**Change in filing Part B Medicare claims**

Since 1990 Medicare Medical Insurance (Part B) claims must be prepared and submitted by the doctor or other service provider. This is true even if the provider does not accept assignment.

Some important things to know about the filing Part B claims are:

- An extra charge cannot be made by provider for preparing and submitting claims.
- The Law applies to all physicians and suppliers who provide covered services to Medicare beneficiaries.
- Time limits for filing claims did not change - i.e. claims must be filed within one year from the date of service.
- If assignment is not accepted, doctors and providers may request payment in full at the time of service.
- Exceptions to the claims filing requirements: When Medicare is a secondary payer; used durable medical equipment purchased from a third party; services billed directly to a third party insurer and unusual unique situations as evaluated by the Medicare carrier.

Medicare carriers are responsible for monitoring these laws to ensure compliance. Physicians and suppliers who willfully and repeatedly do not submit Part B claims for Medicare beneficiaries may be subject to civil monetary penalties of up to \$2000 for each violation.

Most questions concerning the new law should be directed to the Medicare carrier. The address and phone number is listed in the Medicare Handbook. Social Security offices will continue, as in the past, to enroll people in Medicare, assist in filing appeals and helping with routine Medicare problems.

**Woodville City Council to rename Hike and Bike Trail**

Are you good with names? Can you think up a new, more appropriate name for the project currently known as the Dogwood Hike and Bike Trail? If so, the Council wants to hear from you.

Councilman Larry Phillips raised the issue at Monday's meeting of the council. He said, "Public awareness is not being served (by the current name). The trail is the least costly part of the project. There will be one to two acre parks at both ends with picnic areas, restrooms and other facilities."

City Attorney Harry Stafford agreed, adding that the \$435,000 project needs "a name which would more truly reflect the nature of the park."

The council will select a new name for the project at its next regular meeting scheduled for 7 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 8. Send your suggestions to: City of Woodville, 113 North Charlton, Woodville, TX 75797.

In other business, Council passed a motion authorizing city employees to add five families, along Henslow Road, to the city's water system provided the families pay all costs associated with the installation.

The families involved live outside of the city and are about to lose access to the well they have been using. The council indicated its willingness to help the families as long as it doesn't cost the city any money.

Each family's share of the cost to get connected to the city's water system will be about \$600. The group indicated that they could find the required funds.

The council also granted a hardship mobile home waiver to Paul Marshall. Marshall entered into a contract to purchase a lot along Cobb Mill Road on Sep. 1. The lot in question did have mobile homes on it in the past. Marshall purchased the lot planning to move his mobile home from a rental space three blocks away to one of three existing hookups on the lot.

Mayor Billy Rose made it clear that the waiver was for one mobile home and that all distance requirements of the ordinance must be followed.

In other action, the council passed a resolution indicating that property required for utility construction will be acquired by condemnation if easements can not be obtained. The resolution was necessary for the advancement of current sewer projects and gives the council additional easement condemnation authority when needed.

The council also approved minutes of prior meetings.

The next regular meeting of the City Council is scheduled for 7 p.m. on Monday Jan. 8 at City Hall. The public is invited to attend.

**Commissioners review airport policy**

Users of hangars at the Tyler County Airport will soon have a new policy to follow. The Airport Advisory Committee brought a draft of proposed new policies for hangar use at the airport before Commissioners Court, Monday.

The policy sets new hangar rental rates and defines permissible uses of the hangars. It also requires users to maintain their hangars and provide liability insurance.

Commissioners requested that the Airport Advisory Committee make various changes in the wording of the policy.

The policy will come up for public comment and a vote at a special meeting at 8:30 a.m. this Friday, Dec. 15. Notice of the new policy is being sent to hangar users. "Renters should be given an opportunity to comment prior to approval of the policy," said County Judge Jerome Owens.

In other business, commissioners approved giving easements to the city of Woodville, across the front of the Tyler County Appraisal District office and a parcel at the corner of Hwy. 190 and Beach streets. The easements are needed to allow the city to run new sewer lines along that section of Hwy. 190.

The demonstration of equipment to be used in the new 3-1 system was delayed till the January meeting of the court. The court received a fax report indicating that about one fourth of the county has been "digitized." Field work associated with the system is considerably ahead of the digitizing process.

