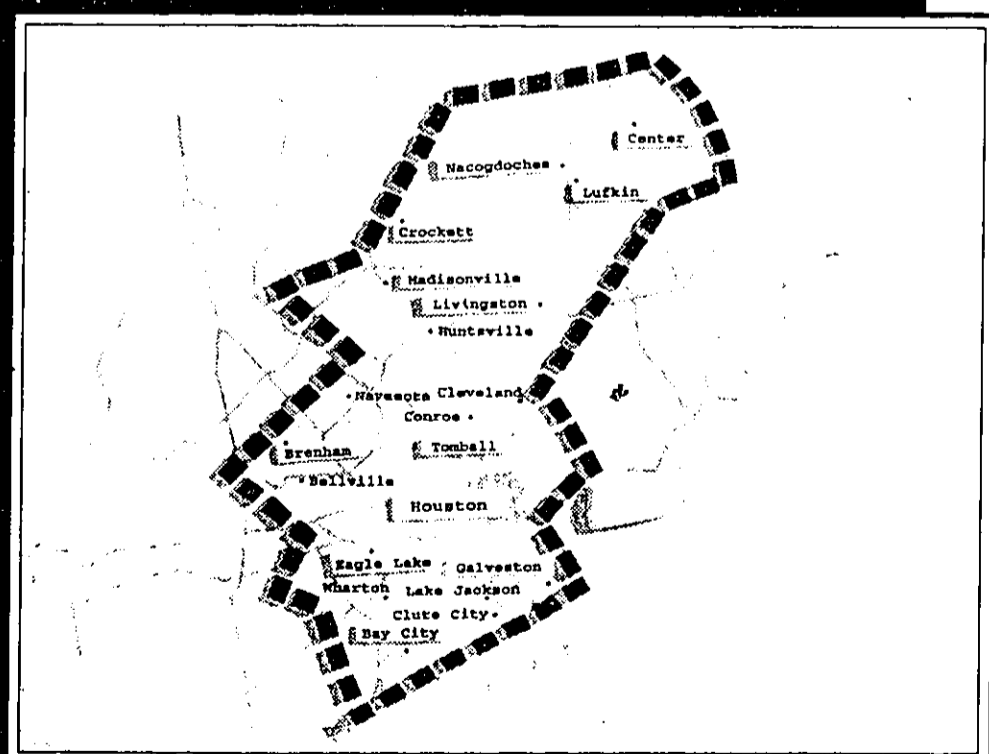
