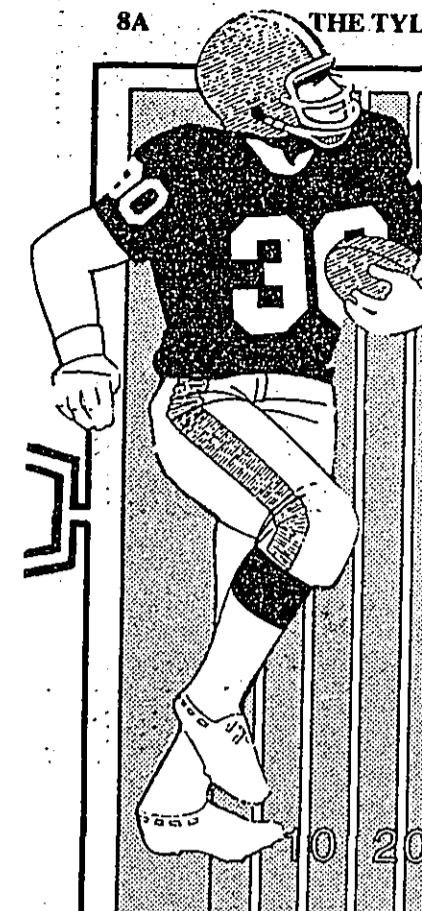

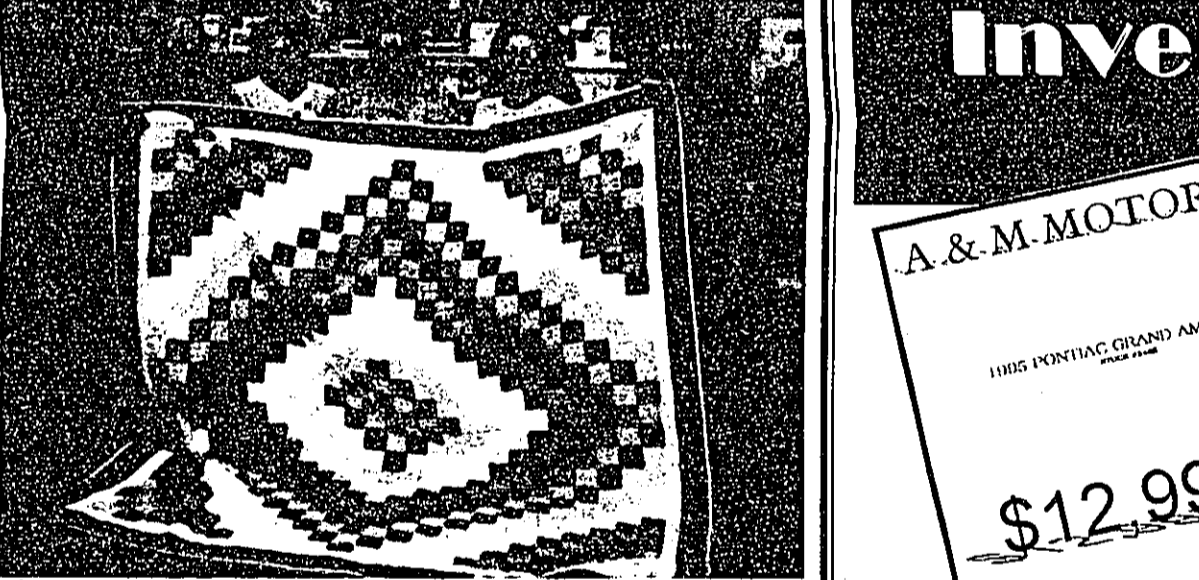
Scott is honored student

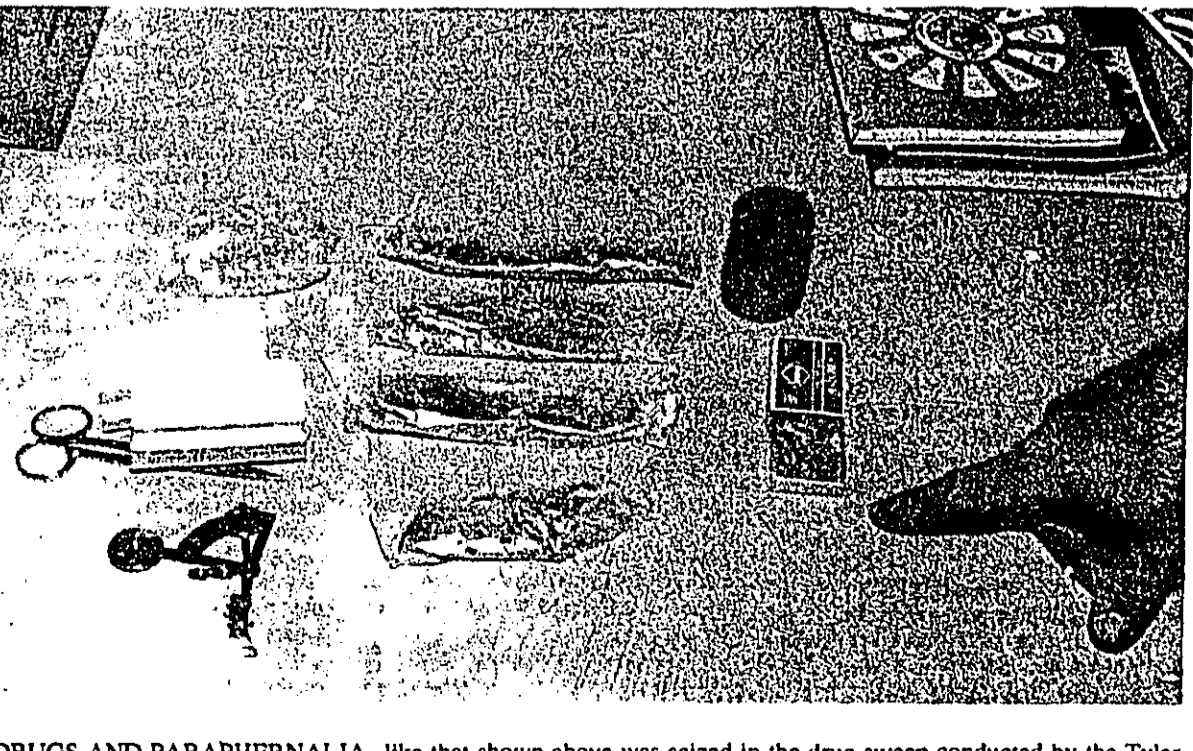
Both parents were admitted with minor burns and