The court also:

- approved bond for Judy Whitehead in the county treasurer's office;
- approved bond for Elzie Norton in rural fire prevention Precinct 4;
- approved deputization of Leslie Harlan for the sheriff's office;
- approved county payroll and holiday schedules;
- approved minutes of prior meetings of the court;
- approved the county treasurer's monthly report;
- approved the county probations monthly report;
- approved the county extension monthly report;
- approved the county auditor's monthly report;
- approved allowances and accounts payable from the county auditors office.

The next regular meeting of the Commissioners Court is scheduled for Jan. 8 at 10 a.m. in the Commissioners Courtroom. The public is invited to attend.

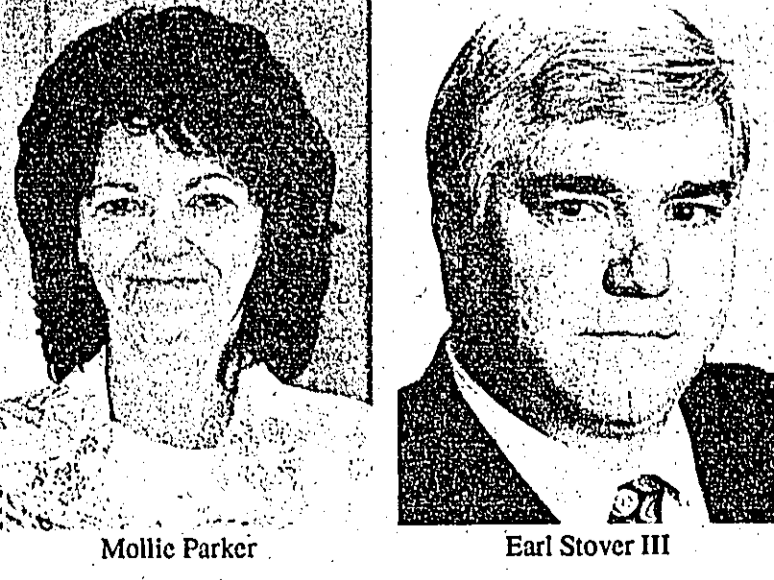

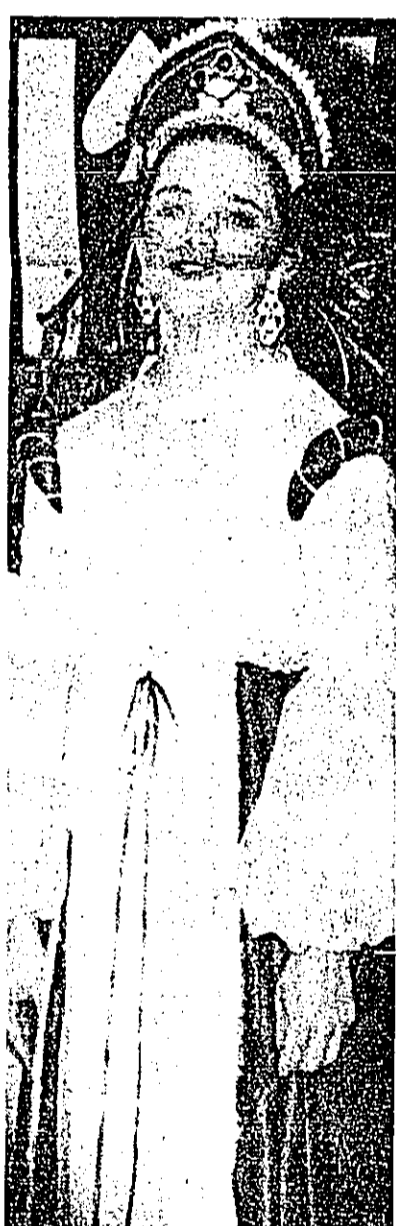
"We want the students to give back to the community some of what the community has given to them," said Stuart.

