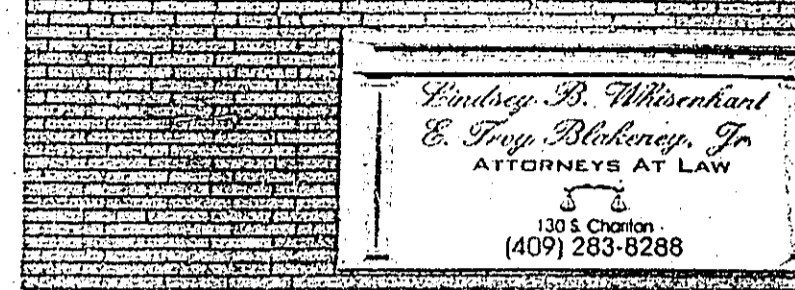
## At the Village