smoke inhalation to Tyler County Hospital and subsequently released.

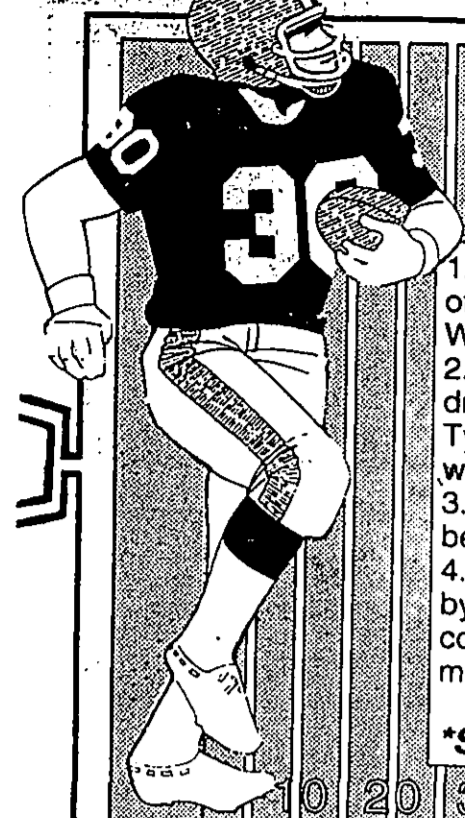

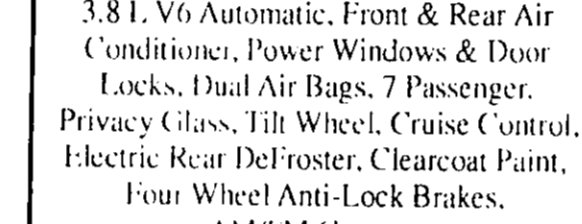

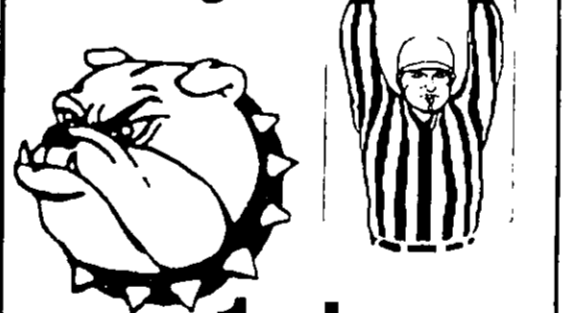