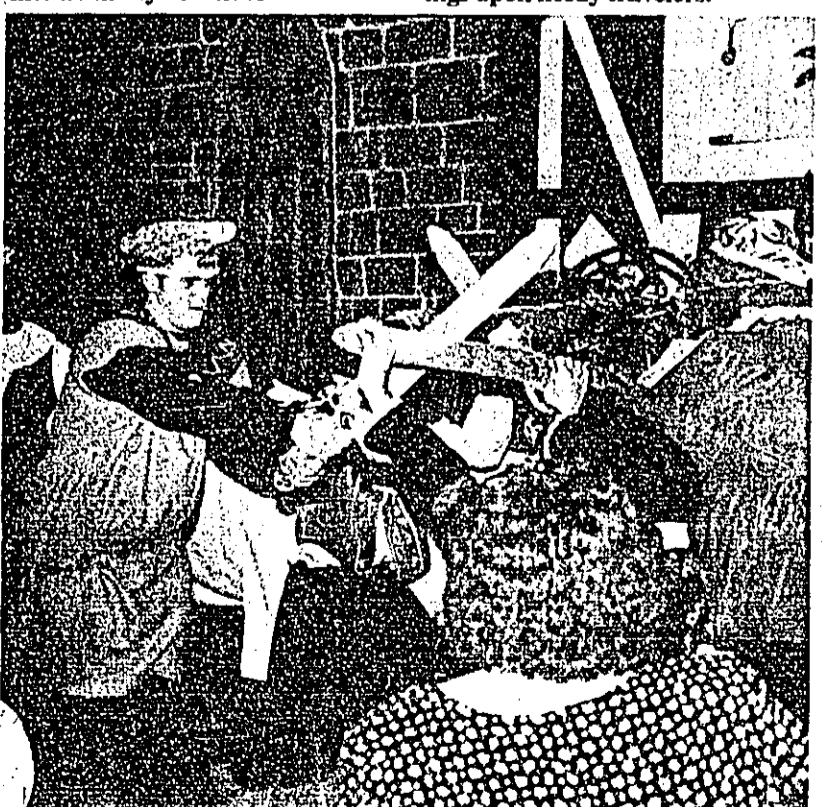

## Career women often forget care of self

HOUSTON (Nov. 22, 1995)—Women who take care of their family and career often forget to take care of themselves.

A new brochure from Baylor College of Medicine in Houston recommends ways women can reduce their risk of disease by incorporating a healthy lifestyle into their hectic lives.

The brochure, "Women's Health: Ideas for a Lifetime of Wellness," produced by Baylor's Office of Health Promotion addresses ways women can reduce their risk of disease including breast cancer, heart disease and osteoporosis.

For example, a regular breast self-examination should be a part of a woman's monthly routine. Suspicious lumps should be examined by a physician.

"Also, few people know that heart disease is the leading cause of death in older women," said Dr. Raye C. Hurwitz, an assistant professor of medicine at Baylor.

Besides age, Hurwitz says other major risk factors in women include high blood pressure, obesity, high cholesterol, smoking, and a family history of heart disease.

A woman's emotional health is also important to her overall health, said Hurwitz.

"Menopause is one condition that not only causes physical and sexual changes in a woman, but also psychological changes," she said. "Trouble concentrating, memory impairment, and depressive symptoms can be frequent at the onset of menopause and can be relieved with treatment."

She suggests some life-style changes to increase your physical and mental well-being:

- Eat a high-fiber, low cholesterol, low sodium, low-fat diet, including fruits, vegetables, fish, and lean meat.
- Drink alcohol only moderately, if at all.
- Exercise regularly. Take brisk walks, go bowling or do aerobics.
- Don't smoke.
- Get regular check-ups that include cholesterol, blood pressure, and bone density screenings.
- Get plenty of sleep.

## Social Security cards for dependents

Since income tax filing time is just around the corner, it's very timely to talk about Social Security numbers for dependents. Tax laws require dependents, age 1 or over, if claimed on tax returns, to have a Social Security number.

Each year, there are a number of children who do not have Social Security numbers. This group includes those who have attained age 1 during the last year as well as those over 1 who have never applied. Parents whose children have no number, are urged to apply right away.

Applying for a Social Security number is a very simple matter and can usually be done by phone and mail. For an applicant who has never had a Social Security card, two documents are required. The first document can be a public birth record or hospital record of birth or a religious record showing age or date of birth. These records should have been established before age five and are used to establish age and citizenship. The second required document establishes identity and can be from a variety of documents. Examples include such items as ID cards, insurance policies, immunization records, school report cards, membership cards in an organization, driver's license, etc. Persons who have a Social Security number and are applying for a new card, need only to present proof of identity. All documents must be originals, and are returned after inspection.

**Change in filing Part B Medicare claims**

Since 1990 Medicare Medical Insurance (Part B) claims must be prepared and submitted by the doctor or other service provider. This is true even if the provider does not accept assignment.

Some important things to know about the filing Part B claims are:

- \* An extra charge cannot be made by provider for preparing and submitting claims.
- \* The Law applies to all physicians and suppliers who provide covered services to Medicare beneficiaries.
- \* Time limits for filing claims did not change - i.e. claims must be filed within one year from the date of service.
- \* If assignment is not accepted, doctors and providers may request payment in full at the time of service.

Exceptions to the claims filing requirements: When Medicare is a secondary payer, used durable medical equipment purchased from a third party; services billed directly to a third party insurer and unusual unique situations as evaluated by the Medicare carrier.

Medicare carriers are responsible for monitoring these laws to ensure compliance. Physicians and suppliers who willfully and repeatedly do not submit Part B claims for Medicare beneficiaries may be subject to civil monetary penalties of up to \$2000 for each violation.

Most questions concerning the new law should be directed to the Medicare carrier. The address and phone number is listed in the Medicare Handbook. Social Security offices will continue, as in the past, to enroll people in Medicare, assist in filing appeals and helping with routine Medicare problems.

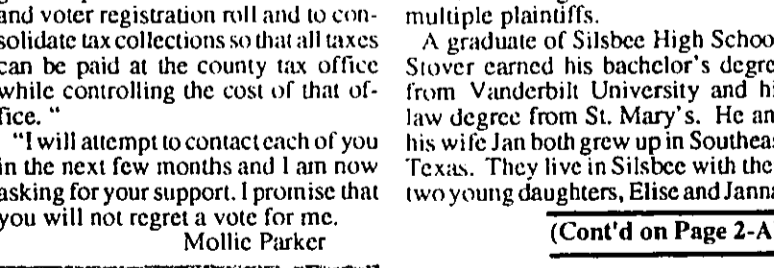

**Career women often forget care of self**

HOUSTON—(Nov. 22, 1995)—Women who take care of their family and career often forget to take care of themselves. A new brochure from Baylor College of Medicine in Houston recommends ways women can reduce their risk of disease by incorporating a healthy lifestyle into their hectic lives.

The brochure, "Women's Health: Ideas for a Lifetime of Wellness," produced by Baylor's Office of Health Promotion addresses ways women can reduce their risk of disease including breast cancer, heart disease and osteoporosis.

For example, a regular breast self-examination should be a part of a woman's monthly routine. Suspicious lumps should be examined by a physician.

"Also, few people know that heart disease is the leading cause of death in older women," said Dr. Raye C. Hurwitz, an assistant professor of medicine at Baylor.

Besides age, Hurwitz says other major risk factors in women include high blood pressure, obesity, high cholesterol, smoking, and a family history of heart disease.

A woman's emotional health is also important to her overall health, said Hurwitz.

"Menopause is one condition that not only causes physical and sexual changes in a woman, but also psychological changes," she said. "Trouble concentrating, memory impairment, and depressive symptoms can be frequent at the onset of menopause and can be relieved with treatment."

She suggests some life-style changes to increase your physical and mental well-being:

- Eat a high-fiber, low cholesterol, low sodium, low-fat diet, including fruits, vegetables, fish, and lean meat.
- Drink alcohol only moderately, if at all.
- Exercise regularly. Take brisk walks, go bowling or do aerobics.
- Don't smoke.
- Get regular check-ups that include cholesterol, blood pressure, and bone density screenings.

Get plenty of sleep.

**Social Security cards for dependents**

Since income tax filing time is just around the corner, it's very timely to talk about Social Security numbers for dependents. Tax laws require dependents, age 1 or over, if claimed on tax returns, to have a Social Security number.

Each year, there are a number of children who do not have Social Security numbers. This group includes those who have attained age 1 during the last year as well as those over 1 who have never applied. Parents whose children have no number, are urged to apply right away.

Applying for a Social Security number is a very simple matter and can usually be done by phone and mail. For an applicant who has never had a Social Security card, two documents are required. The first document can be a public birth record or hospital record of birth or a religious record showing age or date of birth. These records should have been established before age five and are used to establish age and citizenship. The second required document establishes identity and can be from a variety of documents. Examples include such items as ID cards, insurance policies, immunization records, school report cards, membership cards in an organization, driver's license, etc. Persons who have a Social Security number and are applying for a new card, need only to present proof of identity. All documents must be originals, and are returned after inspection.
